THIS IS IT: After sweeping Carolina in the North Divisional series, the FredNats have advanced to their first Carolina League Championship Series since moving to Fredericksburg. The franchise now has a chance to win its first title in 10 years and sixth overall against the Kannapolis Cannon Ballers, affiliate of the Chicago White Sox and the South Divisional Champions. Kannapolis walked off three-time defending league champions Charleston in the deciding game three of their series to advance to the title series for the first time. The FredNats have home field advantage in the series and will play game one on the road at Kannapolis tonight before returning home for games two and three if necessary. RHP Brayan Romero makes his first playoff start in game one. One of his best FredNat outings in the regular season came against Kannapolis just a couple weeks ago as Romero pitched five scoreless innings, allowing just one hit and walking one. He faces Kannapolis lefty Justin Sinibaldi who also pitches for the first time in the playoffs. Sinibaldi was scheduled to start the Sunday series finale against the FredNats two weeks ago today, but that game got rained out.

DIVISIONAL RECAP: The FredNats won two closely contested games to sweep the first half champion Carolina Mudcats in the Divisional round, winning by scores of 7-6 and 5-2. Game two was tied 2-2 going into the 9th, but the FredNat offense exploded for three runs in the 9th to win the series. Elijah Green hit a huge game-tying home run in the 7th inning, and in the two games, the FredNat bullpen allowed two total runs in 9.1 innings pitched. Kevin Bazzell drove in three runs offensively in the two games.

SEASON SERIES RECAP: Fredericksburg and Kannapolis played two series in the regular season, and the Ballers won both. Kannapolis' first half champion team beat up on FXBG at VACU Stadium in June, winning five out of six games. The FredNats returned to Kannapolis in the last road week of the regular season and won two out of the five games that were played. The Sunday game was rained out. A lot of run scoring was the theme of the season series, with Kannapolis outscoring FXBG 68-57, and both teams had team ERAs over 4.75.

HE'S SOMETHING ELSE: Travis Sykora has proven to be one of the most dominant pitchers in the Carolina League since arriving in Fredericksburg on May 1. In August alone, Sykora made six starts, going 4-0 with an 0.88 ERA. In 30.2 innings pitched, he struck out 49 hitters (11 more than the second-best pitcher) and walked just three the entire month. He was named Washington's FredNat Pitcher of the Month for August (duh), and today was named the Carolina League Pitcher of the Month for August by MiLB. Not only did he dominate in August, but among MiLB pitchers with at least 80 innings pitched this year at any level, Sykora leads all of MiLB in strikeout percentage (39.9%), WHIP (0.83) and is second in strikeout-to-walk percentage (32.3%), and FIP (1.78).

THE SKIP IS BACK: The FredNats' leader from the last two seasons returns to the Managerial role for 2024. Jake Lowery is back for another year in the 'Burg. Lowery, 34, was selected by Cleveland in the fourth round of the 2011 Draft out of James Madison University, where he was given the Johnny Bench Award as the nation's top collegiate catcher. The Midlothian, Virginia native played in the Nationals organization from 2016 to 2019, including parts of two seasons with the Potomac Nationals. Lowery reached the Triple-A level in 2018 and transitioned to a managerial role in 2021 after nine seasons in the minor leagues. Lowery is the 28th manager in franchise history dating back to 1978. Lowery is 216-177 in his two-plus years as Manager in Fredericksburg, including the 2022 Carolina League playoffs.

THE STAFF: The majority of the 2023 coaching staff returns for 2024, with the lone exception being Hitting Coach Mike Habas. Pitching Coach Justin Lord, Development Coach Carmelo Jaime, Performance Analyst Josh Freligh, Strength & Conditioning Nathan Sier and Athletic Trainer Jake Meyer are all back from last year's staff. Lord, 44, will begin his fourth season coaching in the Washington organization. The Florida State alum pitched six seasons professionally before transitioning to coaching, spending time in the Baltimore organization prior to joining the Nationals. He was the Pitching Coach for the High-A Wilmington Blue Rocks in 2021 and the Double-A Harrisburg Senators in 2022 before coming to FXBG in 2023 and spending the last two seasons here.

Habas, 33, is in his first season in the Washington organization after spending the last four seasons coaching in the Milwaukee Brewers organization. He was the hitting coach for the ACL Brewers the last two seasons, and was an Assistant Coach for the independent Gary SouthShore RailCats and Head Coach at Prairie State Junior College prior to his time with Milwaukee. Jaime, 38, was Detroit's 24th round selection in the 2008 Draft out of Miami Dade College. The Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic native reached Double-A in his three-year minor league career, and has served as the first base coach and infield coach with the FredNats the past three seasons. Meyer is in his seventh year with the Nationals overall and second with the FredNats, he spent his first five years at the facility in West Palm Beach, FL. Sier is in his second year with FXBG after previous stops with ZSP Sports and Macomb Community College (MI). Freligh is also in his second year with the Nationals after previous stops with the Boston Red Sox and Los Angeles Dodgers.

A LASTING LEGACY: The Fredericksburg Nationals adopt the franchise history of their predecessors in the Carolina League dating back to 1978...the Alexandria Dukes (1978, 1980-83) and Alexandria Mariners (1979) played at Four Mile Run Park in Alexandria, Virginia...the Prince William Pirates (1984-1986), Prince William Yankees (1987-1988), Prince William Cannons (1989-1998), Potomac Cannons (1999-2004) and Potomac Nationals (2005-2019) played at G. Richard Pfitzner Stadium in Woodbridge, Virginia...the franchise has won five Mills Cup Championships, as the Dukes in 1982, as the Yankees in 1989, and as the Nationals in 2008, 2010 and 2014.

TONIGHT'S START: Brayan Romero is set to make his eighth start as a FredNat tonight, in game one of the Championship Series.

Romero was called up from the FCL on 7/26, in conjunction with Marc Davis being promoted to A+ Wilmington.

ROAD TO FXBG: Romero's pro career began in 2022, primarily as a reliever in the Dominican Summer League. He covered 11 innings in the DSL, working to a 3.27 ERA with opponents hitting just .154 against him. That earned him a mid-summer bump to Florida, where he posted a 5.79 ERA over five outings (two starts).

Romero lost 2023 due to injury, but has excelled this season in the FCL. He's transitioned to a starting role (12 appearances, 9 starts), sporting a 2.52 ERA across 39.1 innings, nearly double his 2022 workload. He's struck out 39 men, while walking just nine, with a .212 BAA.

AGAINST KANNAPOLIS: Romero's best FredNat outing was against these Cannon Ballers, at the end of August. The groundball specialist gave up just one hit and one walk over five shutout frames, with three punchouts as well.

LAST TIME OUT: Brayan worked during the final series of the regular season, against Lynchburg. The Hillcats tagged him for six hits and five runs, but just three earned, over four innings.
