By the Numbers

Lake County has 3 walk-off wins this season, all of which have come against Fort Wayne. The Captains scored on a walk-off error on April 30 versus the TinCaps, a Jose Devers walk-off walk on May 1, and a Maick Collado walk-off single on June 14.

Since June 1, Lake County pitching ranks tied for 2nd in 138 Minor League Baseball with 138 strikeouts. Lake County also ranks 5th in MiLB with a 2.53 ERA in June.

> The Captains have stolen 96 bases through 61 games, their most through the first 65 games of a season since at least 2005. Lake County ranks 2nd in Minor League Baseball with an 88.9% stolen base percentage.

CAPTAINS LOG

LAST TIME OUT: 1B Maick Collado hit a walk-off single in the 10th inning to give Lake County a 3-2 comeback victory over Fort Wayne on Friday at Classic Auto Group Park.

Fort Wayne tacked on 2 runs in the top of the 4th on an RBI single by RF Kai Murphy and an RBI groundout by CF Joshua Mears. Lake County answered when LF Jorge Burgos belted a solo homer off the scoreboard in right field.

In the bottom of the 9th, the Captains got a lead-off single from 1B Jake Fox, MLB Pipeline's No. 18 Cleveland prospect, and a 1-out single from SS Jose Devers, MLB Pipeline's No. 19 Cleveland prospect. RF Jonah Advincula then forced extra innings with a game-tying RBI single.

After RHP Zane Morehouse pitched a 1-2-3 10th, the Captains put runners on 1st and 2nd for Collado on a walk by C Cooper Ingle wth Devers being the ghost runner on second. Collado's single propelled ake County to its 7th win in its last 10 games.

BULLISH PEN: Captains RHP's Zach Jacobs and Zane Morehouse combined for 5 shutout innings, 1 hit allowed, 10 strikeouts and 1 walk on Friday. Since June 1, the Lake County bullpen leads High-A and is 4th in MiLB with a 1.48 ERA (7 earned runs in 42.2 innings).

JONAH'S JUNE: OF Jonah Advincula ranks 4th in the Midwest League with a .387 batting average and .486 on-base percentage in June. Advincula has reached base in 8 of his last 9 starts and is 4-for-9 with 2 doubles and 1 RBI in his last 2 games.

HEY DRIVER: RHP Jay Driver pitched 1 shutout inning Tuesday to extend his scoreless appearance streak to 13 games, the longest in the MWL this season, and tied for the 4th-longest active streak in MiLB.

Driver has tossed 16.1 consecutive scoreless innings during this span.

PROSPECTING: Captains INF Angel Genao was ranked Baseball America's No. 65 overall prospect on their updated Top 100 Prospects ist. Other Cleveland minor leaguers on the list: OF Chase DeLauter (#31, Double-A), 1B Kyle Manzardo (#61, MLB), OF Jaison Chourio #82, Single-A), and 1B Ralphy Velazquez (#85, Single-A).

LC-FW CONNECTIONS: TinCaps manager Mike Daly worked in the Cleveland Baseball Operations Department from 2000-01, and as an Area Scout from 2003-06. Lake County INF Alex Mooney and Fort Wayne INF Jay Beshears were 2023 college teammates at Duke and drafted 28 picks apart in the 6th and 7th rounds of the 2023 MLB Draft.

21ST SEASON OF CAPTAINS BASEBALL: 2024 marks the 21st season of Captains Baseball. After the Columbus RedStixx were purchased in 2003, they were moved to Eastlake and became the Lake County Captains. In 2,795 regular-season games, Lake County has an all-time ecord of 1,410-1,385 (.504).

WINNING WAVES: The Captains have had a winning record in 13 of their first 20 seasons, including in each of their last 4 campaigns. Lake County has nade 7 playoff appearances in franchise history (5 Midwest League, 2 South Atlantic League), with its 2010 Midwest League Championship being its sole itle in franchise history

TRENDS & NOTABLES

OH, OH, OH, IT'S MAGIC: Lake County's magic number to clinch the Midwest League East First Half Division title is 2 with 5 games left in he 1st half. In 21 seasons, the Captains have won First Half titles in 2003 South Atlantic League), 2008 (South Atlantic League), and 2010 (Midwest eague), the same year they won their lone Midwest League title. Lake County clinches the MWL East First Half Division Title tonight with a win over Fort Wayne and a Great Lakes loss at Dayton.

PARKER MESSICK NAMED TO TEAM OF THE WEEK: For the 2nd time in the last 3 weeks, LHP Parker Messick was named to MLB Pipeline's MiLB Prospect Team of the Week, being recognized as the top left-handed starting pitcher in Minor League Baseball during the week of 6/3-6/9. On June 6 at Beloit, Messick struck out professional high-tying 11 batters in 5.2 shutout frames, his most since 8/9/2023 versus South Bend.

WELCOME TO RAKE COUNTY: Through 61 games, the Captains have tallied 535 hits, their most through 61 games since 2007 (345). Lake County leads the Midwest League in AVG (.263), hits (535), and OBP

TO THE MOON: INF Alex Mooney, MLB Pipeline's No. 20 Cleveland prospect is 1 of 10 players in Minor League Baseball with 20+ extra base hits and 20+ stolen bases in 2024. Mooney ranks tied for 1st among Minor League 3rd basemen with 21 SB and tied for 9th with 39 RS.

ALL ABOARD THE "TUGBOAT": LHP Matt "Tugboat" Wilkinson has struck out 8+ batters in 3 of his 1st 4 High-A starts. Wilkinson leads MiLB with 96 strikeouts in 55.1 innings. If Wilkinson strikes out 1 hitter in his next start, he will become the fastest starter in Single-A history to reach 100 strikeouts since 2011, when Asheville LHP Edwar Cabrera

NO SURRENDER: The Captains own 3 of the top 5 spots on the Midwest League batting average leaderboard. INF Nate Furman (.338, T-1st), 1B/LF C.J. Kayfus (.338, T-1st), and OF Guy Lipscomb (.329, 4th) are ake County's 3 qualified hitters batting over .300. INF Alex Mooney (.294, 14th), also ranks in top-15. Additionally, C Cooper Ingle's .328 AVG anks 5th among MWL hitters with 120+ ABs this season.

TOP QUALITY: Through 60 games, Lake County starting pitchers have recorded 18 quality starts (6+ IP, 3-or-fewer earned runs), which are tied for the 3rd-most in High-A, and tied for the 9th-most in MiLB. RHPs Austin Peterson (6), Carter Spivey (5), Trenton Denholm (4), and LHP Parker Messick (3), MLB Pipeline's No. 21 Cleveland prospect, have all recorded quality starts for the Captains this year.

CAN'T START A FIRE WITHOUT A SPARK: The Lake County starting rotation is among the best in the Midwest League, leading the MWL in vins (23), innings pitched (306.0), and strikeouts (310) while ranking 2nd in WHIP (1.19) and fewest walks (78).

HE COULD THROW THAT SPEEDBALL BY YOU: RHP Austin Peterson is the only pitcher in Minor and Major League Baseball to have 75+ strikeouts and 6-or-fewer walks in 2024. The right-hander leads the Midwest League in strikeouts (77), quality starts (6), innings pitched (70.1), and WHIP (0.90), while ranking 2nd in ERA (2.69).

LAST TIME OUT: Trenton Denholm (7-1) posted his team high 7th win on June 9 at Beloit in Lake County's 5-3 victory. **Denholm** went 5 innings, allowing 2 runs on 2 hits while striking out 6 and walking 3 on 74 pitches (49 strikes). **Denholm has allowed just 2 hits in 3 starts this season.**

MIDWEST LEAGUE RANKS: Denholm ranks top-10 in the Midwest League in: Wins (7, tied for 1st), WHIP (0.95, 2nd), innings pitched (61.1, 4th), ERA (3.08, 5th), and opposing AVG (.212, 6th). He is also 1 of just 3 Midwest League pitchers to throw a complete game this season, and 1 of 2 to toss a shutout. (May 10 versus Dayton).

THE GREAT EIGHT: In his last start at Classic Auto Group Park on May 22 versus West Michigan, Denholm pitched a Minor League-best 8.1 innings, the most by a Lake County pitcher since RHP Joe Colón also pitched 8.1 frames on 5/14/2022 vs. Great Lakes. Denholm allowed 3 runs on 5 hits while not recording a strikeout. He is the first Captain since at least 2005 to throw 8-plus innings without recording a strikeout.

MIDWEST LEAGUE PITCHER OF THE WEEK: Denholm earned Midwest League Pitcher of the Week honors the week of May 6-12 after tossing a complete game shutout in 7 innings on May 10 versus Dayton. <u>Denholm pitched Lake County's 1st 7-inning complete game since current</u> Double-A Akron RHP Aaron Davenport recorded a CG SHO on Sept. 4, 2022 at Great Lakes.

HILLCAT ON THE HILL: Denholm pitched his 1st professional season in 2022, making 23 starts for the Single-A Lynchburg Hillcats. The right-hander finished the season with a 5-5 record, 4.79 ERA, and 107 strikeouts in 97.2 innings pitched.

AWESOME ANTEATER: Denholm had a strong collegiate career in his four seasons at UC Irvine. As a sophomore in 2019, the right-hander was named the 2019 Big West Pitcher of the Year, as well as a *Collegiate Baseball Newspaper* 3rd Team All-American, after finishing the campaign with a 9-4 record, 1.81 ERA, and 93 strikeouts in 99.2 innings pitched. This season resulted in **Denholm** being invited to the USA Collegiate National Team training camp, and being named to the Golden Spikes Award Watch List prior to both the 2020 and 2021 seasons.

OTHER NOTABLE ANTEATERS: Three-time all-star and former Boston/Baltimore/Cleveland OF Brady Anderson (1983-85), Keston Hiura (2015-17), former Cleveland pitcher David Huff (2004).

BASEBALL IN THE FAMILY: Denholm is related to former MLB catcher Rod Barajas. He played 14 MLB seasons with seven different teams, notably winning a World Series with the 2001 Arizona Diamondbacks. Barajas hit .235 in his MLB career, with 812 hits, 136 home runs, 480 RBI, and 187 doubles.

CAPTAINS TO THE MAINLAND

4 former Lake County Captains have been promoted to MLB during the 2024 season.

INF Daniel Schneemann: On Sunday, June 2, **INF Daniel Schneemann** made his MLB debut at home for the Cleveland Guardians against the Washington Nationals. He started at 2nd base and batted 8th in the Guardians' order, going 1-for-3 with a 2-run double on his first MLB pitch and a strikeout. **Schneemann** played 98 regular-season games for the Captains across the 2018, 2019, and 2021 seasons, hitting .267 with 86 hits, 13 doubles, 3 triples, 5 home runs, 43 RBI, 12 stolen bases, and a .711 OPS. He also played 3 postseason games for Lake County in 2019, hitting .182 (2-for-11) with 2 runs, 2 RBI, and 1 walk.

1B/OF Trenton Brooks: On Tuesday, May 28, **1B/OF Trenton Brooks** made his MLB debut at home for the San Francisco Giants against the Philadelphia Phillies. He started at 1st base and batted 9th in the Giants' order, going 0-for-2 with 1 strikeout. **Brooks** played 29 games for the Captains in 2017, hitting .214 with 24 hits, 5 doubles, 1 home run, 8 RBI, 12 walks, and a .588 OPS.

OF Johnathan Rodríguez: On Tuesday, May 21, **OF Johnathan Rodríguez** made his MLB debut at home for the Cleveland Guardians against the New York Mets. He started in right field and batted 7th in the Guardians' order, going 0-for-4 with 2 strikeouts. **Rodríguez** played 103 games for the Captains across the 2021 and 2022 seasons, hitting .275 with 103 hits, 20 doubles, 23 home runs, 70 RBI, and an .862 OPS. In 2022, he led the Midwest League with 21 home runs.

RHP Cade Smith: On Saturday, March 30, RHP Cade Smith made his MLB debut for the Cleveland Guardians on the road against the Oakland Athletics. He pitched 2 scoreless, hitless innings of relief, allowing just 1 walk and throwing 5 strikeouts. Smith made 23 relief appearances for the Captains across the 2021 and 2022 seasons, going 2-1 with a 2.67 ERA, 48 strikeouts, a 1.11 WHIP, and a .156 opposing batting average, converting 6 of his 7 save opportunities.
