## TODAY'S HEADLINES

**LAST TIME OUT:** The Saints could not repeat their offensive burst on Sunday in a 5-0 shutout loss to close the series in Indianapolis. The Saints did not get their first hit of the game until there were two outs in the seventh inning when Alex Isola singled into right field. It would go down as the lone hit the Saints would get in the game. The only other Saints baserunners came via a fielding error that allowed Yuniur Severino to reach in the fifth and a Severino walk in the seventh. Randy Dobnak took the loss, allowing two runs in 4.1 innings in the start.

**REHAB ROUNDTABLE:** The Minnesota Twins sent Jhoan Duran to St. Paul on a Major League rehab assignment on Tuesday. This stint will be Duran's first minor league appearance since he was a member of the Saints from May 22 - June 15, 2021. Duran, who was a starter at the time, went 0-3 with a 5.06 ERA, striking out 22 and walking 13 in 16.0 Triple-A innings. Duran is the fourth Twin to join the Saints on rehab this season.

**BOOM OR BUST:** The offense has had its ups and downs in the first 20 games of the season. The Saints have scored five-or-more runs 10 times this year, however they have struggled to repeat that performance in consecutive games. They have put up five runs in consecutive games just twice (3/30-31 and 4/14-16). In the other eight instances, they have scored a combined 13 runs in the following games, including one one-run game and three shutouts. That works out to 1.6 runs per game following a five-run performance the game prior.

**SLOW TO THE FINISH LINE IN INDY:** The 1-0 defeat for the Saints on Wednesday was just the eighth game in franchise history to be decided by a 1-0 final. The Saints are now 3-5 in 1-0 games. In the series finale on Sunday, the Saints were shutout again, 5-0. It marks only the second time in franchise history the Saints have been shutout twice in a series, joining August 4 and 6, 2023 at Columbus.

**WALK THIS WAY:** After drawing nine walks in Saturday's 12-4 victory, the Saints moved to 20-2 all-time when drawing at least nine walks. It's the most walks the Saints have drawn this year, beating the previous high of eight from April 9. The Saints are tied for ninth in the IL with their 91 walks drawn this season.

**OFFENSIVE STRUGGLES:** The Saints offense has continued to struggle in the early goings of 2024, slashing .209/.312/.352, all ranking 20<sup>th</sup> in the International League. The 90 runs the Saints have scored are the fourth-fewest in the IL. The 17 double plays the team has hit into are the second-most in the league.

**PRATO PACES THE BASES:** Once again, Anthony Prato has displayed his ability to reach base, leading the team with 18 walks, the tied for the second-most in the International League. Prato's .465 on-base percentage is the fifth-highest in the IL. He has reached base in his first 14 games that he has played in this year, a streak that is tied for the fourth-longest streak in the IL. Prato had a .452 OBP in 72 games with the Saints last year and has a career .457 OBP in Triple-A. In his Triple-A career, Prato has reached base in 77 of his 89 games.

**ST. PAUL SPEEDSTERS:** In their first 21 steal attempts this year, the Saints did not get thrown out, until DaShawn Keirsej Jr. was caught attempting to take third base on Friday. The Saints perfect 21-for-21 start ties the best for any Triple-A team since 2005 (as far as minor league stats go back). Sacramento was successful on their first 21 attempts this year, matching the Saints. The only minor league teams to beat that mark are the 23 consecutive steals to open the year by the 2014 Wilmington Blue Rocks and the 25 stolen bases by the 2007 Elizabethton Twins, holding the minor league record since 2005.

**GO, DIEGO, GO:** Diego A. Castillo recorded four hits in the Saints victory on Sunday, the 29<sup>th</sup> four-hit game in franchise history and the 10<sup>th</sup> of Castillo's career. He followed that with a three-hit game to open the series in Indianapolis. Castillo is snapped his seven-game hit streak on Friday, going 12-for-29 (.414) with a triple, two home runs with one walk and three strikeouts in that span.

**RACKING UP K's:** The Saints struck out 15 Iowa Cubs on April 13, doing so for the third time in the series. They struck out 15 batters in consecutive games on April 9 and 10, the second time in franchise history the club has recorded 15 strikeouts in back-to-back games, matching May 22-23, 2021 against Indianapolis. It's also the fourth time this season and the 17<sup>th</sup> time in franchise history that the Saints struck out 15 batters. The Saints are now 10-7 in games which they strike out 15 hitters. Saints' pitchers are sixth in Triple-A with 208 strikeouts. Their 132 swinging strikeouts are also the sixth-most in Triple-A.

**TWINS UPDATE:** The Twins opened their series against the White Sox with a 7-0 victory. Chris Paddock threw 7.0 innings, striking out 10 while walking none. Ronny Henriquez made his 2024 Twins debut, throwing 2.0 shutout innings. Eduardo Julien hit his fifth homer of the season, part of a three-hit effort in the victory.

**A PERFORMANCE FOR THE AGES:** In just his ninth professional pitching appearance, Festa was a major part of a no-hitter. On May 10, 2022 with Fort Myers, he threw 6.0 no-hit innings, striking out a career-high 11 batters in a combined no-hitter for the Mighty Mussels. Jaylen Nowlin followed with 2.0 perfect innings and struck out three. Hunter McMahon tossed 1.0 hitless inning to finish it off, a 3-0 win.

**ONE, TWO, THREE, YOU'RE OUT!:** On July 24, 2022, Festa allowed three consecutive singles between the third and fourth innings. The final two batters of the third inning reached, as did the first of the fourth. Festa got three outs, but did not retire a batter because promptly picked off each of the three batters, one after the other.

**你好:** While attending Seton Hall Prep in New Jersey, Festa was a member of the National Chinese Honor Society... He said it's sort of tough for him to do certain exercises given his height and narrowness. Last season he was listed at 185 pounds and came into Spring Training in 2024 10 pounds heavier at 195.
