ABOUT LAST NIGHT... The Sea Dogs walked off the Senators 5-4 on Thursday night, capitalizing on a string of Harrisburg errors and a pair of hits to plate the winning runs. **Ahbram Liendo** was the walk-off hero, coming through with a hard hit single into right field to score the winning run. Liendo had another single and a home run, scoring twice while driving in two of the Sea Dogs' five runs. **Tyler McDonough** helped him carry the offense, driving in two runs and scoring once with an RBI single and a home run. In his Delta Dental Park debut, **LHP Tyler Davis** allowed just one hit while pitching two scoreless innings in the eighth and ninth, keeping the Sea Dogs within striking distance. Davis earned the win, his first in Double-A.

WALK IT OFF LIENDO! Ahbram Liendo's game-winning single last night was his third walk-off hit of the season, doing so on April 9 against New Hampshire, and July 4 against Altoona. Liendo has scored the winning run in two more of the Sea Dogs' walk-off wins, doing so on both June 16 and June 20 against Somerset. Liendo has been directly involved in the Sea Dogs last four straight walkoffs.

CLOSE CALLS After last night's ninth-inning comeback, the Sea Dogs are 15-3 in one-run games at home this season. They have eight walk-off wins. The Sea Dogs have played 47 home games this season; 30 of them, approximately 64%, have been decided by three or fewer runs, with 18 one-run games, eight two-run games, and four three-run games.

ROSARIO'S MONTH Ronald Rosario has back-to-back multi-hit games with two doubles, two walks and an RBI to start this week's series. Rosario is tied with Brooks Brannon for the second most home runs by an Eastern League player this month (7). He leads the Eastern League in SLG% (.754) for players with 50+ at bats in the month, and his 19 RBI in July is tied for the second best mark in the league. Overall in July, Rosario is batting .328 with eight multi-hit games.

EASTERN LEAGUE PITCHER OF THE WEEK RHP Max Carlson has been named the Eastern League Pitcher of the Week for July 20-26. Carlson made two dominant relief appearances during Portland's series in Binghamton. Over 5.2 scoreless innings, the right-hander did not allow a hit, surrendered just one walk, and struck out seven batters. Carlson becomes the fifth Sea Dogs pitcher to earn Eastern League Pitcher of the Week honors this season, joining RHP Blake Wehunt (June 22-28, June 30-July 5), RHP Anthony Eyanson (May 18-24), RHP Patrick Halligan (May 11-17), and RHP John Holobetz (April 13-19).

WALKIN' WILL TURNER Will Turner recorded his 61st and 62nd walks of the season on Thursday. He is the Eastern League leader in that category, and 4th best in Double-A despite spending two weeks of the season on the injured list. Though his batting average sits at .180, Turner's .375 on-base percentage is ninth best among qualified Eastern League players.

THIS DAY IN SEA DOGS HISTORY July 31, 2001 – Kevin Olsen fired a complete game 4-hitter, fanning 12 batters and not allowing a runner past second base as the Sea Dogs blanked Norwich, 6-0.

ON THE MOUND RHP Anthony Eyanson (4-0, 1.45 ERA), the top pitching prospect in the Red Sox system, will make his eleventh appearance and tenth start for the Sea Dogs this season, after making five starts for High-A Greenville in April and May (0-0, 0.44 ERA). Eyanson earned the win for the American League in the 2026 MLB All-Star Futures Game. He was named South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Month in April after recording a 0.54 ERA in four starts, and earned an Eastern League Pitcher of the Week recognition after his second Double-A start. Overall for Portland, Eyanson has allowed eight runs, seven earned, on 24 hits with 21 walks and 50 strikeouts in 43.1 innings pitched. After winning the 2025 MCWS with LSU, Eyanson was drafted by the Red Sox in the third round of the 2025 MLB First-Year Player Draft

Leading the Sea Dogs

Acting Manager - Kyle Sasala

Kyle Sasala enters his third season on the Portland staff after a highly successful tenure at Grove City College, where he served as Associate Head Coach from 2016 to 2023. During his time with the Wolverines, Sasala played a key role in the program's rise, highlighted by a school-record 30-win season in 2023 and a 16-4 conference mark. He also helped guide Grove City to a then-record 28 victories in 2019 alongside head coach Matt Royer. Sasala later stepped in as interim head coach for the Eastern College Athletic Conference Division III Championship Tournament, leading the Wolverines to a runner-up finish.

Pitching Coach - Juan Rivera

Juan Rivera also returns to the Sea Dogs coaching staff as a pitching coach for his second season. In 2025, Rivera helped guide a Portland pitching staff that recorded 1,435 strikeouts, the second-most in the Eastern League, while posting a 3.65 team ERA, the fourth-best mark in the league. Rivera spent the previous three seasons as the Salem Red Sox' pitching coach, where he led the staff to a 3.61 ERA, the fourth-best in Single-A. A graduate of Eastern Nazarene College, Rivera has been part of the Boston Red Sox organization since 2022, serving as a Development Coach with Salem before joining the Sea Dogs coaching staff.

Hitting Coach - Trevor Burmeister

Trevor Burmeister joins the Sea Dogs coaching staff as hitting coach after spending the previous five seasons in the Colorado Rockies organization. Burmeister began his coaching career immediately following his collegiate playing career at the University of Wisconsin-La Crosse, where he spent two seasons on the coaching staff. He then served one season at the University of Minnesota Duluth, where the offense ranked third nationally in NCAA Division II with a .352 team batting average and second in the nation with 102 home runs. Burmeister later returned to his alma mater, Madison College (NJCAA), spending three seasons under head coach Mike Davenport. During his time there, he was named the 2019 NJCAA Assistant Coach of the Year by the American Baseball Coaches Association and Baseball America.

Defensive Coach - Kyle Schmidt

Kyle Schmidt joins the Sea Dogs as defensive coach after spending two years with the Red Sox' Single-A affiliate, the Salem Ridge Yaks. Originally from Smithville, TX, Kyle attended the University of Richmond and became a starting catcher for the Spider Baseball Team. Following his 2019 season, Kyle was drafted in the 33rd Round of the 1st Year Player Draft by the Minnesota Twins. Kyle voluntarily retired after the 2023 season. During his playing career, Kyle played at every Minor League level while also being involved in multiple Major League Spring Trainings.

Athletic Trainer - Kelsey Branstetter

Kelsey Branstetter joins the staff as Portland's Athletic Trainer, her first year with the Sea Dogs and second season in the Red Sox organization. She spent last season as the Athletic Trainer for the Greenville Drive (High-A) and served in the same role for Triple-A Louisville (Cincinnati Reds) from 2023-2024. Branstetter graduated from Middle Tennessee State University, where she played four years of soccer. Following her undergraduate studies, Branstetter obtained a master's degree from Wichita State University.

Strength and Conditioning Coach - Jonah Mondloch

Strength and Conditioning Coach Jonah Mondloch returns to the staff for his second season in Portland and his third year in the Red Sox organization. He previously served as an Assistant Rehab Strength and Conditioning Coach, where he supported the strength and conditioning programs for players returning to the field. In that role, he collaborated closely with Major League sports performance and on-field staff to ensure the highest level of care for injured athletes.

2026 in Portland Overall for Portland, Eyanson has allowed 8 runs, 7 earned, on 24 hits with 21 walks and 50 strikeouts in 43.1 innings pitched...After his second start in Double-A, Eyanson earned **Eastern League Pitcher of the Week**. He did not allow a run or a hit while striking out four batters in 5.0 innings pitched. He recently represented the American League in the 2026 MLB All-Star Futures Game, earning the win.

2026 in Greenville earned **South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Month** honors in April for his work opening the season with the Red Sox' High-A affiliate, the Greenville Drive. Eyanson recorded a 0.54 ERA in four April starts, allowing one run on six hits over 16.2 innings, with 27 strikeouts and no walks. Overall, Eyanson made five starts for Greenville to the tune of a 0.44 ERA, allowing seven hits and one run with 34 strikeouts in 20.1 innings of work.

CAREER: Ranked as the top pitching prospect and No. 2 overall prospect in the Red Sox system by MLB.com. He is the No. 51 overall prospect in baseball according to MLB.com.

PERSONAL: Attended the University of California, San Diego (2023-24) and Louisiana State University (2025)...In 2025, posted a 3.00 ERA (36 ER/108.0 IP) with 152 SO (3rd-most in Division I baseball) helping lead LSU to a National Championship...Earned the win in the championship clinching game vs. Coastal Carolina (6.1 IP, 3 R, 7 H, BB, 9 SO)...Was tabbed a First Team All-American by Baseball America, and a Second Team selection by D1 Baseball, ABCA, NCBWA, and Perfect Game...Also named Second-Team All-SEC and to the First-Year SEC Academic Honor Roll...In 2024 at UC San Diego, was a Second-Team All-Big West honoree...In 2024, played summer baseball with the Cotuit Kettleers of the Cape Cod League...Graduated from Lakewood High School (CA)...Notable MLB alumni include, J.P.
