#### Penultimate Home Series

The Fightin Phils return home for their second-to-last home series of the season against the New Hampshire Fisher Cats, Double-A affiliate of the Toronto Blue Jays. It's the 16th-of-17 matchups between the teams this season, and fifth-of-six at FirstEnergy Stadium. Reading won the season-series, and leads 9-6.

#### Fiesta Friday Fun

The Fightin Phils, playing as Los Luchadores de Reading, used a four-run eighth inning en route to a 10-6 win over New Hampshire on Friday night, grabbing a 3-1 lead in the series. Reading struck with five runs in the bottom of the third inning, with the highlight coming on a ground-rule double from Trevor Schwecke. New Hampshire got four in the fourth and one in the fifth, but the R-Phils remained on top thanks to a solo home run to left field from Marcus Lee Sang. Andrew Baker allowed a run in the eighth to tie the game at six. In the bottom of the eighth, Reading loaded the bases and Erick Brito lined his second double of the day down the left field line to clear the bases and make it 9-6. Gabriel Rincones Jr. scored on a balk and error to make it 10-6.

#### Driving Them Home

Trevor Schwecke is turning in another stellar week against his former team, the Fisher Cats. So far this series, Schwecke is slashing .417.417/.583, with a 1.000 OPS. He's added one run, two doubles and six RBI, while striking out just one time. Schwecke has now driven in multiple runs in three-straight games as well. Schwecke is the fifth Fightin Phil to have a streak of three-or-more games with multiple RBI this season. It is the first time this season Schwecke has driven in multiple RBI in consecutive contests.

### **Brito Breaking Through**

With Justin Crawford getting Friday off, Erick Brito was placed in the leadoff spot in the lineup for the first time this season. Brito proceeded to turn in his best game with Double-A Reading, having two hits, one run, two doubles and three RBI. He had a three-run double in the eighth inning to break a tie game. It was both his first multi-hit and multi-RBI games at the Double-A level.

## The First Fightin

Right-handed pitcher Moises Chace makes both his Double-A and Fightin Phils' debut tonight. Chace was acquired with Seth Johnson from the Baltimore Orioles in exchange for Gregory Soto at the trade deadline. Chace made 17 appearances and nine starts for Baltimore's High-A Aberdeen prior to the trade. He made two starts with Jersey Shore prior to his call-up, most recently earning a win on Aug. 10 at Wilmington. In that contest, Chace went five innings, allowing one run on three hits, with seven strikeouts. After the trade, Chace now ranks as the Phillies' No. 26 Prospect, according to MLB Pipeline.

### Streaks on Streaks

Otto Kemp extended his season-best on-base streak to 16 games on Friday night. Over his streak, dating back to July 27, Kemp is slashing .305/.406/.458, with an .864 OPS. Carson Taylor also extended his season-best on-base streak to 14 games on Friday night. Taylor is slashing .304/.450/.928, with a .928 OPS over his streak, which dates back to July 30. Gabriel Rincones Jr. also had a nine-game on-base streak, where he is slashing .353/.436/.794, with a 1.230 OPS over it, which dates back to August 7.

### The Road Ahead

After Sunday's game, the Fightin Phils hit the road for a season-long two-week, 12-game road trip. It will begin at Binghamton and then finish in Somerset. Reading will return home for its final-home series of the season from Sept. 3-8 against Erie, before finishing the season in Harrisburg from Sept. 10-15.

## This Day in Baseballtown History

**August 17, 2014:** At Reading, Hoby Milner tosses a 99-pitch, 3-hit shutout in 1:58 as Reading tops Binghamton, 1-0, avoiding a season sweep by the B-Mets. Milner strikes out 5 and does not allow a walk. Jake Fox's RBI single in the 4th is the game's only run.

### The Cats

New Hampshire enters tonight after finishing in last place in the Eastern League's Northeast Division for the first half with a 30-38 record. They are last in the Northeast Division with a 14-26 record in the second half of the season. New Hampshire most recently took two-of-five at home against Erie. Following this week, New Hampshire hosts Hartford. New Hampshire's roster features eight players ranked amongst the Toronto Blue Jays' top-30 prospects: Charles McAdoo (9), Adam Macko (10), Eddinson Paulino (19), Dahian Santos (22), Yohendrick Pinango (23), Dasan Brown (25), RJ Schreck (29) and Josh Rivera (30).

### Cat on the Bump

Righty Rafael Sanchez makes the start tonight for the Fisher Cats. It will be his third start for the Fisher Cats, as he is 7-2, with a 3.46 ERA over 18 appearances and 17 starts between High-A Vancouver and New Hampshire this season. He was promoted to Double-A from Vancouver on July 30. Sanchez has wins in each of his first two Double-A outings, not allowing a run in either contest. He allowed four hits, and struck out seven, over 6.2-scoreless frams on Aug. 10 against Erie. Sanchez split 2023 between Single-A Dunedin and Vancouver, combining to go 5-8, with a 4.26 ERA. He made his pro debut in 2022. The 22-year old Cuban native signed with Toronto as an international free agent in May of 2022.
