

New Series on Deck

R-Phils.

Tonight, the Reading Fightin Phils open a six-game series on the road at the Somerset Patriots. It's the first of 18 matchups between the teams this season. Reading returns to Somerset from July 4-9 and the Patriots come to Reading from August 15-20. In 2022, Reading went 7-11 vs Somerset, going 5-5 at home and 2-7 on the road.

A Glance Back

Last week, Reading welcomed the New Hampshire Fisher Cats to First Energy Stadium. New Hampshire won the series four games to two. Reading captured wins on Wendesday and Saturday in the series. Saturday featured a six-pitched combined bullpen win. Offensively, Carlos De La Cruz and Oliver Dunn both hit two home runs and Ethan Wilson went 5-20 in the series.

Offensive Production

Through a little over a month, Reading's offense continues to rank towards the top of the Eastern League in multiple categories. The Fightin Phils lead the league in hitting at .257, which is 12 points ahead of second-place Portland. Reading also ranks fourth in runs scored. The offensive production has been helped by five double-digit scoring games so far. Reading had nine double-digit scoring games in 2022.

Kroon Turn Around

After a recent dry spell, Matthew Kroon has turned it around recently. Over his last five games, Kroon is hitting .353 and the same average over his last ten. From April 18-May 2, Kroon hit just .176. So, it seems a strong week at Hartford, which included a five RBI game on May 6, sparked him.

Unique Numbers

Through 32 games, Reading has scored first in 17 games. In those 17 games, Reading holds just a 7-10 record. In 2022, the Fightin Phils were 56-30 when scoring first. So history would suggest that those treds will likely flip at some point. Also, when looking at a tell-tale number for Reading's season, the Fightin Phils are 8-4 when scoring north of five runs and 4-16 when scoring less than five runs. Reading is also above .500 when committing no errors and 2-11 when committing one error or more.

Around the Organization

The Philadelphia Phillies lost their second-straight games, after a previous five-game winning streak, with a 6-3 loss at the Giants last night. Lehigh Valley begins a series on the road at Worcester tonight. Jersey Shore returns home to open a six-game set with Wilmington tonight, while Clearwater puts their Florida State League best 24-9 record on the line this week with a six-game home series against the Bradenton Marauders.

This Day in Baseballtown History

May 16, 1967: At Reading, the Phillies sweep a double-header from Pittsfield, 2-0 and 10-1. The first game (7 innings) takes just 1:15, with Dallas Green needing only 63 pitches to complete the two-hit shutout.

'Sup Somerset

This is the first series of the season between Reading and Somerset. The Patriots sit second in the Northeast Division with a 20-12 record. Last week at Portland, Somerset split the six-game series, with the teams alternating wins in the series between the top-two teams in the division. Next up, the Patriots hit the road for a six-game series at Erie next week before welcoming Portland to Jersey the week after.

Big Leaguer

A very familiar face will be getting the ball for Somerset in Yankees' righty Luis Severino, who is making a rehab start. Severino was placed on the IL in March with a right lat strain. He made a rehab start for triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre and allowed one-earned run over 3.1 innings. He made rehab starts in Somerset in both 2021 and 2022. In 2022, he went 7-3, with a 3.18 ERA over 19 starts and struck out 112 in 102 innings.
