LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn was shut out for the second time in three games in a 3-0 loss at Greenville...CF Roman Anthony drove in all 3 runs for the Drive...The 19-year-old provided a run-scoring single in the 3rd and a 2-run double in the 8th...RHP Layonel Ovalles suffered the loss in his Brooklyn debut...The 20-year-old was impressive, allowing just 1 run and striking out 6 over 5.2 innings...RHP Yordanny Monegro earned the win for Greenville, tossing 5.0 innings of shutout relief with 8 K's in his team debut...RHP Zack Kelly posted a scoreless inning in an MLB rehab start...LF Omar De Los Santos led the Cyclones offense, tallying 2 of the team's 5 hits of the team's 5 hits.

ON THE FINAL FEW CORKSCREWS: Brooklyn is looking to secure a second-straight playoff appearance and is 7-2-2 in their last 11 series...Brooklyn is 33-25 in the second half and is tied with Jersey Shore (33-25) atop the North Division of the SAL with 8 games left to play...The BlueClaws hold the tiebreaker over Brooklyn because of winning the season series (15-11).

KING STANLEY: OF Stanley Consuegra broke a tie with C Francisco Álvarez for the franchise record in career home runs by blasting his 23rd with Brooklyn in the top of the 5th on August 23 at Asheville...He added another blast on August 24 and is 3 home runs (19) behind Álvarez (22) for the single-season home run mark...Consuegra homered in each of the first 3 games of the series in Asheville, tying SS Jett Williams (8/19-22) for the most consecutive games with a round-tripper this year...Entering Saturday, Consuegra is tied for 4th in the SAL slugging percentage (.477), tied for 5th in home runs (19), and tied for 8th in extra-base hits (38)...Over his last 14 games since August 17, the 22-year-old is slashing .273/.344/.655 with a .999 OPS, adding 14 runs scored, 2 doubles, 2 triples, 5 home runs, and 16 RBI...Since that date, Stanley has led the SAL in homers (5), RBI (16), extra-base hits (9), and total bases (36), in addition to being tied for the lead (16), extra-base hits (9), and total bases (36), in addition to being tied for the lead in runs scored (14) and triples (2).

JETT THE MET: INF Jett Williams has been stellar since he made his Cyclones debut on August 1 and all summer long...Since returning from the All-Star break on July 14, the 19-year-old is slashing .309/.473/.576 with a 1.049 OPS, 30 runs scored, 12 doubles, 2 triples, 7 home runs, 19 RBI, 42 walks, and 16 stolen bases in 41 games between Brooklyn and Single-A St. Lucie...Since that date, no player in Minor League Baseball (min. 180 PA) has a higher on-base percentage (.473)... He is also tied for 1st in walks (42) and 3rd in OPS (1.049)...On the season, Williams is tied for 3rd in Minor League Baseball in walks (96)...Among teenagers, Williams leads Mil.B...Since making his SAL debut, the Rockwall, Texas, native has led the circuit (min. 100 PA) in on-base percentage (.452) and walks (27)...He is also tied for 1st in stolen bases (10), 2nd in doubles (8), slugging percentage (.548) and OPS (.983), 3rd in batting average (.292), tied for 3rd in extra-base hits (13), and tied for 4th in hits (28)...Among SAL players with at least 120 plate appearances in 2023, Williams is leading the circuit in walk rate (21.8%), tied for 2nd in OBP (.452), and 5th in wRC+ (170), wOBA (.445), and 8th in OPS (.983). JETT THE MET: INF Jett Williams has been stellar since he made his Cyclones

CLIFF NOTES: OF Ryan Clifford has been an on-base machine since joining the Cyclones on August 3...The 20-year-old has reached base safely in all 10 games of Brooklyn's two-week road trip...Since making his debut with the 'Clones, Clifford is tied for 4th in the South Atlantic League in walks (18)...The North Carolina native already has nearly as many walks (21) as he did in 33 fewer games (25 to 58) and 140 fewer plate appearances (110 to 250) than he had with Asheville before the trade...The 2022 11th-round pick enters Saturday ranked 3rd in the SAL in slugging percentage (484), tied for 3rd in home runs (20), and 6th in OPS (826)... Clifford is also 1st in isolated power (.243), and 8th in wOBA (.368) and wRC+ (122).

LUGO LAND: INF William Lugo has been red hot over the last several weeks for Brooklyn...Lugo reached safely in 8 consecutive games and has a knock in 11 of his last 13...Over his 8-game on-base streak, the 21-year-old is 11-for-31 at the plate (.355) with 3 runs scored, 2 doubles, 7 RBI, and 3 walks...Since August 15, Lugo is slashing .339/.387/.446 with a .834 OPS...Lugo has also scored 5 runs, picked up 4 doubles, a triple, and 13 RBI in 15 games...The Dominican native is tied for the league lead in hits (19) and is tied for 4th in RBI (13) in that span.

PITCHING IN: Brooklyn has seen a bevy of stellar pitching debuts since the start of August...LHP Felipe De La Cruz and RHPs Saúl García, Layonel Ovalles, Jawilme Ramírez, Bailey Reid, Joe Joe Rodríguez, and Luis A. Rodríguez all shined in their first appearances with the club...De La Cruz earned the win in a quality start at Asheville on August 23...García allowed 1 run over 3.0 innings at Greenville on Tuesday...Ovalles took the loss, but allowed just a tally in 5.2 frames at Greenville on Friday, Ramírez worked into the 9th inning, earning earning the win at Jercenville on Friday. Brooklyn and Greenville are meeting for the second time in this season...The Drive took 4-of-6 from the Cyclones from June 6-11 at Maimonides Park...Brooklyn and Greenville have met once at Fluor Field from May 11-16, 2021...The Drive won 4-of-6 contests in that series.

1 at Jersey Shore...Joe Joe Rodríguez whiffed 5 in 2.2 innings at Asheville on August 26 and Luis A. Rodríguez worked a perfect 9th that day for the save...In total, the 7 arms have tallied a 3.58 ERA (11 ER in 27.2 IP) in their first outings for Brooklyn.

FEROCIOUS FELIPE: Despite taking the loss in Game 1 of Thursday's double-header, LHP Felipe De La Cruz continued the stellar start to his Cyclones' career... The 22-year-old hurled his second-straight quality start, hurling all 6 innings in the lid-lifter...After allowing a leadoff home run, De La Cruz retired 18 of the final 19 batters he faced, including sitting the last 11 down in order...The southpaw was credited with a complete game, the first for a Brooklyn pitcher in over 2 years...RHP José Butto was the last to accomplish the feat, tossing 6.0 innings in a 7-inning loss at Aberdeen in Game 1 of a twinbill on June 30, 2021...Since making his SAL debut on August 23 at Asheville, De La Cruz is tied for 2nd in the league in strikeouts (13).

BEST IN SHOW: Since the start of a 4-game winning streak at Hudson Valley on May 17, the Cyclones' pitching staff has, statistically, been one of the most dominant in Minor League Baseball...Entering Saturday, Brooklyn has posted a 3.46 ERA (308 ER in 800.1 IP) over their last 92 games, holding a 50-42 record, which is 3rd lowest in the minors...Tampa Bay's Single-A Charleston (3.40) leads Mil.B...The Cyclones have hurled 9 shutouts in that span...Additionally, Brooklyn pitching holds the 4th lowest opposing OPS (.648), hits-per-9 innings (7.29) and batting average against (219)

THE AMAZING ALEX: OF **Alex Ramírez** is scattered among the Cyclones' all-time leaderboard despite joining the team last July 4...Entering Saturday, the Dominican native is 2nd in franchise history in RBI and is 6 (85) behind INF **José Peroza** (91) for the all-time mark...He surpassed Peroza for 1st in doubles (37), is 2nd in total bases (232), hits (158), and walks (69), and 3rd in runs scored (83)...Ramírez is 4 hits behind Peroza (162) for the franchise record.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: Baseball America released their updated list of Top 30 New York Mets' prospects...11 members of the 2023 squad are featured...OF Ryan Clifford (No. 3), SS Jett Williams (4), C Kevin Parada (7), RHP Blade Tidwell (9), RHP Christian Scott (10), OF Alex Ramírez (12), 3B Jacob Reimer (14), RHP Tyler Stuart (22), RHP Raimon Gómez (24), RHP Layonel Ovalles (28), and RHP Jordany Ventura (29)...Williams (No. 98) and Clifford (99) also appear on the publication's list of Top 100 prospects...Former Cyclones listed include INF Ronny Mauricio (No. 6), RHP Mike Vasil (8), RHP Dominic Hamel (19), OF Matt Rudick (20), and RHP Junior Santos (27)...In all, 16-of-30 members of BA's Top 30 have experience playing on Coney Island...MLB Pipeline released their updated list, as well...8 members of the 2023 team are recognized...SS Jett Williams (No. 3), C Kevin Parada (5), OF Ryan Clifford (6), RHP Blade Tidwell (10), OF Alex Ramírez (11), RHP Christian Scott (12), IF Jacob Reimer (13), RHP Tyler Stuart (17), and RHP Raimon Gómez (25)...Former Brooklyn stars featured are: IF Ronny Mauricio (No. 4), RHP Mike Vasil (9), RHP Dominic Hamel (16), and OF Matt Rudick (27)...Williams (No. 84), Mauricio (93), and Parada (96) are recognized in the Top 100. DE RECORD SETTER: OF Omar De Los Santos entered as a pinch-runner and caught Hudson Valley napping to steal second base on July 21, giving him 33 stolen bases in 2023...The current 36 swipes breaks INF Walter Rasquin's franchise record for single-season stolen bases (32) which was set back in 2017 when Brooklyn played in the short-season New York-Penn League...He is also 4th in the SAL in stolen bases for 2023...De Los Santos remains among the best base stealers in Minor League Baseball since the beginning of 2022...The Dominican native has accumulated 105 stolen bases in that span, which is tied for 7th most in Mil.B...Only Red Sox prospect INF David Hamilton (121), Mariners farmhand OF Jonatan Clasé (118), D'Backs prospect OF Wilderd Patiño (118), Aberdeen OF Luis Valdez (114), Cardinals prospect OF Mike Antico (114), and Marlins farmhand INF Nasim Núñez (113) have tallied more...De Los Santos has also snagged 57 more bases than any other Mets prospect in that time...Fellow 2023 Cyclone IF/OF Jaylen Palmer is 2nd with 49.

Returned to the FCL on May 10 and reported back to St. Lucie on May 23...Registered an 0-5 record with a 7.99 ERA (29 ER in 32.2 IP) and 41 K's in 10 appearances (6 starts) in the Florida State League...Joined the FCL club for the remainder of the season on July 19...Posted a 1-0 mark with a 1.59 ERA (3 ER in 17.0 IP) and 22 strikeouts in 4 outings (2 starts).
