YARD GOATS LEAD WIRE TO WIRE IN DAYTIME DEFEAT: Samad Taylor had the lone RBI for the Fisher Cats, as the Yard Goats put up 12 runs in their 12-1 victory on Wednesday. The Yard Goats homered three times while limiting the Fisher Cats to just five hits. Adrian Hernandez and Brandon Eisert made their debuts for the Fisher Cats in the loss.

UP NEXT: The Fisher Cats will head on their second 12-game road trip of the season following this week. They will first visit Harrisburg (Washington Nationals) before heading to Hartford to close out the season series with the Yard Goats.

LEFT BEHIND? The Fisher Cats will be facing at least one lefty tonight in the form of Hartford starter Nick Bush. The Fisher Cats hit well against southpaws, with a team batting average of .278 and team slugging of .427 against lefties compared to .257/.348 against right-handed pitching.

BOB LIPMAN'S THIS DATE IN FISHER CATS HISTORY: August 5, 2018-The Fisher Cats wrapped a successful 4-2 homestand with a 7-6 win over the Erie SeaWolves at Delta Dental Stadium. Jon Berti's walk-off inside-the-park home run won the game. Patrick Cantwell also homered, and Forrest Wall had three hits---a single, double, and triple, and drove in three runs.

MANCHESTER BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS: The Blue Javs survived a late rally from Cleveland to pick up an 8-6 win. George Springer homered and Corey Dickerson drove home a pair of runs in the winning effort. Dunedin split a double-header with Fort Meyers, winning 5-4 and losing 6-5. Buffalo fell 7-1 to Lehigh Valley, while Vancouver beat Hillsboro 3-2 with Will McAffer picking up the win. The DSL and FCL Jays were both dormant.

RECENT ROSTER MOVES: August 2: Otto Lopez promoted to Triple-A Buffalo and Vinny Capra returned from the Bisons. Pitchers Adrian Hernandez and Brandon Eisert added from Adv. A Vancouver.

## STARTERS:

The all time winningest pitcher in Fisher Cats history will make his 68th career start for New Hampshire tonight, which also is a New Hampshire high. Casey Lawrence is coming off of his first loss at the Double-A level this year, giving up five runs on five hits to the Sea Dogs last weekend. Opponents are hitting .206 against Lawrence over two games so far this year. Lawrence struggled against the Yard Goats in their inaugural year. but has not faced them since 2016.

For Hartford, Nick Bush will get the start. The lefty Bush has struggled this year, posting an ERA of 5.67 at the Double-A level while allowing an opposing batting average of .333. He has faced New Hampshire twice and given up 18 hits and 11 runs over 10 innings. His last outing was an 8.1 inning start against the Rumble Ponies, where he carried a shutout into the ninth before eventually taking the loss. Bush excelled with Advanced-A Spokane, posting four wins and a WHIP of 0.94 before his promotion.


