**REGULAR SEASON BY THE NUMBERS** 

TODAY'S GAME: The M-Braves continue a 12game homestand with a six-game series against the Pensacole Blue Wahoos at Trustmark Park. This is the fourth of five series between the two clubs (12 at Trustmark Park, 18 at Blue Wahoos Stadium). The M-Braves have two 12-game homestands this season, with another from August 29-September 10.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The M-Braves snapped a three-game skid with a 4-1 win over Pensacola. RHP Nolan Kingham pitched five shutout innings, Jesse Franklin V gathered three hits with a two-run double, and Drew Lugbauer homered in the win. Kyle Wilcox earned his third save.

LAST TIME AGAINST THE BLUE WAHOOS: The M-Braves won four of six on the road against Pensacola. The club blasted 17 home runs. The M-Braves had their first ever multi-grand slam game on June 16 at Pensacola (Cade Bunnell, Luke Waddell), with Bunnell hitting the slam off MLB rehaber RHP Johnny Cueto.

A DIFFICULT GOODBYE: On Monday, Atlanta announced a trade with the Colorado Rockies for RHP Pierce Johnson that sent two of Atlanta's top prospects in Double-A, RHP Victor Vodnik (No. 10) and RHP Tanner Gordon (No. 26), to the Rockies organization.

Vodnik is 3-1 with a 3.10 ERA and four saves in 40 2/3 innings over 30 relief appearances. In 11 starts for the M-Braves, Gordon is 4-5 with a 4.61 ERA in 56 2/3 innings. In the first Triple-A action of his career, Gordon made six appearances and five starts for Gwinnett. The right-hander went 1-4 with an 8.28 ERA in 29.1 innings for Gwinnett.

TOP PITCHING STAFF: The M-Braves lead the Southern League, and rank 5th in Double-A, with a 4.00 ERA. The pitching staff has given up just 69 home runs, the fewest in Double-A. The M-Braves bullpen is 3rd in Double-A with a 3.48

**GRAND SALAMI TIME:** The M-Braves have a club record six grand slams, including the first-ever multi-grand slam game on June 16 at Pensacola (Cade Bunnell, Luke Waddell). Waddell hit grand slams on June 16 at Pensacola and July 1 at Biloxi.

RETURN OF THE PEARL CITY BOMBERS: The M-Braves rank 4th in the league and 11th in Double-A with 106 homers in 92 games - 77 on the road, while their opponents have just 70 total home runs. 16 Mississippi players have at least one homer, with Landon Stephens leading the way with 18, which is T-1st in the Southern

CAN'T CATCH A BREAK: In their last seven onerun games, the M-Braves have found themselves on the losing side. The club lost backto-back one-run games to Pensacola to start the series and have lost four of the last seven games by one run. The M-Braves are 3-10 since the All-Star Break

WELCOME BACK MILLY: OF Cody Milligan returned from the IL on Friday after being shut down on April 25 after suffering a wrist injury. Since coming back from injury, Milligan is batting .302 (13-for-43 with a triple, four doubles, four RBI, seven walks and nine runs in 12

WADDYYY: Luke Waddell is second in the league with a .300 batting average, and ranks among the league leaders in OBP (.404, 4th), and OPS (.851, 10th).

RETURN OF THE SLUGBAUER: 1B Drew Lugbauer hit his 102nd minor league home run on Friday vs Pensacola, which was his 61st in three seasons for the M-Braves. Lugbauer returned Wednesday from his second IL stint. He just lost a 14-game hitting streak that went from June 1-July 23, batting .465 with 5 2B, 4 HR, 11 RBI, 8 BB, .558 OBP, and 1.418 OPS over the streak. It's the club's longest hitting streak this season.

On May 23, Lugbauer cranked a 117-mile-perhour home run, ranking 5th among MLB players for hardest-hit balls.

The M-Braves all-time and single-season home run leader slugged his 50th career M-Braves home run on April 30 at Biloxi. Lugbauer has a club record, and Double-A franchise record 60 home runs over parts of three seasons. Lugbauer also has a club-record 173 RBI. He hit 18 homers in 2021 and led the Southern League and Braves minor league system with 28 homers in 2022

**DE AVILA DELIVERS:** Luis De Avila has delivered 11 hitless innings in his last two starts, earning SL PItcher of the Week. The lefty delivered five solid starts in June, going 3-0 with a 1.61 ERA in 28.0 innings. After a team-most 17 starts, De Avila ranks among the league leaders in ERA (3.04, 3rd), opponent average (.208, 3rd) and WHIP (1.25, 4th).

**EVEN STEPHENS:** Landon Stephens is tied for the league lead with 18 home runs and has 12 home runs since the start of June. He homered in three straight games from June 16-18 and has homered in two-straight, on four different occasions.

Stephens leads the Southern League with 21 extra-base hits since June 1, and overall this season is T-1st in home runs with 18. He ranks among the league leaders in slugging (.494, 8th), extra-base hits (31, 9th), and RBI (52, 9th).

RETURN OF THE KING: RHP Nolan Kingham returned to the M-Braves from Triple-A Gwinnett and pitched five shutout innings on Friday. Kingham has pitched for the M-Braves in 2019, 2021 and 2022. In 24 games, 22 starts, for the M-Braves, Kingham is 10-8 with a 3.14 ERA in 131.2 innings.

### **TODAY'S GAME**

- Luis De Avila makes his team-leading 18th start and his fifth career start against Pensacola, all coming this season. In his last start at Pensacola on June 16, De Avila allowed three runs in six innings with six strikeouts.
- De Avila ranks among the league leaders in ERA (3.04, 3rd), opponent average (.208, 3rd) and WHIP (1.25, 4th).
- The lefty has not allowed a hit in 11.0 innings over his last two starts in a remarkable run.

#### **LAST TIME OUT**

 De Avila dominated over six innings of no-hit ball, allowing just two walks with a season-high eight strikeouts. The M-Braves ended up carrying the no-hitter one out into the seventh inning.

#### **2023 NOTES**

- Did not allow a hit in two starts on July 16 at CHA and July 23 at TNS, combining for 11 innings of no-hit ball.
- Tremendous in June, going 3-0 with a 1.61 ERA in 28 innings over five starts
