LAST TIME OUT: The Cyclones tied their season-high in runs (13) in back-to-back games and set a season-high in hits (18) in consecutive contests, defeating the IronBirds, 13-7, on Friday night...The contest featured four lead changes, as Brooklyn took the lead for good with three in the seventh and four more in the eighth...Five different Cyclones accrued multi-hit nights...CF **Stanley Consuegra**, 1B **Nick Lorusso**, and LF **Chris Suero** each posted three-hit nights...DH **Junior Tillen** and 2B **Wilfredo Lara** composed multi-hit efforts, as well...Consuegra drove in a game-high four, while Suero and RF **Kellum Clark** each brought in a pair...Brooklyn had 10 different batters in the game and all 10 posted at least one hit...RHP **Jonah Tong** struck out eight and walked only one over five innings in a no-decision...RHP **Josh Hejka** struck out a season-high over two scoreless innings for his third save.

GET YOUR OFFENSE HERE!: In back-to-back games on SNY, the Brooklyn Cyclones erupted for a season-high-tying 13 runs and 14 hits in Thursday's 13-3 win vs. Aberdeen and followed it up with 13 more runs and a season-best 18 hits in a 13-7 win on Friday...The 13 runs were the most for the Cyclones since a 13-3 win vs. Wilmington on April 24...The 14 knocks were also the most for Brooklyn since a 14-hit outing in a 9-7 win at Jersey Shore on April 20...Friday's 18-hit effort was the best for Brooklyn since they accumulated 18 knocks in an 8-7 win at Hudson Valley on July 21, 2023...The 18 hits were the most for the Cyclones at Maimonides Park in almost 13 years...Brooklyn racked up 20 hits, also against Aberdeen, in a 13-0 rout on July 21, 2011...Friday marked the first time the 'Clones accrued 13+ runs and 18+ hits in the same game since scoring a franchise-record 20 runs in a 20-6 win at Bowling Green on May 27, 2022...It was the first time Brooklyn accomplished those numbers at Maimonides Park that 13-0 win vs. Aberdeen on July 21, 2011.

TURN UP THE TRUMPETS!: On Thursday, RHP **Edwin Díaz** became the fifth player to join the Cyclones on a Major League rehab assignment in 2024, striking out a pair in a scoreless inning...C **Francisco Alvarez**, RHP **Drew Smith**, RHP **Tyler Megill**, and RHP **Sean Reid-Foley** have also appeared on Coney Island this season...He is expected to continue his rehab stint on Sunday...Díaz was placed on New York's 15-day injured list on May 29 with right shoulder impingement...In 20 relief appearances in 2024, the Puerto Rico native is 1-1 with a 5.40 ERA (12 ER in 20.0 IP), five saves, seven walks, and 30 strikeouts...Díaz is a two-time All-Star and has taken home both the American League and National League Reliever of the Year award...The right-hander was acquired by the Mets with 2B **Robinson Canó** and cash considerations from the Seattle Mariners in exchange for RHP **Gerson Bautista**, OF **Jay Bruce**, RHP **Justin Dunn**, OF **Jarred Kelenic**, and RHP **Anthony Swarzak** on December 3, 2018...C **Austin Allen** has also joined Brooklyn from the Florida Complex League on a minor league rehab assignment...The 30-year-old signed with New York as a minor league free agent on January 16 and has appeared in 57 Major League games between the San Diego Padres and Oakland Athletics, hitting .195 (23-118) with two home runs.

CROWN CONSUEGRA!: In last Wednesday's win over Jersey Shore, OF **Stanley Consuegra's** RBI double in the fourth inning made him the new Cyclones all-time hits leader (174), breaking a tie with **Alex Ramirez**...On Friday, Consuegra's two-run double in the second inning tied him with Ramirez for the franchise record in doubles (38)...The 23-year-old is atop the Cyclones' ranks in numerous other offensive categories as well, including extra-base hits (79), home runs (35), and RBI (119)...On the final day of the 2023 regular season, he broke a tie with C **Francisco Alvarez** for Brooklyn's single-season home run record (23)...The Dominican native also broke the franchise's single-season record for extra-base hits (42) and tied the mark for RBI (63) set by **Ronny Mauricio** in 2021.

SUPER STANLEY: OF **Stanley Consuegra** is also in the midst of his best offensive stretch of the season...Consuegra is on a 10-game on-base streak and has a hit in 16 of his last 18 games since May 17 at Bowling Green...During that time, he's hitting .338/.443/.708 with a 1.151 OPS...The Dominican native has scored 12 runs and added six doubles, six home runs, and 18 RBI...Consuegra has raised his batting average by 64 points (.171 to .235) and his OPS by 244 points (.519 to .763) during the stretch...Since that date, the 23-year-old is tied for the South Atlantic League lead in home runs (6) and is second or tied for second in RBI (18), slugging (.708), OPS (1.151), extra-base hits (12), and total bases (46)...On the year, Consuegra is tied for eighth in the league in RBI (29).

YOU'LL GET NOTHING AND LIKE IT: RHPs **Dakota Hawkins** (5.0 IP), **Joey Lancellotti** (1.0), and **Joshua Cornielli** (3.0) combined on the first nine-inning no-hitter in Brooklyn Cyclones history in Tuesday's 3-0 win vs. Aberdeen...The only previous no-hitter came on August 23, 2009, when RHP **Brandon Moore** tossed a seven-inning no-no in a 5-0 win during Game 1 of a doubleheader at Aberdeen...It is just the third no-hitter in Minor League Baseball in 2024...LHP **Chayce McDermott**, RHP **Nolan Hoffman**, and RHP **Kaleb Ort** combined on a 2-0 no-hitter for Baltimore's Triple-A Norfolk on May 3 vs. Nashville...RHP **Dylan Cumming**, RHP **Nick Sinacola**, and LHP **Seth Corry** of San Francisco's High-A Eugene combined on a 4-0 no-no on April 17 vs. Vancouver...Tuesday's effort was the first no-hitter by a Mets minor league affiliate since RHP **Joander Suárez** hurled a seven-inning one on September 7 at Hartford...It was also the first nine-inning no-hitter thrown in the borough of Brooklyn since RHP **Sal Maglie** tossed a no-no for the Dodgers against the Philadelphia Phillies on September 25, 1956, at Ebbets Field.

SHUT OUT THE LIGHTS: The Cyclones' pitching staff earned its seventh shutout victory in Tuesday's 3-0 no-hit win vs. Aberdeen...On Sunday, Brooklyn earned its sixth of the season in a 7-0 triumph at Jersey Shore...The Cyclones had a season-high 23.2 consecutive scoreless innings since two out in the fifth inning on Saturday snapped on 3B **Mac Horvath's** one-out RBI single in the third inning on Wednesday...The Cyclones have shut out opponents in back-to-back games twice in 2024...Brooklyn's blanking of the BlueClaws on Sunday marked the team's first shutout since May 4's 4-0 and May 3's 2-0 wins vs.

vs. ABERDEEN: Brooklyn returns home for a six-game series against the Orioles' High-A affiliate...Aberdeen possess six of Philadelphia's top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: OF **Enrique Bradfield Jr.** (5), INF **Mac Horvath** (11), LHP **Luis De León** (17), RHP **Jackson Baumeister** (18), RHP **Carter Baumler** (28), and C **Creed Willems** (29)...The Cyclones captured the first meeting at Maimonides Park, winning 4-of-6...In 2023, Brooklyn went 7-5 against Aberdeen on Coney Island and 3-3 at Leidos Field...Dating back to 2002, Brooklyn leads the all-time series since 2021, 133-116 (.534).

Aberdeen...The seven shutouts are tied for the second-most in the South Atlantic League and tied for the fourth-most in Minor League Baseball...In 2023, the Cyclones set a franchise record with 11 shutouts.

NECK AND NECK DOWN THE STRETCH: Including Saturday, 11 games remain in the First Half of the South Atlantic League season...The Cyclones are tied with Jersey Shore for second in the North Division...Brooklyn is 1.5 games back of first-place Greensboro...The Grasshoppers hold the lead in the division even though they did not play an in-division opponent until this week, as the Jersey Shore BlueClaws travel to North Carolina.

MARVELOUS MORABITO: OF **Nick Morabito** has been as good as any offensive player in Minor League Baseball in 2024...Morabito is fifth in Minor League Baseball in on-base percentage (.462)...He is also ninth in batting average (.345) and tied for 10th in stolen bases (26)...Since making his South Atlantic League debut on May 7, the former second-round pick is tied for second in the league lead in steals (15) and tied for third in runs scored (22).

BUZZIN' ON THE BOARDWALK: INF **Wilfredo Lara**, INF **Junior Tillen**, and C **Chris Suero** have caught fire over the last few weeks...In his last 16 games since May 19, Lara is hitting .321/.424/.518 with an .942 OPS, adding a double, two triples, two home runs, and eight RBI...Tillen enters Saturday on a team-season-long 17-game on-base streak since Game 2 of May 16's doubleheader at Bowling Green...The streak is the second-longest active in the South Atlantic League behind Bowling Green's OF **Jhon Díaz** (18)...The 20-year-old has posted a .286/.395/.349 line with a .744 OPS, adding eight runs scored, two doubles, a triple, five RBI, and 11 walks...The 17-game streak is Brooklyn's longest since INF **William Lugo** reached in 18-straight from August 23, 2023, until April 6, 2024...Since May 17, Suero has reached safely in 13 of 14 games...The 20-year-old is hitting .319/.467/.468 with a .935 OPS, 15 runs scored, a double, two home runs, 12 RBI, and 12 walks.

START ME UP: The Cyclones' starting rotation has been one of the best in Minor League Baseball in 2024...Brooklyn holds the best ERA for starting pitchers in the South Atlantic League at 2.99...The Cyclones have the only starting staff with a sub-3.00 ERA in the circuit and hold a mark 0.44 runs better than the next team (Rome: 3.43)...That ERA is also second at the High-A level and sixth among full-season MiLB squads...Arizona's High-A Hillsboro holds the best mark in the minors and the level (2.55).

HOME COOKING: The Cyclones enter play on Saturday with a 19-9 record at Maimonides Park, but a 11-16 record in opposing ballparks...So far in 2024, Brooklyn is a perfect 4-0 in home series...The 'Clones haven't lost a home series since Hudson Valley took four of six from August 15-20, 2023...Brooklyn holds the sixth-best home ERA (2.71) in Minor League Baseball...Arizona's High-A Hillsboro (2.27) has the lowest mark at the High-A level, while Texas' Single-A Down East leads MiLB (2.16)...The eight home runs allowed at Maimonides Park is tied for the sixth-fewest at home in MiLB...In visiting parks, the Cyclones' ERA is 4.80.

LARRUPIN' LORUSSO: INF **Nick Lorusso** has quietly been one of the top hitters in the South Atlantic League in 2024...Amongst South Atlantic League batters, Lorusso tied for fourth in triples (3), eighth in slugging (.494), ninth in OPS (.869), and tied for ninth in total bases (84).

ATOP THE HEJ-ES: RHP **Josh Hejka** earned his first save of the season on May 5 vs. Aberdeen, making his Cyclones' franchise-record-setting 48th pitching appearance in the process...The 27-year-old broke a tie with **Hunter Parsons** (47) for the most pitching appearances in Cyclones franchise history...In his 57 career outings for Brooklyn since 2019, Hejka has accumulated a 5-1 record with a 2.41 ERA (25 ER in 93.1 IP) and 6 saves, walking just 22 and striking out 83.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: The Brooklyn Cyclones have several Top 30 prospects according to *Baseball America* and MLB Pipeline...The 'Clones have three of the Top 30 per BA: **Kade Morris** (21), **Jonah Tong** (22) and **Calvin Ziegler** (29)...Ziegler is currently on the full-season injured list...Plus four of the Top 30 per MiLB: Tong (20), Ziegler (23), **Wilfredo Lara** (24), and OF **Nick Morabito** (26).

LAST TIME OUT: Picked up his second-straight no-decision in an abbreviated start at Jersey Shore last Sunday...Did not allow a run on two hits over 4.1 innings...Walked one and struck out three...Relieved by RHP **Jake Stevenson** with a man at first and one out in the bottom of the fifth with Brooklyn leading 3-0...Morris, Stevenson (1.2 IP), RHP **Jimmy Loper** (2.0), and RHP **Brett Banks** (1.0) combined on a two-hit shut-out as the Cyclones blanked the BlueClaws, 7-0.

PROSPECT RADAR: Morris is considered the New York Mets' No. 21 prospect in 2024 according to *Baseball America*...He is the highest-rated prospect on the Cyclones' roster per the publication.

KADE YOU DIG IT: Morris has been outstanding since joining the Cyclones roster from Single-A St. Lucie...Since making his debut on May 22 vs. Hudson Valley, the 21-year-old is fourth in the South Atlantic League in WHIP (0.91), tied for fourth in batting average against (.170), and sixth in ERA (1.17).

2024: Joined the Cyclones from Single-A St. Lucie on May 20...Made seven appearances (six starts) in the Florida State League...Posted an 0-3 record with a 3.63 ERA (14 ER in 34.2 IP), 11 walks, and 38 strikeouts...Struck out a career-high nine over five innings in a loss at Bradenton on May 9...Tallied a career-best 7.0-shut-out innings of work in his final start on May 15 at Palm Beach...Punched out 27 (28.13 K%) and walked five (5.21 BB%) in his final 22.0 innings in the circuit.

2023: Signed with the Mets as a third-round selection on July 15 for \$666,500...Assigned to the Florida Complex League Mets on August 17...Made one start on August 17 at the FCL Marlins...Allowed one unearned run on one hit in 1.0 inning...Transferred to Single-A St. Lucie on September 6...Made one start on September 7 vs. Daytona...Permitted one run on one hit over 2.1 innings...Walked two and struck out three...Returned to the FCL on September 8.
