Today: The Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Athletics, play on a Grand Slam School Day and Dog Days of Summer, the second in a six-game series with the Beloit Sky Carp. The Nuts had lost ten straight meetings against Beloit before winning yesterday, Lansing's first win against the Sky Carp since June 21, 2022. (The Nuts were 2-10 vs. Beloit in 2022, did not play at all in 2023, and went 0-5 in Beloit, Wisconsin, last year.

Last Night: Locos 9, Sky Carp 6. Trailing 6-2 entering the sixth inning, Lansing scored one in the sixth and then exploded for six runs in the bottom of the seventh inning, handing Beloit a series-opening defeat. Tommy White went 3-for-5 with a single, double and home run in the win.

Prospecting: The Nuts have six of MLB Pipeline's Top 30 A's prospects: No. 7 prospect (Tommy White), No. 10 (Joshua Kuroda-Grauer), No. 12 (Steven Echavarria), No. 17 (Ryan Lasko), No. 18 (Rodney Green, Jr.) and No. 28 (Nate Nankil).

Lugnuts to The Show: Three Nuts have made their Major League debuts this season: Max Muncy on March 27, Gunnar Hoglund on May 2, and Denzel Clarke on May 23 (with Denzel picking up his first MLB hit last night, an infield single). 196 Lugnuts have now gone from Lansing to the Majors all-time.

Elvis is in the Building: Infielder Elvis Rijo makes his 2025 Lugnuts debut today, becoming the 16th different position player and 35th different player used by the Nuts this season. Rijo was on the Lugnuts' roster from April 16 through May 4 last year, though he played in only one game: April 26 vs. Dayton, going 1-for-3 with a fielding error, single, HBP and two runs scored. Both the single and HBP came in a nine-run eighth inning, which Rijo ignited with a leadoff single to right field; he eventually came to the plate again, was plunked, and thus was able to score both the first and ninth runs of the rally... though the Lugnuts lost the game 14-10.

O Canada: Brampton, ON, native T.J. Schofield-Sam leads the Midwest League with a .354 batting average and 52 base hits this season. Schofield-Sam went 2-for-3 with a single, triple and two HBPs yesterday. He's batting .373/.430/.554 at home, and is especially sizzling in day games with a .393 average (22-for-56).

Tiger-tastic: LSU product Tommy "Tommy Tanks" White has homered in three of his last four games, and now ranks atop the Midwest League with a .959 OPS while ranking second with a .558 slugging percentage and fifth with a .317 batting average. White is batting .438 (7-for-16) in four Wednesday games this season.

Mark it Down: Closer Mark Adamiak is first in the league with eight saves, notching his eighth yesterday in his league-leading 16th appearance. Adamiak has recorded a save in each of his last four appearances. 12 of his 16 appearances this year have been scoreless, and he has allowed one run or fewer in 15 of his 16 appearances.

What a Debut! 2023-24 Lugnuts starter Luis Morales premiered in Triple-A Saturday night with six hitless innings for the Las Vegas Aviators at Sugar Land, striking out seven while walking just one on 88 pitches, and was honored as the Pacific Coast League Pitcher of the Week for his efforts.

Jumpman: 2025 Lugnuts Opening Day starter Gage Jump was not honored by the Texas League, but perhaps he should have been. Jump made two starts for the Double-A Midland RockHounds at Frisco last week, tossing six scoreless innings with eight strikeouts and following up with seven innings, two hits and eight strikeouts. Between Lansing and Midland this season, Jump is 7-1 with a 1.80 ERA in 50 innings, striking out 67, walking just 10 and allowing a .180 batting average with a 0.84 WHIP.

At the Plate: The Lugnuts rank second in the Midwest League in batting average (.261), first in base hits (390), second in doubles (89), second in on-base percentage (.358), third in total bases (586) and are the toughest team to strike out (308), whiffing only twice yesterday.

# History vs. Beloit

The Nuts are 79-77 all-time vs. the Sky Carp, 37-39 in Lansing and 42-38 in Wisconsin. The Lugnuts did not play Beloit in either 2021 or 2023, going 2-10 vs. the Sky Carp in 2022.

In 2003, the Lugnuts met up with Beloit in the Midwest League Championship Series, sweeping the series in three games. It's the Nuts' most recent of their two titles.
