ABOUT LAST NIGHT...: A three-run top of the ninth spoiled the series opener for the Vancouver Canadians on Tuesday, as the visiting Everett AquaSox (Mariners) came from behind to win 5-3 in a battle between two of the High-A West League's best teams.

Leading 3-2 to start the final frame, Vancouver sent Parker Caracci (L, 0-1) to the hill to secure what would have been his fourth save. Instead, Everett started the rally with a one-out hit by pitch before an infield single put the go-ahead run on base. A groundout moved both runners into scoring position, which set up Kaden Polcovich for a two-RBI single to left field that made it 4-3 AquaSox. #2 Mariners prospect Julio Rodriguez followed with an RBI single of his own to give the 'Sox a 5-3 advantage they would not relinquish, despite Vancouver bringing the tying run to the plate in the bottom of the inning.

Vancouver took a one-run lead in the bottom of the eighth. Tanner Morris started a two-out rally with a single then went to second on a Luis De Los Santos base hit. Consecutive walks forced in the go-ahead run that put the C's in prime position to win the game before the AquaSox surged in the ninth.

The scoring started in the third when both teams plated one run. Everett used a triple and a two-out single to draw first blood before a hit batter set up an RBI double from Cameron Eden in the home half of the frame to tie the score. The C's got another RBI from Eden - this time by way of a sacrifice fly - in the fifth to go up 2-1, but the Mariners affiliate tied it with a run on two hits in the seventh.

Right-hander Sean Wymer turned in his finest start of the year. The Flower Mound, TX native went a season-high six innings, allowing one run on three hits, walked two and struck out five.

FEELING SOXY: The Everett AquaSox (Mariners) hop into town this week for the first of 6 series between these two clubs, for a total of 36 head-to-head matchups. Everett will be a tall task for the C's; entering today, the Sox lead or are among the leaders in all of Advanced-A in AVG (.252, 2nd), R (130, 1st), H (164, 1st), TB (293, 2nd), 2B (48, 1st), HR (23, T-2nd), RBI (116, 1st), BB (108, 1st), OBP (.368, 1st), SLG (.451, 2nd) & OPS (.828, 2nd).

HOME AWAY FROM HOME: Due to pandemic-related border closures, Ron Tonkin Field in Hillsboro will serve as Vancouver's home ballpark this year. 78 of 120 C's game will take place in the Tualatin Valley over the course of the season (60 home games, 18 as the visitors).

LEAGUE LEADERS: Vancouver and Everett are all over the offensive league leaderboard. Of the 15 categories, the Canadians are represented in 13 of them while the AquaSox are listed in 14. The C's have four players in the top ten for batting average and on-base percentage while the 'Sox have four or more in RBI, extra-base hits, total bases and runs scored.

TUESDAY BLUES: In four games on Tuesday this year, the Canadians are 1-3. It's their worst winning percentage on any day of the week.

ON, BUT NOT IN: The C's went 0-7 with runners in scoring position last night, most glaringly when they loaded the bases with one out in the bottom of the first but failed to score.

DOWN, BUT NOT OUT: Cameron Eden, Luis De Los Santos and Ryan Gold are the guys you want at the plate when the C's are trailing; when the team is behind, Eden is batting .429, De Los Santos .350 and Gold .308. 11 of De Los Santos' 14 RBI have come when the C's are down.

LATE NIGHTMARES: After giving up just two ninth inning runs in the first 17 games of the season, Vancouver has allowed a combined six runs to cross in the final frame over their last two games.

HOR-WIZ: Spencer Horwitz continues to find ways to get on base. His 22 walks are the second-most in Minor League Baseball (Anthony Servideo of Delmarva [Low-A, BAL] has 25 in the same number of plate appearances) and his .519 on-base percentage is the fifth highest in the country among players with 10 or more games under their belt this season.

VAN EYK KKKKKK: Tonight's Canadians starter CJ Van Eyk is coming off the finest start of his pro career, when he established a new team high with nine strikeouts on May 20 at Hillsboro.

ON THE HILL: #9 Blue Jays prospect (MLB.com) CJ Van Eyk returns to the hill tonight as he seeks his first win as a pro. The right-hander was fantastic in his last turn on May 20 at Hillsboro, when he struck out a team-high nine across a personal-best six innings pitched. He gave up one run on two hits and walked one. Van Eyk, 22, is in the midst of his first professional season after the Blue Jays took him in the second round of last year's draft out of Florida State. In his pandemic-shortened junior season in the ACC, Van Eyk went 1-1 with a 1.31 ERA and 25 strikeouts across 20.2 innings pitched. He was a preseason All-American and a semifinalist for the AAU Sullivan Award, given to the nation's top amateur athlete and the only baseball player to be recognized. Previous winners include Bill Walton (1973), Peyton Manning (1997), Michael Phelps (2003) and Tim Tebow (2007). He played his prep ball at Steinbrenner High School in his hometown of Lutz, FL, a northern suburb of Tampa. He was previously drafted by the Mets in the 19th round of the 2017 draft but didn't sign.

#14 Mariners prospect (MLB.com) Levi Stoudt gets the call for Everett. He took the loss in his last start on May 19 in Spokane, when he gave up three runs (two earned) on five hits with two walks and three strikeouts in 5.1 innings pitched. The right-hander was a third round selection (97th overall) in the 2019 draft out of Lehigh University, where he made 10 starts as the ace of the Mountain Hawks rotation. Stoudt, 23, had Tommy John surgery after he was drafted and is in the midst of his first professional season in 2021.
