1922 - When umpires **Brick Owens** and **Tom Connolly** miss a train, the Detroit and St. Louis trainers, **Bits Bierhalter** and **Dan Howley**, are pressed into service.

2009 - **Mark Buehrle** of the White Sox pitches the 18th perfect game in major league history, beating the Rays, 5-0. Dewayne Wise, inserted as a defensive substitute in the 9th, saves the gem by reaching over the left-center field fence to deprive Gabe Kapler of a home run. It is the second career no-hitter for Buehrle, who threw one on April 18, 2007. After the game, he receives a congratulatory phone call from President Barack Obama, a staunch White Sox fan.

2021 - The Cleveland baseball team announces it will be called the Cleveland Guardians beginning in 2022. The name replaces the name "Indians" which had been used for over 100 years.

APPLE SLICES

PACKING PARVIEW: For the second straight game, the **Fort Wayne TinCaps ended with the 7th-best crowd in Minor League Baseball, with an attendance of 5,353.** This comes after 6,011 on Tuesday, the 11th time this season the 'Caps have welcomed in more than 6,000 fans to the ballpark. That number only trailed five Triple-A teams and Dayton. The TinCaps this season are 3rd among 60 teams at the Single-A/High-A levels in average attendance and 32nd in all of Minor League Baseball, drawing an average of 4,750 fans per night.

WALK IT OFF: Fort Wayne finished off a miraculous comeback win on Tuesday with their sixth walk-off of the campaign. **Alex McCoy's** RBI single in the 9th inning is the second walk-off winner for the 'Caps this season against Lake County, with the other coming on June 2 courtesy of Justin DeCriscio. The TinCaps have a walk-off winner in each of the last five homestands dating back to the end of May, when Jack Costello crushed a walk-off three-run homer on May 22 against Dayton. Fort Wayne had 4 walk-off victories in 2025, three of which were by Brandon Butterworth, including the last coming on July 30 against Great Lakes.

THE COMEBACK 'CAPS: The TinCaps completed their second-largest comeback of the season in Tuesday night's 7-6 victory. All 3 wins on the previous road trip were not in come-from-behind fashion after winning 16 straight comeback affairs dating back to May 15 on the road against Cedar Rapids. Of their 38 victories this year, 26 are comeback wins.

HOLDING THE LINE: TinCaps relievers **Javier Chacon**, **Will Koger** and **Luis Germán** tossed 5.0 scoreless innings in Fort Wayne's comeback efforts on Tuesday. Only 1 hit was allowed in the stretch, with a pair of key double plays playing a major factor in keeping Lake County off the board. Chacon has not allowed a run in 3 of his last 4 outings and is third on the team with 20 appearances this year. Koger struck out 4 batters for the first time since May 1 when he was with Single-A Lake Elsinore against Ontario and has not surrendered a run in his last 3 showings. German collected his third win of the season in his second outing back with the team since being transferred from the Arizona Complex League on July 15.

THE WORLD OF WIDEMAN: TinCap center fielder **Ryan Wideman** has consecutive multi-hit games to begin this series, following his 2-for-5 showing on Wednesday. Wideman has put together five multi-hit games in July and brought home the crucial tying run with two outs in the ninth inning on Tuesday. The Padres 2025 third-round pick out of Western Kentucky slashed .314/.389/.504 with a .893 OPS in 65 games with Single-A Lake Elsinore to begin this season before his promotion to High-A on June 23.

JACK ATTACK: Fort Wayne left fielder **Jack Costello** hit his 11th home run of the season in the seventh inning on Tuesday night, giving him 21 round-trippers in his TinCaps career. Jack is now 1 of 11 players in franchise history to hit the 20-home-run mark and is tied for 9th in career home runs with Fernando Tatis Jr. (2017). Costello has a hit in 12 of his last 15 showings, slashing .264/.316/.528 with a .844 OPS and 4 HR in the stretch. Thirteen of Costello's 15 doubles this season have come since May 9, ranking him ninth in the Midwest League in that stretch. Costello has led the MWL since the start of 2025, with 11 of his 20 home runs against left-handed pitching, three ahead of his own teammate, Jake Cunningham.

SWEET-SWINGING ALEX MCCOY: TinCaps slugger **Alex McCoy** walked it off in the ninth inning on Tuesday and collected his Midwest League-leading 24th double of the season. McCoy has 11 multi-RBI games this season, with July 10 at West Michigan being his third three-RBI showing. The No. 19 Padres prospect is the active team leader in RBI (45) and multi-hit games (23) in 82 games this season. Along with leading the Midwest League in doubles, McCoy is 3rd in extra-base hits (37), fourth in total bases (145), and seventh in hits (83). The 24-year-old has reached base in seven straight games with a knock in 6 of 7.

BIG LEAGUE ARM IN THE HOUSE: Nine-year Major League pitcher **José Leclerc** joins Fort Wayne as part of a rehab assignment. After eight seasons with the Rangers and one with the Athletics, Leclerc signed a Minor League contract with the San Diego Padres on March 17, 2026, after pitching in only 10 games in 2025, missing the final five and a half months due to shoulder surgery. Leclerc won a World Series in 2023 with the Rangers and left Texas as the Rangers/Senators all-time leader in strikeouts by a reliever (469), fourth in games pitched (350), and 10th in saves (41). He made his first professional appearance with the ACL Padres in 437 days on July 3. The native of Esperanza, Dominican Republic

KT WANTS TO RULE THE WORLD: Since May 31, TinCaps outfielder **Kavares Tears** is 8th in the Midwest League with 17 extra-base hits (5 2B, 2 3B, 10 HR). Playing 30 games, Tears has hit .257 with a .930 OPS and ranks 3rd in HR with 10 in the stretch. Tears hit his 13th home run of the season on Sunday at Jackson Field and is now the active team-leader in long balls. The former Tennessee Volunteer clobbered a pair of homers on July 1, the fourth multi-homer game by a TinCap this season, and the first from a 'Cap not named Jake Cunningham. Tears leads the Midwest League with eight first-pitch home runs this season and is tied for fourth in Minor League Baseball. He is hitting .436 (17-39) when putting the ball in play on the first pitch of an at-bat.

JD JUST DOING IT: Fort Wayne shortstop **Justin DeCriscio** is tenth in High-A and fifth in the Midwest League with 18 hits since July 3 (12 games). DeCriscio had his 10-game hitting streak cut Sunday, but hit .429 (18-42) with 4 doubles, 2 HR, and 8 RBI in the stretch. On Sunday, June 12, vs. West Michigan, DeCriscio went 3-for-5 with a 2B, HR, and a career-high 5 RBI. His three-run shot in the seventh inning was his eighth round-tripper of the season. The former NC State Wolfpack now has 17 multi-hit games with Fort Wayne since being promoted on May 12, with six of those being three-hit showings.

HE GETS ON BASE: DeCriscio has reached base safely in 21 of his last 24 games dating back to June 18. He is slashing .301/.371/.495 with a .866 OPS in the stretch, with 4 HR, 6 doubles, a triple, and 15 RBI. The 23-year-old has the only grand slam hit by a TinCap this season (June 12), and 6 of his 8 home runs have been on the road. The Padres' 10th-round pick in 2025 is fourth in the Midwest League with 46 hits dating back to May 31, with a .291 average in that stretch.

CROD CRUSHING: TinCaps catcher **Carlos Rodriguez** belted his 5th home run of the season on Sunday afternoon against Lansing. The round-tripper for Rodriguez is his first since May 28 at Four Winds Field against South Bend, with his last three homers coming away from Parkview Field. Rodriguez is hitting .300 in 9 games in July, which includes his second 3-hit performance of the season on July 3 at home against Great Lakes. The 22-year-old has a hit in 6 of his last 7 games.

GOOD WILL HUNTING: Reliever **Will Varmette** collected his third win of the season on Saturday night. The 23-year-old has not allowed an earned run in his last three outings, which have spanned 5.0 innings. Since June 10, Varmette has a 1.80 ERA, 0.93 WHIP, and a 2-0 record in 15.0 innings. The righty picked up his first High-A save on June 12 at Day Air Ballpark against Dayton in his 40th appearance with Fort Wayne across the last 4 seasons. Varmette is second on the team in appearances this season with 29.

GOOSE-EGGS: On Saturday, July 18, the Fort Wayne TinCaps and Lansing Lugnuts entered the 11th inning scoreless before Fort Wayne plated a pair to win 2-0. It is the first time that Fort Wayne and an opponent have been scoreless through 10 innings since June 8, 2013, when the 'Caps won on a walk-off single by Maxx Tissenbaum vs. Dayton. It is the first occurrence since the "automatic runner" rule was set in place in MiLB in 2018. It's the first such occurrence in the Midwest League since May 27, 2022, as the Dayton Dragons beat the West Michigan Whitecaps, 11-0, and the third since the league moved to High-A in 2021.

THE FINAL CHAPTER: Tuesday marked the beginning of the final series of four between Fort Wayne and Lake County this season. The 'Caps are 8-11 against Lake County, seeing them more than any other opponent this season. Fort Wayne hit 5 home runs against the Captains on April 16 at Classic Auto Group Park, the third time in the TinCaps era (2009-present) the team has reached the mark. In the first series at Parkview Field, Justin DeCriscio delivered a walk-off ninth-inning single on June 2 before Jake Cunningham hit three home runs for the 4th time in franchise history on June 5. The 'Caps split their last series with Lake County, spinning the 18th one-hitter in franchise history in the series opener on June 23.

AN ALL-TIME CLASSIC: Fort Wayne and Great Lakes needed 14 innings and 4 hours and 48 minutes on July 4 at Parkview Field to determine a winner in the longest game for the TinCaps by innings since July 30, 2016. The evening featured 25 runs on 32 hits with 30 runners left on base. Each team used six pitchers, with Great Lakes totaling 217 pitches and Fort Wayne logging 274. Five home runs were hit between both teams, and the pitching staffs combined to walk 14 batters while punching out 26.

ANOTHER FUTURE STAR: On Sunday, July 12, the 2026 MLB All-Star Futures Game, presented by Nike, took place at Citizens Bank Park in Philadelphia. Among the participants was Fort Wayne TinCaps left-handed pitcher **Kash Mayfield**. This marks the fifth-straight season an active TinCaps player has appeared in the Futures Game. Fort Wayne is one of only two out of 30 High-A teams to have had a player selected for this showcase each year since 2022. Outfielder Robert Hassell III became the first active player to represent Fort Wayne in 2022, before Jackson Merrill appeared in 2023. This year's rosters also include Padres No. 1 prospect Ethan Salas (2024) and Athletics No. 1 prospect Leo De Vries (2025), both of whom return to the showcase after representing Fort Wayne in their respective seasons with the club. Including Mayfield, the Midwest League had nine players who have donned an MWL team's jersey this season in the event.

Manager

Age: 54

- **FROM:** Centerville, IA
- **COLLEGE:** Indian Hills Community College (Iowa) and the University of New Orleans
- **PLAYING CAREER:** Drafted in the 42nd Round of the 1994 MLB Draft by the Colorado Rockies, played one season
- **COACHING CAREER:** Mathews returns to Fort Wayne for his third stint with the organization and second as the team's manager. Began coaching career at the University of Iowa and then in the Minnesota Twins' organization after his playing career. Became the hitting coach for the High-A Fort Myers Miracle in 1997, before managing the rookie-level Elizabethton Twins in 1998 and '99. Returned to alma mater, coaching at Indian Hills and taught economics from 1999-2012 before returning to professional baseball. Mathews coached in the Baltimore Orioles' farm system in 2013, and Arizona Diamondbacks' system from 2014-2016 before joining the Padres organization in 2017 as their major-league outfield coach. He first spent time in Fort Wayne as the TinCaps hitting coach from 2018-2021 before assuming the same role with Triple-A El Paso in 2022. He took over as the Fort Wayne manager in 2023, leading the TinCaps to a second-half east division title and first playoff appearance since 2017. He has spent the last two years as a minor league hitting coordinator.

Pitching Coach

Age: 42

- **FROM:** Maracay, Venezuela
- **SIGNED:** July 19, 2000 (Florida Marlins) as international free agent
- **CAREER:** Made 25 big league appearances, including eight starts across four seasons from 2005 to 2009. He also played 10 seasons in the minor leagues, accruing 1,112 innings pitched and a 3.91 ERA. He ended his playing career in 2017 after multiple seasons away from the states in Venezuela, Mexico, and Italy.
- **COACHING:** Became a pitching coach in the Pittsburgh Pirates organization in 2018, acting as a pitching coach in the DSL before going stateside in 2021. He then joined the Padres organization in 2023 and spent 2025 as the pitching coach for Single-A Lake Elsinore.
- **RELATIONSHIP:** Older brother of Seattle Mariners reliever Eduard Bazardo, who made nine appearances in the playoffs in 2025.

Luis Mendez

- **FROM:** San Juan de los Morros, Venezuela
- **CAREER:** Mendez played in the minors for nine seasons all of which in the Rangers organization totaling 506 games in the minor leagues. Retired from playing after winter league stint in 2018-19.
- **COACHING:** After retiring from playing in 2019, Mendez began his coaching career with the Tri-City Dust Devils before the COVID-19 pandemic cut down the 2020 season. Mendez then spent the next three seasons as the manager of the rookie-level Dominican Summer League (DSL) Padres. In 2024, Mendez managed the Arizona Complex League (ACL) Padres. He returns for his second season as the TinCaps bench coach.

About Parkview Field

- **BACKGROUND:** In 2007, the Fort Wayne City Council approved the Harrison Square Project to build a new ballpark downtown as well as other amenities.
- **DEBUT:** Opening Day for Parkview Field took place on April 16, 2009. The TinCaps played in front of a sold-out crowd and beat the Dayton Dragons 7-0.
- **CAPACITY:** 8,100
- **RECORD CROWD:** 9,508 (July 4, 2019)
- **DIMENSIONS:** 336 feet to the left-field foul pole... 377 feet to left-center field... 400 feet to straight-away centerfield... 383 feet to right-center field... and 318 feet to the right-field foul pole.
- **WALLS:** Range from 10 feet tall, from center to right-center field, up to 15 feet tall in the outfield corners as well as a small section of left-center field.
