GOTTA BE BLASICK, AGAIN: Nathan Blasick secured his California League leading 10th save Wednesday night with a clean ninth inning. Blasick is tied for second in ALL of Minor League Baseball with 10 saves with only Wellinton Herrera, who is with the Rockies AA affiliate in Hartford, having more at 11 saves this season.

HOLDING STRONG: Brady Hill and Fidel Ulloa both earned holds on Wednesday night protecting the Grizzlies lead to bridge the game from starter Marcos Herrera to closer Nathan Blasick. The Grizzlies have 17 holds this season which is the second most in the California League. Fresno has five total blown saves through the first 59 games, the 3rd fewest in all of MiLB, only Modesto (3) has fewer in the California League, as this series features two of the best bullpens in the league.

EXTRA, EXTRA: Kelvin Hidalgo's bases clearing triple on Wednesday night not only tied the game in the 2nd inning but extended his California League best six-game streak with an extra-base hit. Hidalgo is riding a 7-game hit streak and the last six have included 4 doubles, 2 triples and one home run.
