### LAST TIME OUT

The Baysox recorded their ninth shutout win of the season on Tuesday with a 5-0 victory over Altoona to win their sixth game in their last seven. Bowie scored three runs in the first two innings as **Jud Fabian** hit a two-run homer in the first and a sacrifice fly in the second. **Enrique Bradfield Jr.** collected his first Double-A hit and RBI on one swing with sharp single to right field. Starting right-hander **Alex Pham** pitched five shutout innings with six strikeouts and **Dan Hammer** and **Levi Stoudt** combined for four shutout innings of relief.

### IF YOU AIN'T FIRST, YOU'RE LAST

Bowie has scored in the first inning in six of the last seven games. When the Baysox score first, they are 35-17 this season compared to 16-40 when they do not. The Baysox have scored the 3rd-most first inning runs in the Eastern League (62).

### BASALLO BASHES

C/1B **Samuel Basallo**, the Orioles '24 All-Star Futures Game selection, turned 20 yesterday. The No. 3 O's/No. 11 MLB prospect is tied for the Eastern League lead in total bases (166) and is tied for 2nd among active Eastern League players in hits (102). Basallo is leading all qualified Eastern League hitters in August with a .381 batting average (16-for-42).

### BRADFIELD TO BOWIE

OF **Enrique Bradfield Jr.** made his Double-A debut yesterday and recorded his first Double-A hit and RBI on a single to right in the 4th. At the time of promotion, the Orioles 2023 first rounder stole 59 bases, which led the South Atlantic League and was second in all of Minor League Baseball.

### THE FABULOUS FABIAN

OF **Jud Fabian** retook the Eastern League lead in home runs with his 18th on the season last night. Amongst all Double-A hitters, he is tied for 3rd in home runs. The O's No. 13 prospect has 33 career home runs with the Baysox, the 13th Baysox player in franchise history to eclipse 30 career homers.

### BENCOSME BARRELS

IF **Frederick Bencosme** recorded his first four-RBI game at Double-A with his first career grand slam on Friday. The 21-year-old has tallied a hit in 14 of his last 17 games. Over his last 15 games, he is batting .388 (19-for-49) with three doubles, two homers and 11 RBI.

### LEAVE IT TO BEAVERS

OF **Dylan Beavers** has reached base in 76 of 94 games played this season. The Orioles No. 8 prospect is 2nd in the Eastern League in walks (53) and fourth in stolen bases (25).

### SECOND HALF SILAS

C **Silas Ardoin** is batting a team-best .373 since the All-Star Break with an on-base percentage of .484 and OPS of .915. The 23-year-old has hits in 10 of his last 11 games with multi-hit performances in five of those contests. Defensively, Ardoin has been one of the best backstops in the Eastern League. His 23 base runners caught stealing is third-most in the circuit.

### TROUBLE WITH THE CURVE

Entering this week, the Altoona Curve are tied for fourth in the Southwest Division with a record of 16-23. The Double-A affiliate of the Pirates has won 10 of the last 11 games against the Baysox. Three of the Pirates top 30 prospects are on the Curve active roster - LHP Anthony Solometo (No. 7), LHP Hunter Barco (No. 8), IF Tsung-Che Cheng (No. 18).

### TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

LHP Anthony Solometo makes his 12th start of the season for the Curve. The Pirates No. 7 prospect returned to Altoona on August 8 after spending the last month in Florida with FCL - Pirates and Single-A Bradenton to work on his mechanics. The southpaw lasted only 1.2 innings in Portland in a no-decision. The 21-year-old holds a 3.86 career ERA against the Baysox in three starts but lasted only 2.2 innings in his most recent start on April 21.

**Arsenal:** 4-Seam (93-95), Splitter (84-87), Slider (78-80), Cutter (86-88)  
**Drafted in the 16th round by the Orioles in 2021 out of UC Irvine**  
**Entering second season with the Baysox and fourth season in O's system**

**2024: Recorded fourth scoreless start of season on 8/6 vs HBG with season-high 5.0 shutout IP and 6 K. Has six or more strikeouts in four of six outings this season. Threw 15 consecutive scoreless innings across first four outings after being activated off 60-day IL on 7/4. Baysox are 3-2 when he starts.** Struck out season-high seven over 4.0 scoreless, hitless innings of relief on 7/19 vs HFD. Started first two outings of season and threw at least four scoreless innings each. Began season on 60-day IL. Sent on a rehab assignment to FCL Orioles on 6/4 before continuing rehab assignment in High-A Aberdeen on 6/16. In three rehab starts with IronBirds, threw 10 IP and struck out 13 over 3 BB to a 6.30 ERA.

**2023:** Spent entire season with Double-A Bowie primarily as a starter. Posted a 6.04 ERA in 18 games (11 starts) over 53.2 innings with 70 strikeouts. Struck out sixth-most batters on the team. Punched out five or more batters eight times. Did give up 12 homers, tied for fourth-most. Was on the IL from 7/13 - 8/19. Returned from the IL on 8/19 and made five appearances to finish out season. Pitched in the Arizona Fall League for Mesa Solar Sox. Appeared in five games (two starts) and threw 9.2 innings with 15 strikeouts over nine walks.

**2022:** Spent entire season with High-A Aberdeen. Pitched in 24 games (14 starts) and threw 88.2 innings with 97 strikeouts to a 3.25 ERA. Recorded most wins (11) and 10th-most IP in O's system. Threw five scoreless innings as part of a combined no-hitter on 6/18. Started two postseason games and allowed just one run over nine innings, including four scoreless innings in South Atlantic League Championship Series.

**2021:** Debuted professionally with Single-A Delmarva. Pitched in six games (two starts) and struck out 16 batters over 13 innings without allowing a walk.

**College/Personal:** Drafted by the Orioles in the 16th round of the 2021 Draft out of UC Irvine. Posted a career 4.03 ERA in 19 appearances (18 starts) across 96 innings. Transferred to UC Irvine in 2020 after spending two seasons at Ohlone College. Oldest of six siblings. Has worked as a baseball umpire. Native of Pleasanton, CA. Grew up rooting for Bay Area pro sports teams.

During select games during the 2024 season, the Baysox will take the field as the Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake, as the Baysox look to continue to embrace the culture of local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake" identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.



### CHESAPEAKE BAYSOX

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the "Chesapeake Baysox." This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stenciled outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince George's Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.



### BOWIE PIT BEEF

The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s.



## COACHING STAFF

### ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

The 17th manager in Baysox franchise history, Mercado spent each of the past two seasons as the manager of the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds. He was honored with the Orioles organization's Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award following his first season with Aberdeen in 2022. Prior to the start of his professional career, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut. He began as an assistant coach in 2004 before being promoted to head varsity coach in 2011. In addition to coaching the New Britain baseball team, Mercado served as the Dean of Students for over 18 years. He also spent time as an assistant coach of the Yarmouth Dennis Red Sox in the Cape Cod Baseball League from 2014-2022 and was a coach in the Goodwill Series, where high school baseball players from the United States competed overseas in both Australia and New Zealand in 2017 and 2018.

### AUSTIN MEINE

Pitching Coach

Meine joins Mercado on the move from High-A Aberdeen. Meine served as the IronBirds pitching coach in 2023, where he helped Aberdeen post the third-lowest ERA (3.81) and second-most strikeouts (1,363) across the South Atlantic League. He previously spent two seasons on staff at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, where he guided the 49ers to the two highest single-season strikeout totals in program history. Meine has also worked on staff at the Premier Pitching and Performance facility in Missouri. He pitched collegiately at Lindenwood University.

### JOSH BUNSELMAYER

Hitting Coach

Bunselmayer served as the hitting coach for the Orioles' Single-A affiliate, the Delmarva Shorebirds, last season. 2024 is Bunselmayer's fifth season in the Orioles' system after also spending the previous three campaigns as a hitting coach in both the Florida Complex League and Dominican Summer League. He played three seasons in the Independent Frontier League following a collegiate playing career at Saint Louis University.

### CHASE SEBBY

Fundamentals Coach

Sebbly joins the Baysox staff as the Fundamentals Coach in 2024. Sebbly was the fundamentals coach in Aberdeen last season and was a development coach within the Orioles' organization in 2022. Sebbly played collegiately as a catcher at Cypress College and Ball State.

### BILLY FACTEAU

Development Coach

A familiar face in Bowie, Facteau rejoins the Baysox staff in 2024. Facteau was the development coach in Aberdeen last season, but began his professional coaching career as a development coach on the Baysox staff in 2022.
