CURVE CUTS: Roy Reuben "Bubba" Chandler... Was committed to play both football and baseball at Clemson University prior to signing with the Pirates... Was named a Georgia 4-A all-state first-team selection in baseball during his senior season... Was the 2021 Region 8-AAAA Player-of-the-Year in baseball...
