Baty Gets Called Up to the Big Leages: After just six games with Syracuse, Brett Baty will make his Major League debut tonight in Atlanta batting eighth and playing third base. Baty is the 337th Binghamton player to reach the big leagues, 169th to do it with the Mets, 67th to do it in the same year after playing with Binghamton and the first to reach the majors this year. Baty is also the first Rumble Ponies player to make his MLB debut since Tylor Megill on June 23rd, 2021.

Baty by the Numbers: Baty, the number two ranked prospect in the Mets system and 18th ranked prospect in all of baseball according to mlb.com, slashed .312/.406/.544 with 19 home runs, 59 RBI, and an OPS of .950 in 89 games with Binghamton. Baty named by Minor League Baseball as the July Player of the Month for the Eastern League. From July 12th through the 29th, Baty hit .490 over a 12-game hit streak, nine of which were multi-hit games, including six consecutive, and hit five home runs, drove in 19 runs, and carried an OPS of 1.431. He also had a team-high 16-game hitting streak earlier in the season.

Tuesday: Nick Meyer hit two home runs and the Binghamton Rumble Ponies scored eight unanswered runs in an 8-2 win over the Richmond Flying Squirrels in the series opener Tuesday night at The Diamond. Binghamton was down 2-0 entering the top of the sixth before Meyer tagged the first pitch he saw over the left-field wall to cut the deficit to 2-1. Brandon McIlwain hit a two-run double that put Binghamton ahead 3-2 followed by a Carlos Cortes sacrifice fly that made it 4-2. In the seventh, Luke Ritter led off with a double, followed by a walk to Hayden Senger, bringing Meyer to the plate again. Meyer belted a three-run homer that broke the game open making it 7-2. It's Meyer's second and third home runs of the year. He finished 2-4 with 4 RBI. Ronny Mauricio added a solo home run in the ninth, his 22nd of the year and 70th run batted in. Mauricio finished 2-5 with an RBI.


Heating Up Again: Ponies infielder Wyatt Young rode a 15-game hit streak from July 13th-August 7th batting .344 during that time with 22 hits, two homers and 12 RBI with an OPS of. 955. He picked up right where he left off and is on a seven-game hit streak. In the series against Altoona, Young hit .333 with a homerun, two RBI, a triple, five walks and had an OPS of 1.081. After getting on base in Tuesday's game, is on-base streak has also reached 23 straight games.

Reid Brignac - Manager - 1st season with Binghamton - 3rd year in the Mets organization. Brignac comes to Binghamton after serving as the manager of the St. Lucie Mets (Low-A) in 2021. He appeared in parts of nine years in the major leagues with the Tampa Bay Rays, Colorado Rockies, Atlanta Braves, Philadelphia Phillies, New York Yankees, and Miami Marlins. He was initially drafted by the Rays in the second round of the 2004 MLB Draft.

Jerome Williams - Pitching Coach - 1st season with Binghamton - Williams also held the same position on Brignac's staff with St. Lucie and is entering his fourth season in the Mets organization following a 20-year playing career. He pitched for 11 years in the major leagues with the Giants, Angels, Cubs, Cardinals, Rangers, Phillies, Nationals and Astros compiling a 52-66 record with a 4.59 ERA in 236 career games.

Tommy Joseph - Hitting Coach - 1st season with Binghamton - 2nd year in the Mets organization. Joseph joins Brignac and Williams in being promoted from the same position in St. Lucie to Double-A Binghamton. He is entering his second season with the Mets organization after retiring from his playing career following the 2020 season. He spent two seasons in the major leagues with the Phillies in 2016-17 hitting .247 with 43 home runs and 116 RBI in 249 major league games.

Mariano Duncan - Bench Coach - 1st season with Binghamton - arrives in the Southern Tier after serving as the bench coach for the Brooklyn Cyclones (High-A) in 2020.
