TODAY'S GAME: The Curve are in the midst of their 25th anniversary season, opening up a six-game set with Akron.

LAST TIME OUT: Altoona got their hearts ripped out in a 7-6 loss in 13 innings on Sunday afternoon at Bowie. All 6 runs scored via home runs from Jackson Glenn (solo), Chavez Young (3-run) and Joe Perez (2-run).

HE'S HERE: Right-hander Paul Skenes, the No. 1 Overall selection in the 2023 draft has joined the Curve for his Double-A debut on Saturday, August 26. Skenes is the 5th player No. 1 overall selection to suit up for the Curve following RHP Kris Benson (1996 / 2002 rehab), RHP Bryan Bullington (2002, 2004 with Curve), RHP Gerrit Cole (2011 / 2012 with Curve) and C Henry Davis (2021 / 2022-23 with Curve). Skenes has thrown 4.0 innings scoreless innings with the FCL Pirates and Bradenton in his professional career and is ranked as the No. 3 overall prospect in MiLB by MLB Pipeline.

EXTRA EXTRA: Sunday, August 20 in Bowie, the Curve dropped a heartbreaking 7-6 loss to the Baysox in 13 innings. After taking a 4-3 lead in the 9th inning on Chavez Young's 3-run homer, Bowie's Silas Ardoin tied the game with a solo shot in the bottom of the ninth. The game remained 4-4 through 12 innings until **Joe Perez** led off the 13th with a 2-run shot. In the bottom of the inning, Bowie's Greg Cullen knocked a 2-run walk-off shot to slay the Curve. Altoona's 13-inning game was the longest game in terms of innings since August 28, 2017 at Richmond when the Curve lost 2-1 in 15 innings.

GET SHORTY: Righty Aaron Shortridge has turned in his best work of the season since the calendar flipped to the second half. Since June 28 he's recorded a 3.52 ERA, the best mark by a qualified Curve pitcher. In the month of August, Shortridge has earned a win in all three of his starts and recorded a 1.71 ERA (4 ER / 21.0 IP) with just one walk and 15 strikeouts. 8 times this season, Shortridge has turned in a quality start. The 26-year-old ranks 1st in the Eastern League with 22 starts and 2nd with 115.1 IP.

NOT YOUR AVERAGE JOE: Signed as a minor league free agent on August 10 after six seasons in the Astros system, utility man Joe Perez matched his career-high with 4 hits on August 15 at Bowie. Perez homered twice in Altoona's series at Bowie last week and has at least one hit in each of his 8 games played with Altoona, batting .375/.412/.719/1.131 with 2 2B, 3 HR, 6 RBI, and 12 K's.

OUR OWN HOWLER: Left-hander Jackson Wolf, acquired from the San Diego Padres in the Rich Hill and Ji Man Choi deal, has continued to be one of Double-A's best strikeout artists this season. He's struck out 14 in three starts with Altoona in 13.0 innings giving him 119 this season between San Antonio and Altoona, the 10th-most strikeouts by a pitcher at the level.

IT"S OFFICIALLY GEN Z: Infielder Tsung-Che Cheng owns the Eastern League's longest hit streak this season at 17 games, a streak that ended on August 11 against Erie. Cheng's tied Kevin Newman for the seventh-longest in franchise history, falling a few games short of Austin Meadows' 24-game hit streak in 2016 that stands as the franchise record. Cheng batted .393/.415/.574/.989 with 5 2B, 2 HR, 9 RBI, 3 BB, 9 K and 3-3 SB during his streak. Cheng's 10 triples this season are the most in minor league baseball.

THE BIG LEFTY: Lefty Anthony Solometo is the youngest pitcher to reach the Eastern League this season, doing so at 20 years, 6 months and 15 days when he made his debut on June 17 at Somerset. Solometo is the 13th player in franchise history to suit up for the Curve under the age of 21 and slots in as the 5th-youngest player in the team's history between C Ryan Doumit, who was 20 years, 4 months, 0 days old when he debuted on August 3, 2001, and LHP Sean Burnett, who was 20 years, 6 months, 18 days old when he debuted on April 4, 2003. Solometo leads all qualified Pirates minor leaguers with a 3.14 ERA and ranks 5th with 108 strikeouts this season. He is one of 8 players to play EL at age 20 or younger, Harrisburg has two of them: Brady House and James Wood. Jackson Holliday (BOW), Jasson Dominguez (SÓM), Yanquel Fernandez (HFD), Blaze Jordan (POR) and Marcelo Mayer (POR) are the other players in the league that are not permitted to drink

STRIKEOUTS ARE ALL THE RAGE: Throughout the 2023 season, Altoona has been one of the league's most-difficult teams to strike out. Entering play on Sunday, August 20, Altoona has struck out 906 times, still the fewest among Double-A teams and 5th-fewest in minor league baseball. Altoona's franchise record for fewest strikeouts in a season is 811 achieved in 2003 when the Curve struck out an average of 5.75 times per game. The 2023 Curve are striking out an average of 8.23 times per game.

DUCKS ON THE POND: Rouglas Odor, the uncle of San Diego Padres infielder Rougned Odor, is back in the rubber city as Manager for a fourth season after previously coaching in Akron with the Aeros from 2011-2013 and later as the Hitting Coach in 2015-17. His squad features some top Guardians prospects according to MLB Pipeline: No. 6 INF Juan Brito, No. 19 RHP Tanner Burns, No. 20 OF Petey Halpin, No. 26 LHP Doug Nikhazy, No. 27 LHP Will Dion,

THE FIRST RUBBER ON THE ROAD: Tommy Mace takes the ball for the 'Ducks in the series opener. Mace was the 69th overall selection by Cleveland in 2021 out of the University of Florida. The Tampa native joined the 'Ducks in late-June and has steadied the rotation, he recorded a 2.66 ERA in 5 games (2 starts) during the month of July. Mace attended Sunlake High School in Florida and uses a 5-pitch arsenal that includes the addition of a cutter in his final season at Florida.
