**YESTERDAY:** The Flying Squirrels lost to the Fisher Cats, 8-7, in 10 innings. The Fisher Cats opened a 5-0 lead in the second inning. In the fourth, Josh Kasevich hit a solo homer to extend the lead to 6-0. The Flying Squirrels scored seven unanswered runs over the seventh through ninth to take a lead. In the seventh, **Jairo Pomares** hit a solo homer, his fourth of the year, to get Richmond on the scoreboard. Later in the inning, **Dilan Rosario** brought in a run with a sac fly and **Carter Howell** plated a run with a groundout to close the score to 6-3. In the eighth, **Adrián Sugastey** hit an RBI double and Pomares tied the game with a two-run double. **Andy Thomas** hit a go-ahead single in the top of the ninth to move the Flying Squirrels ahead, 7-6. Rainer Nunez brought in the tying run with a groundout in the bottom of the ninth. After the Flying Squirrels were held scoreless in the top of the 10th, Ryan McCarty hit a walk-off double to end the game. The six-run deficit overcome by Richmond would have the largest comeback win in franchise history, which has occurred twice.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels face the New Hampshire Fisher Cats, Double-A affiliate of the Toronto Blue Jays, in the fourth of a six-game series on the first leg of a 12-game road trip to New England. This series is the only meeting between the Flying Squirrels and Fisher Cats this year. This is also the first series for the Flying Squirrels in Manchester since August 2-7, 2022, a six-game split. This series marks the second of three road sets this year for Richmond against teams from the Northeast Division. They opened the season going 1-2 in a three-game set at Somerset from April 5-7. Next week, they will play their final road series against the Northeast Division with six games at Portland.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** snapped a five-game losing streak with their win on Wednesday night. They had gone 3-9 in their previous 12 from since May 29 through Tuesday. In their previous 13 games from May 15-28, they went 11-2. That stretch came following a span where they went 1-12 over a 13-game span from April 28-May 12, including 1-11 on their road trip to Akron and Erie. They had won five-of-six in two straight series, including at home against Reading from May 15-19 and on the road at Bowie from May 21-26, before dropping four-of-six against Erie at The Diamond from May 28-June 2 and again against Altoona from June 4-9.

**THE FISHER CATS** are in fifth place in the Northeast Division. This year, the Fisher Cats have the second-most hits (488) in the Eastern League. New Hampshire's roster includes five of MLB.com's top-30 Blue Jays prospects, including OF Alan Roden (No. 7), LHP Adam Macko (No. 9), SS/3B Josh Kasevich (No. 11), RHP CJ Van Eyk (No. 17) and 3B/SS Alex De Jesus (No. 23). Baseball America's top-30 Blue Jays prospects list includes three New Hampshire players, including Kasevich (No. 7), Roden (No. 8) and Macko (No. 11). Baseball America also lists Kasevich as the best defensive infielder, Macko as the best curveball, Roden as the best hitter for average and Garrett Spain as the best outfield arm.

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander Dylan Cumming makes his second Double-A start. He made his first Double-A start last Friday against the Curve in Richmond and allowed one unearned run over four innings, striking out five. He made his Double-A debut out of the bullpen on May 30 against the SeaWolves and struck out seven batters over four innings, allowing one run. Cumming began the year with High-A Eugene, going 3-0 with a 1.87 ERA in nine games (seven starts). He was named the Northwest League Pitcher of the Month in April after going 1-0 with a 0.50 ERA (1 ER/18.0 IP) in five games (four starts). On April 17 against Vancouver, Cumming started and threw three innings in a combined no-hitter with Nick Sinacola and Seth Corry. In his final start for the Emeralds on May 22 against Spokane, he set a career high with nine strikeouts over five innings in a win. Cumming spent last year with Low-A San Jose in his professional debut season, going 7-3 with a 2.93 ERA in 34 games (seven starts). He worked as a reliever most of the season before making starts across July, August and September. Cumming began his collegiate career at Chicago State, where he pitched three seasons before the program was disbanded in 2020. He pitched his final two seasons at Liberty University in Lynchburg, Va., and was with the Burlington Sock Puppets in the 2022 summer, where he was selected as an Appalachian League All-Star. Cumming signed with the San Francisco Giants as a non-drafted free agent on February 25, 2023. For more on Cumming, see page two.

FOR NEW HAMPSHIRE: Right-hander CJ Van Eyk makes his ninth start of the season. He last pitched on Saturday at Erie and allowed a season-high seven runs over 3.1 innings in a loss. After posting a 1.88 ERA (5 ER/24.0 IP) in five May games, he has allowed 10 runs over 7.1 innings in his two June starts for a 12.27 ERA. Van Eyk was selected by the Blue Jays in the second round (42nd overall) of the 2020 MLB Draft out of Florida State. He first reached Double-A last year, going 0-2 with a 4.15 ERA in four games with the Fisher Cats over the final month of the season. After being limited to 34.1 innings in the regular season, he pitched for Surprise in the Arizona Fall League, going 2-1 with a 2.51 ERA in five outings.

PACKING THE HOUSE: The Flying Squirrels drew an average of 7,113 fans in April for their home games at The Diamond to open the season, their highest April average in franchise history. The previous high was 6,891 in 2014 followed by 6,571 in 2019. This season, the Flying Squirrels are leading all 30 Double-A teams and are ranked fourth among the 120 minor league clubs in average home attendance (7,008).

**THOMAS THE TANK ENGINE:** Andy Thomas is batting .347 (26-for-75) over his last 23 games since May 15 with two homers, seven doubles, a triple and 18 RBIs, raising his batting average for the year from .193 to .264. On May 24 at Bowie, he clubbed his first homer of the year, a grand slam, and finished the game with six RBIs, tying his career high. Last Wednesday night, Thomas came off the bench and hit an RBI triple in the eighth inning for an insurance run, the second triple of his professional career. Last Thursday, he hit his second homer of the season. He added two hits on Friday and an RBI double on Saturday. On Wednesday at New Hampshire, he went 3-for-3 with a walk and caught a shutout.

**OPEN THE GATES:** This season, **Evan Gates** has posted a 1.34 ERA (5 ER/33.2 IP), which is the lowest in the Eastern League (min. 30 IP). Gates posted a 0.86 ERA (2 ER/21.0 IP) over his first 12 appearances of the season through May 18. After allowing four runs (three earned) in his two outings May 23 and 26 against the Baysox, he pitched 3.1 scoreless innings on May 31 against the SeaWolves, the longest outing of his career, and struck out four batters. In that appearance, he issued a walk to the first batter he faced before retiring the next 10 batters in order to finish his night. Gates followed with a six-out save against the Curve in a combined shutout on June 4. Since joining the Flying Squirrels in 2022, Gates has pitched 67 Double-A games, combining for a 3.21 ERA (35 ER/98.0 IP).

**BERICOTO BASHING:** In his last seven games dating back to June 6, **Victor Bericoto** is hitting .333 (10-for-30) with a homer, three doubles, two walks and four RBIs. After leading the Giants organization in homers (27) last year, Bericoto hit just one homer in his first 34 games this season through May 21. From May 22-28, he homered three times in five games. In his last 17 games since May 22, Bericoto is batting .290 (18-for-62) with four homers, four doubles, eight walks and 13 RBIs.

**BLANK SPACE:** Four of the Flying Squirrels' last five wins have been shutouts. They shut out the SeaWolves in their last homestand. On May 28, **Hayden Birdsong** covered six scoreless innings before **Nick Swiney** and **Tyler Myrick** worked the final three in a 5-0 win. On May 31, **Matt Frisbee** started and pitched 4.2 innings before being replaced by **Evan Gates**, who worked a career-high 3.1 innings. Myrick threw a scoreless ninth to close his fourth save of the year. On June 4 against the Curve, **John Michael Bertrand** pitched six innings, **Mat Olsen** worked a scoreless seventh and Gates retired the final six outs in a 1-0 win over the Curve. On Wednesday at New Hampshire, **Nick Sinacola** pitched five hitless innings, **Ben Madison** threw two scoreless innings while Olsen and Myrick covered the final two frames. The Flying Squirrels' eight shutout wins this season are tied for second-most in the Eastern League with Harrisburg, trailing only Akron with nine.

MOVIN' UP: A pair of Flying Squirrels players were promoted to Triple-A Sacramento following last week's series against the Curve. Pitcher Hayden Birdsong went 4-2 with a 2.05 ERA this season in 11 starts with 61 strikeouts in 48.1 innings of work. Among Eastern League pitchers, he ranked second in BAA (188), third in ERA (2.05), third in WHIP (1.10), third in LOB% (81.6%), fifth in K/9 (11.36), fifth in strikeout percentage (30.7%), sixth in K-BB% (20.6%), sixth in BABIP (.255), seventh in SwStr% (13.8), eighth in strikeouts (61) and ninth in xFIP (3.48). He joined the Flying Squirrels last August and went 4-5 with a 3.15 ERA in 19 starts, striking out 94 batters in 71.1 innings. His 11.86 career K/9 is second-highest in Richmond franchise history (min. 70 IP), trailing only Kyle Harrison (13.61). Outfielder Grant McCray was also promoted to Triple-A. In the Eastern League, he was tied for third in triples (3), tied for fifth in doubles (14) and tied for fifth in extra-base hits (23). He also led the team in homers (6). After batting 135 (14-for-104) in his first 27 games, McCray hit. 312 (24-for-77) in his final 23 games from May 15-June 8 with two homers, nine doubles, three triples, 10 RBIs, 10 walks and .989 OPS.

PROSPECT WATCH: Four of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects are on the Richmond roster, including OF Vaun Brown (No. 10), RHP Eric Silva (No. 20), C Adrián Sugastey (No. 23), RHP Ryan Murphy (No. 26) and LHP José Cruz (No. 28). On Baseball America's Best Tools list, Sugastey is rated as the best defensive catcher and John Michael Bertrand is rated as having the best control. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list includes five Richmond players, including Brown (No. 15), OF/1B Victor Bericoto (No. 19), Sugastey (No. 23), OF Jairo Pomares (No. 26) and RHP Carson Ragsdale (No. 30).
