NORFOLK SERIES: The Bulls claimed the opening series of the second half, taking five of six from Norfolk. The Bulls and Tides tied for last in the first half with records of 28-47. Durham won the opening five games before losing a one-run decision in game two of Sunday's doubleheader. The Bulls and Tides played two doubleheaders during the set, with Tuesday and Saturday's games both rained out.

HOME TO GWINNETT: The Bulls were 4-2 against Gwinnett in the first half. Durham will play Gwinnett 18 times in the second half of its remaining 69 games. The Bulls' series win May 12th-17th in Lawrenceville represented one of two series that the Bulls won in the first half, and the only road series claimed by Durham. The Bulls outscored Gwinnett 37-29, outthrewed the Stripers 9-4 and stole 12 bases to Gwinnett's eight. Durham's ERA was 4.50 versus 5.67 for the Stripers. Cooper Kinney hit .381 with two homers. Tatam Levins drove in seven runs in five games while hitting .368. Carson Williams hit .353.

UPCOMING: The Bulls make their first and only trip to Jacksonville next week for a six game set. Upon conclusion, the IL will reach its All-Star Break.

TRANSACTION WIRE: OF Jacob Melton was activated from the IL last Tuesday, while C Bryan Broecker was transferred to Durham from Bowling Green. RHP Chris Roycroft was acquired by the Rays from St. Louis on June 25th and assigned to Durham. OF Jake Cave was signed as a free agent by Tampa Bay and assigned to Durham on June 24th. 1B/OF Will Simpson was re-assigned to Montgomery. Tampa Bay Rays OF Jake Fraley (sports hernia) and IF Gavin Lux (shoulder/ankle) have been assigned on major league rehabs as of June 30th. IF Nick Madrigal was signed as a free agent by the Rays and assigned to Durham as of June 28th. OF Austin Slater re-signed as a minor league free agent, re-joining Durham on June 30th. C Bryan Broecker has been reassigned to the Bulls roster.

CONNECTIONS: RHP Anthony Molina appeared in 13 games in 2023 (3-2, 4.37). IF Brett Wisely appeared in five games in 2022 (5-21) and also was on Durham's post-season roster. OF Ben Gamel appeared in 59 games in 2023 (276-8-31). Coach Dan Dement was Durham's hitting coach in 2018 and 2019.

HOMER BUSH JR. 6'2 R/R 10/13/01 4 (23) Grand Canyon U MLB TIME: 0.000

2026: Opened season on Durham injured list, making one rehab appearance for Charleston (April 18th) before joining Bulls for Triple-A debut April 21 in Lehigh Valley (3-4, RBI, SB). Matched career-high with 4H (4-5)/5/13 at Gwinnett.

Bio: 4th round (SD) in 2023 from Grand Canyon University.

Other: Hit .301 at Double-A Montgomery in 2025 with 57 stolen bases in 69 attempts. Father Homer Sr, spent between 1997 and 2004 in MLB, winning a World Series with the Yankees in 1998. Career spanned New York, Toronto, Florida and culminated back with the Yankees in 2004 (9g).

JAKE CAVE 6'0 L/L 12/4/92 6 (11) Kecoughton (VA) HS MLB TIME: 5.071

2026: Added to Bulls' roster June 25th.

Bio: 6th round (NY Yankees) in 2011 from Kecoughton (VA) HS.

Other: Signed by Tampa Bay as free agent June 25th. Made MLB debut May 19, 2018 with Minnesota. Spent 18-22 seasons with Twins; '23 with Phillies & '24 with Colorado. 523 career MLB games (.236-45-176/OPS 692). Spent '25 season with Doosan (Korea: 299-16-87) and the first half of '26 with Veracruz (MX). Made five Opening Day rosters (3 MIN, 1 PHL, 1 COL). In first pro game, fractured kneecap in collision at home plate, missing rest of 2011 and 2012 seasons.

GAVIN LUX 5'11 L/R 11/23/97 1 (16) Indian Trails HS (WI) MLB TIME: 5.114

2026: Began season on Rays injured list (R shoulder); started MLB rehab with Durham on April 2nd. Appeared in nine games before injuring left ankle in Scranton, resulting in pause of rehab. Returned April 24th at Lehigh Valley. Rehab paused again May 11th (L shoulder/ankle). Rehab started again June 30th.

Bio: 1st round (LAD) in 2016 from Indian Trail HS (WI).

Other: Acquired by Rays as part of three-team trade in January, 2026. Lux appeared in 412 games over five seasons with Dodgers. Lux was traded January, 2025 to Reds for Mike Sirota. Lux played in career-high 140 games with Cincinnati in 2025 (269-5-53-1). Part of two World Series championship teams with LA (2020 & 2024). Did not appear in 2020 World Series (v TB), but went 1-10 in 2024 in World Series v NYY.

LOGAN DRISCOLL 5'11 L/R 11/3/97 2 (19) MLB TIME: 0.029

2026: Started 2026 on injured list, activated by Durham on June 9th. Spent May 13th-June 7th at Low-A Charleston (16g: .292-1-12).

Bio: 2nd round (SD) in 2019 from George Mason.

Other: Made MLB debut 9/3/24 with Tampa Bay. Traded to Tampa Bay February 8, 2020 from San Diego with Manuel Margot for Emilio Pagan. Released by Rays August 15, 2025, but re-signed with Rays on August 25th, 2025. Spent first 4 games of 2026 (May 2-8) with FCL Rays before joining Charleston (May 13). Hit .220 with 1 HR and 12 RBI in 16 games before being assigned to Durham. Played 20g with Bulls in 2023 and 70g in 2024. TJ surgery on April 16, 2025, costing him most of 2025 season. Underwent second non-TJ surgery in January, 2026 to realign nerve in elbow.

OLIVER DUNN 5'10 L/R 9/2/97 11 (19) Utah MLB TIME: 1.021

2026: Opening Day 3B for Charlotte (CWS). Played with Knights through May 19th before traded to Tampa Bay for Joe Rock. Assigned directly to Rays where hit .091 (1-11) in nine games before being optioned to Durham June 8th.

Bio: 11th round pick (NYY) in 2014 from Utah.

Other: Spent 2025 with Nashville Sounds, hitting .208 with 8 HR and 43 RBI with 25 stolen bases. Appeared in 14g with Milwaukee in 2025. Made MLB debut in 2024 with Milwaukee (41g: 221-1-7-3). Younger brother Ross is pitcher in Minnesota organization. Made Opening Day roster for Milwaukee in both 2024 and 2025.

BROCK JONES 6'0 L/L 3/8/01 2 (22) Stanford MLB TIME: 0.000

2026: Opened season at Double-A Montgomery before being assigned to Durham on April 14th.

Bio: 2nd round (TB) in 2022 from Stanford.

Other: Spent nearly two months with Durham in 2025 (April 22nd-June 15th), hitting .151-5-13-5. Spent remained of year at Double-A, hitting .189-8-33-19. Spent freshman season at Stanford also on football team as safety, seeing game time on special teams.

COOPER KINNEY 6'1 L/R 1/27/03 1 (21) Baylor School (TN) MLB TIME: 0.000

2026: Started season in Montgomery, hitting .341 in 22 games. Hit 4HR with 13RBI while playing 2B (13) and 3B (6). Had first 2-HR game of career May 16th at Gwinnett (3-4, 2HR, W, 3RBI).

Bio: 1st round (TB) in 2021 from the Baylor School in Chattanooga, TN.

Other: Played 117 games at Double-A Montgomery in 2025, hitting 13HR with 62RBI and an average of .242. He played 14g at 1B, 59 at 2B and 28 at 3B. Missed all of 2022 with torn labrum in right shoulder resulting from injury in spring training diving into first base. Injured another shoulder in 2024 while diving in field which led to another labrum surgery. Tennessee HS Player of Year. Had signed LOI to play at South Carolina.

TATEM LEVINS 6'1 L/R 5/29/99 8 (22) Pitt MLB TIME: 0.000

2026: Made his season (and Triple-A) debut on April 23rd in Lehigh Valley, hitting a solo home run in his first AB (2-0 pitch). Levins then homered in Game 2 of a doubleheader two days later. Matched career-high with 5RBI at Gwinnett May 16 (2-4, 2B, 1B, SF).

Bio: 8th round (Seattle) in 2022 from Pitt.

Other: Acquired by TB from Seattle in November, 2023 in trade for Blake Hunt. Levins spent 2025 at Double-A Montgomery, appearing in 100 games (244-7-54-2) with 77 walks for an OBP of .405. Levins also threw out 40 baserunners (139 SBA). Levins spent his first three collegiate seasons at LaSalle before Explorers program was discontinued. Was a freshman All-American at LaSalle and A-10 Rookie of Year. Three-time all-state swimming selection at Notre Dame HS (PA).

JACOB MELTON 6'2 L/L 9/7/00 2 (22) Oregon State MLB TIME: 0.111

2026: Began season on Durham roster, placed on IL (ankle) April 22nd at Lehigh Valley. Reinstated from IL June 23.

Bio: 2nd round pick (Houston) in 2022 from Oregon State.

Other: Rehabbed 5g with FCL (June 11-20: 6-11, HR) before returning to Bulls active roster June 23rd. Made MLB debut June 1, 2025. Avid outdoorsman, growing up in Medford, OR. Fisheries/wildlife science major at Oregon State. Pac-12 POY in 2022. Was top Astros prospect entering 2024 season. Two years at OSU after two seasons at Linn-Benton CC. Acquired by TB in three-team trade with PIT & HOU.

BLAKE SABOL 6'4 L/R 1/7/98 7 (19) USC MLB TIME: 1.048

2026: Made his first Durham Bulls opening day roster.

Bio: 7th round pick (PIT) in 2019 from Southern Cal.

Other: Signed as free agent in Jan, 2026 with Tampa Bay. Prepped at Aliso Niguel HS in Aliso Viejo, CA. Made MLB debut March 30, 2023 with San Francisco. Played three years at USC. Brother Stefan was drafted by Mets in 2012, playing five years in minors. Second cousin to NFL safety Troy Polamalu. First and thus far only MLB Opening Day roster was with San Francisco in 2023 - remained on roster all year after being selected as Rule V pick from Cincinnati. Dad (Rob) played baseball at Long Beach State.

AUSTIN SLATER 6'1 R/R 12/13/92 8 (14) Stanford MLB TIME: 7.147

2026: Made Durham debut 5/28 in G2 at Norfolk. Was opening day RF and leadoff batter for Miami. With Marlins through April 21st (12g: .174, 4-23, 1RBI) Joined NYM on April 29th through May 16th (9g: .250, 5-20, 1RBI). DFA'd by Marlins April 23rd, elected free agency. DFA'd by Mets May 19th, elected free agency.

Bio: 8th round pick (SF) in 2014 from Stanford.

Other: Prepped at The Bolles School in Jacksonville, FL, winning three straight state titles. Grandfather played football at Duke. Led MLB in pinch-hit RBIs in 2021 with 13. Named after his grandfather Ed Austin, who was mayor of Jacksonville, FL from 1991-95. Played MLB with SF, CIN, BAL, CWS, NYY, MIA and NYM. Post-season 2021 with SF (3g: v LAD, NLDS) and in 2024 with BAL (1g: v KC, ALWC)

CARSON WILLIAMS 6'1 R/R 6/25/03 1 (21) Torrey Pines HS (CA) MLB TIME: 0.039

2026: Made first career Opening Day roster for Tampa Bay. Made Bulls debut on April 8th at Scranton. Recalled by TB May 17th. Optioned back to Durham May 29th. Hit .100-0-3-0 in 12g with Rays.

Bio: 1st round (TB) in 2021 from Torrey Pines HS (CA).

Other: Made MLB debut August 22, 2025 vs. St Louis, hitting HR in first game. Finished season with Rays, hitting .172-5-12-2 in 32 games. Hit .213 with 23 HR, 53 RBI and 22 steals with Durham in 2025.

Appeared in 13g for Rays in 2025 before being struck in face while in dugout by 105mph line drive from Baltimore's Adley Rutschman on June 19th, suffering multiple facial fractures. Missed remainder of 2025.
