YESTERDAY: The Captains hit five home runs, including two by Jonathan Rodríguez, to edge the Dayton Dragons, 9-8 Jhonkensy Noel, Quentin Holmes and Mike Amditis also went deep. Ivan Johnson and Allan Cerda homered for Dayton. The Captains battled back from an early 3-0 deficit, as Johnson's first-inning, three-run homer put Dayton on top three batters into the game. Amditis gave the Captains their first lead at 4-3 with a two-run shot in the fourth. After Cerda's homer in the fifth tied the score, Holmes went deep in the bottom of the fifth to give the Captains a lead they did not relinquish. Rodríguez's second homer of the game, a three-run shot in the seventh, proved to be the difference.

PLAYOFF PICTURE: The Captains enter today 1.0 game behind the Cedar Rapids Kernels for the second playoff spot in the High-A Central League (HAC). Lake County, Great Lakes, the Cedar Rapids Kernels and the Dayton Dragons are all separated by just 4.0 games. The Quad Cities River Bandits currently hold the top playoff spot and are 11.0 games ahead of second place. The top two teams in the HAC earn playoff bids (regardless of division).

TIEBREAKER WATCH: The following are the tiebreaker scenarios for the High-A Central League Postseason.

Head-to-head record

- If the Captains finish the season tied with the Great Lakes Loons for the final playoff spot, Great Lakes clinches the playoff berth via head-to-head record (15-9 vs. Lake County)
- If the Captains finish the season tied with the Dayton Dragons for the final playoff spot, Lake County clinches the playoff berth via head-to-head record (14-7 vs. Dayton)
- If the Captains finish the season tied with the Cedar Rapids Kernels for the final playoff spot, the playoff berth will be decided by the second tiebreaker rule.

Best overall winning percentage over the final 20 games

If the Captains finish the season tied with the Cedar Rapids Kernels, the team with the better winning percentage over the final 20 games of the regular season will win the playoff berth. If this situation arises, the Captains would win the tiebreaker because Lake County trailed Cedar Rapids at the 100game mark. A tie between the two teams at the end of the season means the Captains would have the better record over the final 20 games

UNLIKELY LONG BALLS: In last night's game, Quentin Holmes hit his first home run since June 11. Mike Amditis hit his first homer since July 3. It was Amditis' first start since July 10 after the catcher missed two months with a left hand injury.

WHO'S HOT?

José Tena: Since August 1, Tena has slashed .287/.346/.533 (.879 OPS) and is third in the league with eight homers. Christian Cairo: 13-for-42 (.310) with two homers and two doubles in 12 games since being promoted from Low-A Lynchburg on August 24

Jhonkensy Noel: Slashing .324/.378/.632 (1.011 OPS) in his first 17 games with the Captains since being promoted from Low-A Lynchburg on August 17. Across three levels this year (Rookie, Low-A & High-A), Noel leads all Cleveland minor leaguers in batting average (.361), wRC+ (174), OPS (1.051), slugging percentage (648), BABIP (.396) and ISO (.288).

Quentin Holmes: While Holmes is only hitting .182 over his last 10 games, he also has an .879 OPS in that span. Holmes is slashing .182/.379/.500 in that stretch with seven walks, five steals and his first home run since June 11

Kevin Kelly: Kelly has not allowed a run in eight consecutive appearances, spanning 10.0 innings. Since August 13, the right-hander has a 0.52 WHIP and a .100 opponent's batting average.

TRAFFIC CHECK: Since August 1, the Captains' pitching staff owns the best WHIP (1.20) in the High-A Central League (third-best n all of High-A)

BORN TO RUN: The Captains are second in the High-A Central League in stolen bases (41) since August 1 (fourth in all of High-A).

NEW BLOOD: 3B Jhonkensy Noel joined the Captains on August 17. The 20-year old led all of Low-A (minimum 160 PA) with a .393 batting average and a 190 wRC+, while hitting 11 homers. INF Christian Cairo and OF Jonathan Rodríguez joined the Captains on August 24. Cairo led Low-A Lynchburg with 37 walks and held a .364 on-base percentage, which led all Hillcats minimum 200 PA). Rodríguez slashed .314/.363/.450 with the Hillcats, good for an .812 OPS

LAST TIME OUT: Gaddis struck out 10 batters for the second time in his pro career, but took the loss after allowing four runs, three earned, over 5.2 innings at South Bend last Friday. Over the first three innings, Gaddis held the Cubs scoreless on just one hit. In the fourth, however, he gave up back-to-back two-out singles, including a game-tying RBI knock by Bryce Ball. Gaddis gave up two more runs in the fifth and surrendered a leadoff homer in the sixth to Ball. The Captains lost, 5-4.

INNINGS EATER: Gaddis is second behind **Mason Hickman** for the Captains lead in innings pitched, throwing 86.2 innings to Hickman's 87.0. Gaddis has gone five or more innings in nine consecutive starts and has posted four straight quality starts. Over that span (which includes one four-inning relief appearance), Gaddis has a 2.91 ERA (18 ER, 55.2 IP) with 69 strikeouts and 12 walks.

HOMER PRONE: Gaddis leads the Captains and is second in the High-A Central League with 17 home runs allowed. His 16.7 HR/FB% is second in the league (min. 60 IP). 46.4% of Gaddis' runs allowed this year have come on homers (56 R, 26 via HR). Since the start of July, 65.5% of Gaddis' runs allowed have been on home runs (29 R, 19 via HR).

NO MORE LOONS, PLEASE: Gaddis has allowed 41.1% of his home runs and 35% his earned runs against the Great Lakes Loons. Gaddis has a 8.04 ERA against Great Lakes (4 G, 3 GS, 15.2 IP, 14 ER, 7 HR) and a 2.93 ERA against all other teams in the High-A Central League (14 G, 14 GS, 80.0 IP, 26 ER, 10 HR).

PROSPECTING: Gaddis ranks as Cleveland's #28 prospect, according to FanGraphs. He is unranked on Cleveland's top prospect lists published by MLB.com and Baseball America. 2019: Across 13 appearances and 11 starts in 2019, Gaddis posted a 2.73 ERA across two levels – the Rookie Level Arizona League Indians Blue and Short Season Mahoning Valley.

NO-HITTER: On August 23, 2019, Gaddis threw three perfect innings after a 93-minute rain delay to begin what turned into a combined no-hitter against the Williamsport Crosscutters. It was the first no-hitter for Mahoning Valley since 2013. After Gaddis left the game, RHP Matt Waldron and RHP Luis Sanchez finished the game for the Scrappers. Gaddis set his career high with six strikeouts, throwing 35 pitches in the outing. Also in the starting lineup for Mahoning Valley that day were current Captains INF Brayan Rocchio, C Bryan Lavastida and OF Will Brennan

GEORGIA STATE STAR: Gaddis is in the history books as an all-time great at Georgia State finishing his career with a program best 3.81 ERA. He also is second all-time in program history with 266 strikeouts, fourth in innings pitched (266.2) and sixth in games started (40). His junior season he finished with 112 strikeouts to lead the Sun Belt and finish 14th in the country. He wrapped up 2019 with his second consecutive second-team allSun-Belt selection.

PANTHER PRO'S: David Buchanan is currently the only Georgia State Panther to ever make the big leagues. Gaddis is trying to become the second, after being drafted in the 5th round at 160 overall he is also the highest ever draft pick from Georgia State. Buchanan was a starting pitcher from 2014-15 for the Philadelphia Phillies and was drafted in the seventh round of the 2010 draft.

TEAM USA: In 2017 Gaddis became the first ever player from Georgia State to be chosen by Team USA when he joined the USA Collegiate National Team.
