LAST TIME OUT: The Cyclones were handed their first defeat of 2025 on Wednesday afternoon in a 7-2 loss to Hudson Valley...Despite the defeat, SS **Boston Baro** clubbed his first home run of 2025, while LHP **Jonathan Santucci** impressed in his professional debut...The southpaw tossed 4.0+ innings of 2-run ball, while striking out 6 and walking just 1...CF **Eli Serrano III** continued his hot start to 2025, finishing the day 2-for-5 at the dish...RHP **Anthony Nunez** was sharp in his second outing of the season...The 23-year-old recorded 5 strikeouts over 1.2 frames...Of the 8 outs Nunez has recorded this season, all of them have been K's...Still, Brooklyn left 10 men on the bases, and went just 1-for-14 with runners in scoring position...The Renegades broke the game open in the sixth, when C **Antonio Gómez** hit a grand slam to push Hudson Valley's lead to 6-0 at the time.

GET YOUR NEW YORK SPORTS, HERE!: Thursday's game marks the first of 5 Cyclones games this season to air on SNY, the TV home of the New York Mets...Brooklyn...Other games slated to hit the SNY airwaves this season include May 1st vs. Wilmington, May 18th vs. Winston-Salem, May 29th vs. Aberdeen & June 12th vs. Asheville...Cyclones broadcasters **Justin Rocke** and **Johnny Gadamowitz** will broadcast all 5 contests, while the Cyclones production crew that produce all 66 home games will be at the controls...It's the 2nd-straight season that SNY will feature various Cyclones games throughout the year...Last year, Brooklyn went 2-2 on SNY.

THE LONG HALL: RHP **Noah Hall** spun his best career pro outing on Opening Day for Brooklyn...The 2023 draftee picked up the win, thanks to 5.0 innings of 1-run ball...Hall surrendered only 3 hits, and gave up just 1 run...The righty also punched out 3 batters and walked 4...The University of South Carolina product became not only the 1st player in franchise history to start on consecutive Opening Days, but the 1st player in franchise history to start multiple Opening Days...Last year, was placed on the injured list on April 26 and did not pitch again until September 7 with Single-A St. Lucie.

SOARIN' SERRANO: OF **Eli Serrano III** has impressed to begin his High-A career...The 2024 Mets 4th-round selection is 8-for-18 at the plate...3 of his 8 hits have gone for extra bases, including 2 home runs - one of which was a mammoth blast to right-center field - no small feat at Maimonides Park...The N.C. State product has also displayed a keen eye at the plate, drawing six walks through five games...Serrano III is tied for the league lead in home runs and tied for 3rd in walks entering play on Thursday...The North Carolina native appeared in 17 games at the tail end of last year with Single-A St. Lucie, and collected a .778 OPS

'PEN = NAILS: Brooklyn's bullpen has been outstanding amidst the Cyclones 4-1 start... Through five games, the Cyclones bullpen has surrendered only 9 runs over 24.0 innings of relief work...The 3.38 bullpen ERA is good for fourth in the South Atlantic League...Sunday's win over Wilmington saw the trio of RHPs **Jace Beck**, **Austin Troesser** and **Anthony Nunez** record four shutout innings, during which, they faced the minimum 12 batters...8 of the 12 outs recorded were strikeouts...On Saturday, RHPs **Ben Simon**, **Joel Diaz** and **Dylan Ross** combined for 6.1 frames of scoreless relief work...Simon picked up with win, while Diaz logged the save...The quartet struck out a combined 15 Wilmington batters throughout the course of the day...It's been a similar native for Brooklyn starters as well, who have compiled a 2.57 ERA through the first 5 games.

SUERO SUAVE: C **Chris Suero** is off to a scorching start in 2025...The Bronx native is one of two players on the Cyclones with multiple home runs...Suero is a blistering 8-for-21 at the dish, with 6 extra-base hits, 8 runs batted in, and boasts an impressive 1.266 OPS...The 2022 international free agent signee is coming off an impressive 2024, that saw him play in 87 games at the High-A level, with 7 home runs and 45 RBI, while also swiping 15 stolen bases

THOR'S HAMMER: LHP **Zach Thornton** picked up right where he left off in 2024 in his season debut on Sunday...The Grand Canyon University product collected his first win of the year, behind five shutout innings against Wilmington...Thornton allowed only two base hits and one walk, while striking out a career-high eight Blue Rocks batters...In 2024, Thornton pitched in four games with Brooklyn down the stretch, starting four games to the tune of a 3.67 ERA

YOU GET A HIT, YOU GET A HIT, YOU GET A HIT...YOU GET THE POINT: In Saturday's lopsided victory over Wilmington, Brooklyn put up some gaudy numbers that haven't been seen on the boardwalk in quite some time...The 15 runs scored are the most scored in a single game by the Cyclones since Brooklyn scored 18 times in an 18-1 victory at Jersey Shore on August 28, 2022...The Cyclones offensive output was their best at Maimonides Park since June 24, 2010, vs. Hudson Valley, in a 16-5 win... Additionally, Brooklyn's 20 hits collected on Saturday were the most hits the 'Clones in any game since a 20-hit effort in a 13-0 triumph vs. Aberdeen on July 21, 2011...3B **Richard Lucas** went 5-for-6 at the dish, while CF **Travis Taijeron** was a perfect 4-for-4 with 5 RBI...The contest was just the second game since 2005 where Brooklyn accumulated 15+ runs and 20+ hits in the same contest...The Cyclones first accomplished the feat with 16 runs and 22 hits in a 16-7 win at Tri-City on July 13, 2007.

REIM TIME!: It's difficult to get out to much of a hotter start than Cyclones INF **Jacob Reimer**...Through 5 games, the California native is an impressive 7-for-22 at the plate with 8 RBI, 5 runs scored, 2 doubles and a triple...The 2022 draftee is tied for 3rd in circuit in RBI (8), tied for 5th in the league in doubles (2), tied for 8th in hits (7), and tied for 9th in runs scored (5)...Reimer collected more RBI through his first 2 games played this season than he logged all of last year through 25 games scattered across three different levels.

BOARDWALK BENGEE: OF **Carson Benge** started his 2025 on the right foot thanks to a keen eye at the plate...Benge is 3-for-10 with a double, RBI and 3 walks through his first 3 games played...The 2024 first-round draftee by the Mets made Wilmington pitchers work over the weekend, drawing 3 free passes, while going 2-for-6 at the plate in the couple of games of the season...The Oklahoma State

vs. HUDSON VALLEY: The Cyclones welcome in the Hudson Valley Renegades for the first installment of the SAL Subway Series of 2025... The Yankees High-A affiliate went 2-1 against Jersey Shore to start the new year, including an 8-7 walk-off victory on Saturday...Hudson Valley boasts 8 top 30 Yankees prospects including INF **George Lombard Jr.** (2), RHP **Ben Hess** (4), RHP **Bryce Cunningham** (6), RHP **Elmer Rodríguez-Cruz** (8), RHP **Cade Smith** (16), RHP **Carlos Lagrange** (19), LHP **Kyle Carr** (20) and INF **Roc Riggio** (27).

product laced a double to left field on Friday for the first High-A hit of his career, and then went 1-for-4 on Sunday...Five of Bengie's 15 hits with Single-A St. Lucie went for extra base hits at the tail end of last year...The Yukon, OK native clubbed 2 home runs and 3 doubles in the Florida State league during his time in PSL.

2024 IN REVIEW: Although the Cyclones did not qualify for the postseason last year, 2024 saw a bevy of achievements on the boardwalk...Numerous franchise records were set, including the all time games played, hits and stolen base records, in addition to the single season hits and stolen base records being set...The 2024 'Clones tossed the first nine-inning no-hitter in franchise history thanks to a combined effort, and six players appeared in Brooklyn on big league rehab assignments.

BROOKLYN TO THE BIGS: After four former Cyclones made their Major League debuts in 2024, three alumni had already accomplished the feat before the end of March in 2025...C **Hayden Senger** ('18, '21) came off the bench and became the 103rd former Cyclone to play in the Majors and the 68th to debut with the New York Mets on Opening Day, March 27 at Houston...Three days later, on March 30, OF **Jake Mangum** ('19, '21) batted second and played right field for the Tampa Bay Rays and went 0-for-3 with a walk...RHP **Mike Vasil** debuted for the Chicago White Sox a day later, tossing 2.0 innings of two-hit shutout relief, whiffing 1B **Ty France** for his first Major League strikeout...The franchise record for debuts in a single season is nine in 2015 and 2017.

GOMEZ GEARED UP FOR ROUND TWO IN BK: Cyclones manager **Gilbert Gómez** embarks on his second season at the helm after serving as the youngest manager in franchise history in 2024...The 33 year old becomes the first Cyclones skipper to begin a 2nd consecutive season as manager since **Edgardo Alfonzo** (2017-2019)...Gómez led Brooklyn to a 65-67 record during his inaugural season at the controls...Gómez spent the winter as the head man for Tigers del Licey in the Dominican Winter League.

FAMILIAR FACES: 21 players on the Cyclones break camp roster have previous playing experience in Brooklyn...Notables include: INF **Boston Baro**, who played in 11 games with Brooklyn towards the end of last season...INF **Jacob Reimer**, who suited up in 39 games for the 'Clones over the last two years...RHP **Dakota Hawkins** had a hand in the first nine inning no-hitter in franchise history last year...RHP **Ben Simon** logged 22 appearances, the most amongst any returning pitcher outside of Hawkins.

NEW KIDS ON THE BLOCK: Seven members of the Mets' 2024 draft class will begin the 2025 campaign with the Cyclones...RHP **Ryan Lambert** is the lone '24 draftee that returns to the Brooklyn roster, while 1st round selection OF **Carson Benge**, 2nd round pick LHP **Jonathan Santucci** and 4th rounder OF **Eli Serrano III** all will make their High-A debuts...RHP **Brendan Girton**, RHP **R.J. Gordon** & INF **Nick Roselli** round out the class.

LEVITTOWN LEGEND: INF **Nick Roselli** grew up 34 miles northeast of Maimonides Park in Long Island's Levittown...The 11th round pick played his college ball at Binghamton University, where he was a career .349 hitter for the Bearcats...The Division High School product grew up a huge Mets fan, and was considered to have the "Best Pro Debut" of any member of the 2024 Mets draft class by *Baseball America*...Roselli hit the ground running last year in the Florida State League, notching an .869 OPS across 18 games with Single-A St. Lucie.

KEEP IT IN THE BALLPARK!: With so much of Brooklyn's pitching staff returning from last year, it's worth noting that Cyclones pitchers led the South Atlantic League by a wide margin in home runs allowed (59)...Hudson Valley was the next closest (78)...Of the 59 long balls permitted, only 20 of them came at Maimonides Park...Over the last two seasons, Brooklyn arms have surrendered just 55 home runs in 132 home games.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: Brooklyn's Opening Day Roster features no shortage of talent...According to MLB Pipeline, the Cyclones boast 7 of the Mets Top 30 prospects...Those include OF **Carson Benge** (3), LHP **Jonathan Santucci** (13), INF **Boston Baro** (14), INF **Jacob Reimer** (21), C **Chris Suero** (22), OF **Eli Serrano III** (23) and C **Ronald Hernandez** (27)...Of those 7, 4 have previous experience playing in Brooklyn...Those include OF **Carson Benge** (3), LHP **Jonathan Santucci** (13), INF **Boston Baro** (14), INF **Jacob Reimer** (21), C **Chris Suero** (22), OF **Eli Serrano III** (23) and C **Ronald Hernandez** (27)...Of those 7, 4 have previous experience playing in Brooklyn.

LAST START: Earned the first victory of his professional career on Opening Day, last Friday night, vs. Wilmington...Tossed a career-high-tying 5.0 innings, allowing 1 run on 3 hits...Walked 4 and struck out 3...Charged with a wild pitch and a balk...Induced a pair of double plays...Threw 66 pitches and 45 strikes (68.2%)...Retired the leadoff batter in 4 of 5 innings...Relieved by RHP **Dakota Hawkins** to start the top of the 6th inning, and the Cyclones leading, 6-1...Brooklyn went on to defeat the Blue Rocks, 8-4.

HALL PASS: Hall started on Opening Day for the Cyclones for the second-straight year on 4/4 vs. Wilmington...The 24-year-old was Brooklyn's starter on Opening Day in 2024, taking the loss on 4/5 at Wilmington...Hall is the only pitcher in Cyclones history to start on back-to-back Opening Days and the only arm in franchise history to start the first game of the season multiple times.

2024: Spent most of the campaign with Brooklyn...Made his professional debut as the Cyclones' 2024 Opening Day starter on 4/5 at Wilmington...Suffered the loss, allowing 4 runs on 5 hits in 3.2 innings...Walked 3 and struck out 3...Best start of the season came on 4/18 at Jersey Shore...Allowed only 1 run on 4 hits in a career-high 5.0 innings...Walked 2 and punched out 3 in a no-decision...Placed on Brooklyn's 7-day injured list (shoulder) on 4/26...Transferred to 60-day IL on 5/12...Joined Single-A St. Lucie for a rehab assignment on 9/7...Combined to tally a 0-2 record with a 9.65 ERA (14 ER in 13.0 IP), 10 walks, and 12 strikeouts in 5 starts.

FREE FALL-IN': Following the 2024 season, Hall pitched for the Scottsdale Scorpions of the prestigious Arizona Fall League...Accumulated a 0-1 mark with a 5.40 ERA (4 ER in 6.2 IP) and 3 strikeouts...Best outing came on 10/18 vs. Surprise...Allowed 1 unearned run on 1 hit over 3.0 innings, allowing 3 walks and striking out 2.

PALMETTO POWER: The Charlotte, N.C. native spent 2 years at the University of South Carolina before joining the professional ranks...Before missing the remainder of the 2023 season with a back injury, Hall garnered a 5-1 record, a 3.29 ERA (15 ER in 41.0 IP) and 43 strikeouts in 7 starts for the Gamecocks...The right-hander tallied 121 strikeouts in 117.2 innings over 22 appearances (19 starts) at South Carolina...He described South Carolina as his "dream school since I was a little kid"...He has multiple South Carolina alumni on his mom's side of the family and attended their sporting events as early as the age of 2 or 3.

APP-ETIZER: Before spending a pair of seasons at South Carolina, Hall was a member of Appalachian State University's baseball program in 2020 and 2021...Serving predominantly as a reliever, the 7th-round pick was named a Freshman All-American in 2021 by Collegiate Baseball...In 28 appearances (5 starts) for the Mountaineers, Hall was 7-1 with a 3.36 ERA (36 ER in 69.2 IP), 4 saves, and 73 strikeouts.

WELCOME TO NEW YORK: Hall was selected by the New York Mets in the 7th round of the 2023 MLB Draft out of the University of South Carolina...The right-hander inked his deal with the organization, earning a \$176,250 signing bonus.

TAKE TWO: Hall was drafted for the second time in 2023...The Charlotte native was taken by the Milwaukee Brewers in the 20th round of the 2022 MLB Draft out of the University of South Carolina, but did not sign.
