Good Things Come in Threes... Outfielder Jhon Diaz became the first Bowling Green Hot Rods player in over three years to hit a home run in three consecutive games with a solo home run in Wednesday night's win. Diaz matches Dru Baker, who coincidentally homered in three straight games at Truist Stadium against the Winston-Salem Dash from August 2 to August 4, 2023.

King of Thieves... Infielder Tony Santa Maria surpassed 50 stolen bases in Wednesday's 8-3 victory. Santa Maria becomes just the fifth player to record 50 or more swipes in the South Atlantic League since the 2017 season. His 51 steals marks the third-most by a Bowling Green player during a single season in the franchise's 17-year history.

Another One Swipes The Dust... The 2026 Hot Rods are up to a franchise-record 276 stolen bases this season after logging four steals Wednesday. The 276 steals surpasses the 2024 Hot Rods squad, who stole 262 bases.

Halting the Dash... The Hot Rods are now 6-2 against the Dash this season. Bowling Green pitching has posted a 3.49 ERA and a 10.6 K/9 over 67.0 combined innings against Winston-Salem hitting.

Citelli Keeps Cooking... Bullpen arm Cade Citelli hurled 2.0 shutout innings on Wednesday. The right-hander has now posted a season-long 9.0 consecutive scoreless in-nings since August 9 against the Hub City Spartanburgers.

Aybar's August... Nicandro Aybar extended his on-base streak to 21 consecutive games since his promotion from the Charleston RiverDogs on July 29. The 21-year-old has the third-best batting average (.333) and tenth-best OBP (.427) in the South Atlantic League during this month.

Brendan's Back in Action... Outfielder Brendan Summerhill drove in three runs in last week's series against the Greensboro Grasshoppers. The Tampa Bay Rays' No. 28 prospect has recorded a hit or RBI in all six games since joining Bowling Green on August 4.
