LATE OFFENSE HELPS RIDERS TAKE OPENER IN CORPUS:

The Frisco Rough Riders scored five runs between the seventh and eighth innings in a 6-2 victory over the Corpus Christi Hooks from the following the corpus Christi Hooks from the following the corpus Christi Hooks from the following the following the corpus Christian ChrisWhataburger Field to open their series. Trailing 2-1 in the seventh, Frisco (23-28) took the lead on a Luisangel Acuña two-run double to make it 3-2. They then extended the advantage in the eighth with a Jax Biggers two-run single and an Aaron Zavala RBI double to make it 6-2. The lead held with the RoughRiders' bullpen domination. Michael Brewer threw two shutout innings and Danny Duffy, Alex Speas and Justin Slaten all contributed scoreless frames in relief as well. Back in the first inning, the Riders jumped out in front early when Thomas Saggese plated the first run with a sacrifice fly in the first inning, scoring Acuña. The Hooks (25-27) countered with a run of their own in the bottom of the second when Frisco starter Jack Leiter walked Colin Barber with the bases loaded to make it 1-1. Leiter allowed another run in the third on an RBI fielder's choice from Kennedy Corona, but surrendered just those runs on two hits over four innings while striking out seven and walking four. The RoughRiders' pitching staff struck out 13 overall in the opener. Frisco won back-to-back games for the first time since May 26th and 27th in Arkansas.

COMEBACK KIDS:

With the RoughRiders victory on Tuesday, Frisco has had back-to-back come-from-behind wins. Frisco trailed 2-1 into the seventh before taking the lead for good on Tuesday while they trailed 6-2 into the fourth on Sunday against San Antonio before scoring five runs in the fourth to take a lead they would not give up. Of their 23 wins of on the season, eight have been after trailing at some

THE SPEAS THAT PLEASES:

With his appearance on Tuesday, reliever Alex Speas now has an ERA under 1.00 at 0.89 over 18 appearances. In 20.1 innings, he has struck out 35 to 10 walks. Opponents are hitting just .151 against him and he has not allowed an earned run over his last nine outings. During that span, he has struck out 20 to three walks over 10 innings. On the season, righties are just hitting .123 (7-for-57) against him on the season with a .383 OPS.

PLEASE CONNECT TO POWER:

Over the last 16 games (7-9 record), Frisco has hit just three home runs while batting .220/.336/.295/.631. The three home runs (from Liam Hicks, Trevor Hauver and Thomas Saggese) are the fewest in the league over the last 16 and tied for the second-fewest in Minor League baseball (Salem, 2). The Riders are averaging just 4.1 runs per game over the last 16 games, which is the second-fewest in the league (only in front of Northwest Arkansas, 2.8).

AMBUSH EARLY AND OFTEN:

Thomas Saggese has been fantastic on first pitches this season, fourth in the Texas League with a .579 average (11-for-19) when he puts the first pitch of an at-bat in play. He has a 1.442 OPS on the first pitch. Luisangel Acuña has also been great, hitting .484 (15for-31) on the initial offering while his 15 hits on the first pitch lead the league.

DUSTIN' THEM AND LEAVING THEM BEHIND:

Dustin Harris has been running wild for the RoughRiders this season. After stealing 19 bases in 85 games in 2022, Harris has already swiped 22 bags in 49 games this season to lead the Texas League and the entire Rangers organization. If Harris plays 110 games this season, he is on pace for 49 steals, which would by far be a career high. Luisangel Acuña and Harris are tied for the league lead in steals with 22. The RoughRiders are third in fewest caught stealings in the league with just 11 while stealing 76 bases (87 percent).

ONE HOME RUN, PLEASE. AND MAKE IT GRAND:

The RoughRiders have had a knack for grand slams this year with **Thomas Saggese** hitting Frisco's seventh grand slam of the season on Friday. They are one of two teams with seven grand slams in all of Minor League Baseball. Six different players have accounted for the grand slams (Hicks, Luisangel Acuña, Jax Biggers, Dustin Harris, Trevor Hauver, Thomas Saggese (2)). Frisco also has a 1.223 OPS with the bags full, which is third in the minors (Low-A Myrtle Beach, 1.295 and Triple-A Saint Paul, 1.267).

RoughRiders infielder Luisangel Acuña has been on fire to start his 2023 season. The Rangers No. 3 prospect is hitting .293 (55for-188)/.362/.415/.777 through the first 44 games. Over his last 40 games, he is batting .306/.380/.441/.821. When the 21-year-old arrived in Frisco in 2022, he had a wRC+ of 68 while it has nearly doubled this season (111).

-Opened the 2023 season with three shutout innings against Amarillo on April 7th. He was working his way back up from a neck injury that kept him out for a couple weeks during Spring Training.

-Threw first quality start for RoughRiders pitchers on April 25th at Amarillo, allowing three runs over six innings. He retired the first 10 he saw and allowed just one baserunner on a single through five innings.

2022 SEASON

-Entered the season as the No. 8 prospect in the Rangers system by MLB.com.

-Over his last three starts in Hickory, before being promoted to Frisco, White went 2-0 with a 1.89 ERA (4ER/19.0IP) while striking out 30 and just walking three over 19.0 innings.

-Recorded five quality starts over his 10 total starts, including a 7.0 innings, 1 ER, 11 K start on June 11th.

-With Hickory, owned a 45.8 percent groundball rate, 10th in the South Atlantic League. Also had a 16.4 percent swinging strike rate (3rd in SAL) and a 33.3 percent strikeout rate (4th).

-Was dominant in Double-A debut on June 25th, allowing one runs until an inherited run came across over his 5.1 innings in Arkansas.

-Threw 5.1 hitless innings with seven strikeouts on July 1st against CC, winning Texas League Pitcher of the Week. Left game with left ankle injury, but was able to make next scheduled start. Riders lost nohitter in 7th inning when Seth Nordlin allowed single, but Frisco won 5-0.

2021 SEASON

-Was Low-A Down East's Opening Day starer before punching the ground after an error and breaking his hand on May 4th. He returned to the Wood Ducks on August 10th.

-From The Athletic: "As soon as I did that, CY (general manager Chris Young) called me and basically said the Rangers have my back and they knew that it wasn't out of like hatred or trying to hurt myself," White explained on Monday. "It was more going out and competing and my emotions got the best of me at that moment in time. It's not like I came in the dugout and punched something at a locker, it was just — emotions got the best of me, I did what I did, and now I had to pay the consequence. But ..." White paused and nodded before giving a wry smile. "I promised them that I would never do it again."

-After making just nine outings on the season, he won Arizona Fall League "Pitcher of the Year", going 5-0 with a 1.91 ERA and 29 strikeouts over a league-best 28.1 innings.
