Last Time Out: The Binghamton Rumble Ponies knocked down the Reading Fightin Phils, 2-1, on a walk-off two-run double from Rowdey Jordan with two outs in the bottom of the ninth. Joander Suarez struck out a Double-A career-high nine batters over five scoreless innings. Suarez, Brendan Hardy (2 IP, 4 K), and Paul Gervase (2 IP, 6 K) combined to strike out 19 batters and issue just three walks.

Jordan at the Buzzer: Rowdey Jordan smoked a walk-off two-run double with the Ponies down to their final out in the ninth inning on Thursday night against Reading. It marked Jordan's third walk-off RBI of the season, drawing a walk-off walk against Richmond on May 28 and hitting a walk-off single against Portland on June 18. Over his last three games, the 24-year-old has driven in eight runs. Jordan is currently riding a five-game hitting streak. He is tied for fifth in the Eastern League with 66 runs scored and leads the team with 62 runs batted in.

Scoreless Suarez: Right-hander **Joander Suarez** dominated again in his start for the Rumble Ponies last night. He struck out a Double-A career-high nine batters over five scoreless innings, while allowing just two hits and two walks. Over his first three starts at the Double-A level, Suarez is 2-0 and has thrown 18 scoreless innings with 19 strikeouts, while allowing just three hits and four walks. Opponents are hitting .055 against him in Double-A. Over his last four starts overall, dating back to August 25, Suarez has thrown 24 scoreless innings with 25 strikeouts, while allowing just four hits and six walks.

Jett Soars in AA: Shortstop **Jett Williams** has soared in his first three games at the Double-A level. Williams has three hits, four runs, an RBI, and a walk over his first three games. The Mets' No. 3 prospect scored the game-winning run on Thursday night. He went 2-for-4 with three runs scored, reaching base on a double, single, and hit by pitch in his Double-A debut on Tuesday. The 19-year-old has drawn 103 walks this season, which is tied for the second-most in all of Minor League Baseball.

Ride with Rhylan: Outfielder **Rhylan Thomas** has gotten off to a strong start in Double-A, hitting .326 with a .392 on-base percentage over his first 14 games. Thomas is currently riding a 10-game hitting streak, hitting .314 with 11 hits over that span. Thomas has recorded at least one hit in 13 of his 14 games with Binghamton.

Hamel Keeps Fightin: Right-hander **Dom Hamel** has been electric in two starts against the Reading Fightin Phils this season. He recorded 20 strikeouts over 13 innings across his first two starts against the Fightins. In his most recent start against Reading on July 26, the Mets' No. 16 prospect struck out a career-high-tying 11 batters over a career-high seven innings of one-run ball. On June 10 at Reading, Hamel struck out nine batters over six innings of one-run ball. Hamel is currently tied for first (with Somerset's Richard Fitts) in the Eastern League with 152 strikeouts. He also ranks top 10 in the EL in BAA (5th), IP (6th), GS (T6th), ERA (8th), and WHIP (8th).

Last Start: Hamel struck out five batters over three no-hit innings on Friday night at Hartford in a rain-shortened game. He allowed just one baserunner via a walk and the game was suspended after the third inning.

Against Reading: Hamel has made two starts against Reading: 0-0, 1.38 ERA, 13 IP, 6 H, 2 ER, 5 BB, 20 K, .133 BAA. In his most recent start against Reading on July 26 at FirstEnergy Stadium, Hamel struck out a career-high-tying 11 batters over a career-high seven innings of one-run ball, while only allowing three hits and two walks. He struck out nine batters over six innings of one-run ball on June 10 in Baseball-town.

World Baseball Classic: Hamel represented Team Puerto Rico in the 2023 World Baseball Classic. He honored his late mother, who passed away 11 days before the Mets selected him in the 2021 MLB Draft. He was WBC teammates with current New York Mets, Francisco Lindor and Edwin Díaz.

2022: Was named the 2022 New York Mets Minor League Pitcher of the Year. He led all Mets minor leaguers with 10 wins and 145 strikeouts. Began the season with St. Lucie (A) and pitched to a 5-2 record with a 3.84 ERA in 14 appearances and 13 starts. He tossed 63.1 innings and struck out 71 batters, before he was assigned to Brooklyn (A+) on July 4. He went 5-1 on the mound with a 2.59 ERA in 11 starts for the Cyclones. He struck out 74 hitters over 55.2 innings and opponents hit just .180 against him.

BACKGROUND: Ranks as the Mets' No. 2 pitching prospect and No. 10 overall Mets' prospect by MLB Pipeline. He was drafted out of Dallas Baptist University in the 3rd round (81st overall) by the Mets in 2021. Hamel went 13-2 on the mound and racked up 136 strikeouts in his final year at DBU in 2021. He spent his first two years at Yavapai College.

Reid Brignac - Manager - 2nd season with Binghamton - 4th year in the Mets organization.

In 2022, Brignac led a team that saw five players make their major league debut with the Mets after starting the season with the Rumble Ponies (Francisco Álvarez, Brett Baty, Jose Butto, Nate Fisher, and Bryce Montes de Oca), tied for the second-most in franchise history. This past fall, Brignac was one of two Mets staff members selected to be a part of the Arizona Fall League coaching staff, serving as the manager of the Peoria Javelinas. Following his retirement as an active player in 2018, Brignac was the manager of the St. Lucie Mets (Low-A) in 2021 before coming to Binghamton last year.
