New England Double

The Fightin Phils remain in New England and continue a six-game series at the New Hampshire Fisher Cats, Double-A affiliate of the Toronto Blue Jays, on Friday night. It is the 9th-of-17 matchups between the teams this season, and ninth-of-11 in Manchester. The Fisher Cats come to Reading for their lone series in Baseballtown from Aug. 13-18. Reading currently leads the season-series over New Hampshire 5-3.

Winning Streak Snapped

The Fightin Phils had their season-best four-game win streak snapped with a 5-4 loss to New Hampshire on Thursday night. Reading raced out to a 3-0 lead when Leandro Pineda hit a three-run home run in the top of the second. New Hampshire then got two back in the bottom of the frame off Christian McGowan, who went three innings in his first Reading start since May 1. Carson Taylor tripled for his second hit and scored his second run on an Otto Kemp sac fly in the top of the fourth. Jean Cabrera, who went four innings, allowed his only two runs in the seventh to tie the game. New Hampshire then scored a run in the bottom of the ninth inning off Tommy McCollum for the walk-off win and the Fisher Cats first win of the series.

Shutout Streak

After allowing two runs in the second inning on Thursday, the R-Phils' pitching's scoreless streak was snapped at 23 innings, dating back to Sunday at Portland. It was their longest scoreless-inning streak since going 22-straight scoreless from July 10-14, 2022. It fell one-inning shy of Reading's 24-inning streak from Aug. 19-22, 2013, which is their longest, dating back to 2005. Included in that streak was back-to-back shutouts pitched, marking the first time Reading pitched consecutive shutouts since July 12-13, 2022.

Swiper Yes Swiping

Reading stole nine bases in Tuesday night's win at New Hampshire, marking the most stolen bags in a game, dating back to the 2005 season. The Fightin Phils now sit at 101 stolen bases on the season, which puts them on pace for 150 this season. In 2023, Reading stole just 119 bases for the season. Since the conclusion of the All-Star Break on July 19, Reading is tied with Portland for the most stolen bases in the Eastern League at 16. Five have come from Justin Crawford.

Going Going Gone

The Fightin Phils reached the 100 home run mark in Thursday night's game, thanks to Leandro Pineda's three-run home run. Reading currently sits second in home runs hit at 100. Since June 1, the Fightin Phils lead the Eastern League in home runs hit at 58, leading second-place Somerset by seven over that span.

Carson Crushing It

Carson Taylor has been on a roll during the month of July. For the month, he is slashing .318/.436/.614 (1.050 OPS). Taylor's added two doubles, one triple, three home runs and seven RBI. He's struck out just twice over 55 plate appearances. Taylor currently holds the following Eastern League ranks: 5th AVG (.292), T-5th HR (13), 2nd RBI (60), 3rd OBP (.391), 3rd SLG (.516), 2nd OPS (.907), T-8th BB (40) and T-8th TB (129). Taylor is also on a 12-game on-base streak.

Pineda Powering

Leandro Pineda has had a red-hot start to his time with Reading. He has reached base in each of his first five games and is slashing .368/.429/.737 (1.166 OPS). He's added a double, two homers and four RBI so far while proving to be a versatile defender, playing both first base and both corner outfield spots.

Rincones Recap

Following an 0-4 game Thursday night, where he didn't reach base, Gabriel Rincones' team-high 17-game on-base streak came to an end. It dated back to Apr. 5 and ranked as the second-longest on-base streak by an R-Phil this season. He slashed .284/.392/.567 (.959 OPS) over the streak. Adding five homers and 9 RBI.

Scouting the Fisher Cats

New Hampshire enters tonight after finishing in sixth place in the Eastern League's Northeast Division for the first half with a 30-38 record. They are sixth in the Northeast Division with a 5-17 record in the second half of the season. New Hampshire most recently dropped two-of-three at Harrisburg. Following this week, Portland heads to Binghamton. New Hampshire's roster features seven players ranked amongst the Toronto Blue Jays' top-30 prospects: Adam Macko (9), Josh Kasevich (11), Cade Doughty (13), CJ Van Eyk (16), Dahian Santos (20), Alex De Jesus (22) and T.J. Brock (28).

Fisher Cat Pitcher

Lefty Trenton Wallace makes the start tonight for New Hampshire. This season, Wallace is 3-3, with a 2.62 ERA over 16 starts (75.2 IP, 53 H, 30 BB, 89 SO). Wallace last pitched July 20 at Harrisburg, allowing no runs on two hits over four innings, with six strikeouts. Against Reading on June 22, he allowed one run on seven hits, with nine strikeouts, in a no-decision. Wallace was limited to 12 starts over four levels last season, going 5-3, with a 2.65 ERA. Toronto drafted the 25-year old in the 11th round in 2021 out of Iowa. He pitched for the Hawkeyes from 2018-21.
