TODAY marks game #102 of the 2023 season, the second game of a six-game roadtrip, and the second game of a six-game series against the Great Lakes Loons. These two teams played 17 times during the 2022 regular season, with the Whitecaps winning the series 9-8, and will play 24 times in 2023. The Whitecaps are a Detroit Tigers affiliate in their 29th season in pro baseball, while Great Lakes is in their 16th year of affiliation with the Los Angeles Dodgers.

UP NEXT: The 'Caps return to LMCU Ballpark for a six-game series against the South Bend Cubs from August 15-August 20 before embarking on a 12-game roadtrip -- their longest of the season before concluding the 2023 regular season in West Michigan against the Loons at LMCU Ballpark.

STORYLINES AND HEADLINES

LAST TIME OUT: The West Michigan Whitecaps saw a dominant performance from their catcher and solid pitching deliver them their eighth-straight victory 6-4 over the Great Lakes Loons in front of 2,384 Tuesday night at Dow Diamond. 'Caps catcher Josh Crouch finished 2-for-4 with a run scored, a double, and a three-run home run. Meanwhile, Whitecaps pitchers posted thirteen strikeouts while holding the Loons to a 1-for-9 mark with runners in scoring position in the victory. The eight-game win stretch ties the longest West Michigan has enjoyed since the 2017 season when they won ten in a row in June of that year. The Whitecaps struck first in the second inning as Crouch delivered a three-run home run, putting the 'Caps in front 3-0. Whitecaps pitchers Dylan Smith, Erick Pinales, and Jack Anderson started the game with five scoreless frames and seven strikeouts before Loons third baseman Taylor Young delivered a solo homer - trimming the advantage to 3-1. 'Caps outfielder Brady Allen opened the seventh with an RBI single before Loon outfielder Jake Vogel and third baseman Taylor Young collected a pair of RBIs in the bottom half - slicing the lead to 4-3. West Michigan added two insurance tallies in the eighth as Dom Johnson added an RBI double before scoring on a wild pitch, extending the advantage to 6-3. Great Lakes mounted a rally in the bottom of the ninth as Young added an RBI double, but 'Caps closer Dario Gardea slammed the door with a pair of strikeouts to earn the 6-4 victory. The Whitecaps improve to 52-49 overall and 20-16 in the second half, while the Loons fall to 63-39 overall and 18-19 in the second half. 'Caps reliever Erick Pinales (4-0) secures his fourth win of the year, going 1.1 innings allowing no runs with two strikeouts as Gardea collects his seventh save. Loons starter Ronan Kopp (0-4) suffers his fourth loss, allowing three runs through 2.2 innings pitched. With their eighth-straight victory, the Whitecaps have tied their longest winning streak under manager Brayan Pena. West Michigan sits just a half-game out of first place in the Midwest League East Division.

TROPICAL DISASTER: The Baltimore Orioles are 6-3 against the Tampa Bay Rays this season and 4-2 at Tropicana Field after their 5-3 win on July 23, despite hitting .192 with a .254 on-base percentage in those contests, scoring 3.3 runs per game. Since the Rays joined Major League Baseball in 1998, Baltimore holds a record of 213-234, with the O's going 116-107 at Camden Yards and 98-127 at 'The Trop.'

IMPOSING HIS WIL-KEL: Tonight's Whitecaps starting pitcher Wilkel Hernandez has allowed just two runs over his last 21 innings pitched while posting a 25-to-2 strikeout-to-walk ratio.

BRINGING THE PENA: Whitecaps pitcher Carlos Pena was named Midwest Player of the Week on July 24. The lefty tossed ten innings while giving up just one run on one base hit while striking out eight batters. The 24-year-old also brought home Midwest League Pitcher of the Month for April earlier this season, and currently holds the third-lowest ERA in the Midwest League at 3.44.

GUARDIAN ANGEL: 'Caps pitcher Angel Reyes now leads the franchise in appearances with 131 over the course of four years with the team.

Acquired: In a trade made by the Tigers along with OF Troy Montgomery from Los Angeles (AL) in a trade for infielder Ian Kinsler on December 13, 2017.

Hernandez is back in West Michigan for the first time in nearly four calendar years -- having last pitched for West Michigan at the end of their run as a Tigers Low-A affiliate in 2019. Hernandez then underwent Tommy John surgery in the canceled COVID-19 season in 2020 and returned to Low-A Lakeland in 2022. Hernandez was once rated the Tigers No. 20 prospect in 2018 by Baseball America.

LAST START: Hernandez’s turned a strong stretch into a dominant one with six innings of three-hit, scoreless baseball while walking two and striking out five as part of 5-1 win over the Fort Wayne TinCaps on August 1 at LMCU Ballpark.

2022: Hernandez posted a respectable 3-5 record with Lakeland and a 4.50 ERA in 14 games and 44 innings. His best month came in May when he collected a 1.23 ERA in five starts and 14.2 IP and just two walks to 23 strikeouts.

2021: Missed the season (injury).

2020: COVID-19 Canceled MiLB Season

2019: Hernandez enjoyed his best professional season, going 9-7 with a 3.73 ERA in 21 games and 101.1 innings pitched, allowing 97 hits and walking 26 with 90 strikeouts.

2018: Hernandez began his 2018 campaign in Connecticut with the short-season New York-Penn League and got hit hard, taking the loss in the only two games he pitched and posting a 7.94 ERA. Despite the numbers, Hernandez struck out nearly two batters per inning with 11 punchouts in 5.2 frames. Upon his arrival in West Michigan, Hernandez stayed competitive but watched his record fall to 2-5.

2017: Hernandez started and relieved with the Los Angeles Angels player development staff and went 4-1 with a 2.64 ERA in 12 games (7 starts). In 44.1 innings between the Arizona Rookie-League Angels and Orem Owls (where he pitched in the same rotation as Whitecaps pitcher Elvin Rodriguez), he allowed just 25 hits in 44.1 IP and gave up 22 walks with 44 strikeouts and permitted opponents a .164 batting average against.

2016: At just 16 years old, Hernandez pitched well in five starts out of the Dominican Summer League, going 2-0 with a 1.20 ERA and allowed 12 hits in 15 frames on six walks and 14 strikeouts.
