TODAY marks game #15 of the 2024 season, the 6th game of a six-game roadtrip, and the 6th game a six-game series against the Great Lakes Loons. These two teams played 24 times during the 2023 regular season, with the Loons winning the season series 13-11. The Whitecaps are a Detroit Tigers affiliate in their 31st season in professional baseball, while the Loons are in their 18th year of professional baseball affiliation with the Los Angeles Dodgers.

UP NEXT: The 'Caps return home for a rematch of Opening Weekend, but this time on their home turf to begin a six-game series at LMCU Ballpark against the Lake County Captains at LMCU Ballpark from April 23-28 before concluding the month with a six-game road set at Day Air Ballpark against the Dayton Dragons from April 30-May 5.

STORYLINES AND HEADLINES

'CAPS LOSE BIG LEAD IN 9-8 LOSS: The West Michigan Whitecaps bullpen lost a lead for the fourth time in five days as part of a 9-8 loss to the Great Lakes Loons Saturday afternoon at Dow Diamond. The Whitecaps started strong, enjoying a 5-0 advantage after two innings and a 6-4 advantage entering the sixth. However, the Loons scored five times to come-from-behind against the 'Caps bullpen once again, turning the game around. The contest began as a slugfest, with the 'Caps taking advantage of a pair of Loons wild pitches to take a 3-0 lead after two innings. In the third, the 'Caps used a two-run single by Izaac Pacheco to expand their advantage to 5-0, but the Loons responded with a pair of runs in the next two innings highlighted by a Yunior Garcia two-run homer to bring the West Michigan lead to 6-4. In the sixth, West Michigan reliever Tanner Kohlhepp walked three batters – including two with the bases loaded – hit a batter and gave up a pair of hits as the Loons rallied to take a 9-6 lead. Luke Gold collected his fourth hit of the day with a two-run home run down the right field line, but the Loons shut the door in the ninth to seal their victory. The comeback gives the Loons rallies in every close game of this six-game series in Midland and gives Great Lakes the chance to gain a series split with a win on Sunday. Great Lakes reliever Frankie De La Paz (1-0) tossed two scoreless frames in earning his first win of the 2024 season, while Kohlhepp (2-2) gave up five runs in taking his first second of the season. Livan Reinoso finished the contest by the final 'Caps hitter to earn the first save of the season. West Michigan drops to 6-8 while the Loons jump to 8-6. Jenkins and Gold each reached base four times in a losing cause for the Whitecaps.

STARTING OVER FINISHING: Whitecaps starting pitchers have combined for a 1.22 ERA (10 ER, 70 IP), while the bullpen's sits at 4.60. (23 ER, 45 IP)

I LOVE GOOOOOOOLD: Infielder Luke Gold posted three straight three-hit performances at Great Lakes from April 18-20, while a four-hit performance on the 20th. Gold has hit .588 with 3 doubles and two home runs in this series with a game to play, and has a chance at bringing home MWL Player of the Week.

NIGHT OWLS: The Whitecaps are 5-3 in night games, while having lost 5 of 6 contests during the day.

PROSPECTS APLENTY: The Whitecaps hold five of the Top 30 Detroit Tigers prospects, and are mentioned near the top right corner of this page.

Acquired: Signed by the Tigers as an international free agent on January 25, 2021.

Marcano, who was signed by the Tigers as an international free agent in 2021 (the same class that featured Cristian Santana) was the youngest pitcher in the Florida State League to surpass 20 innings pitched in 2023. The teenager held his own in his first full season at the low-A level, tossing 100 innings while going 4-5 with a 4.50 ERA and generating 78 strikeouts and reducing hard contact (holding opposing hitters to a .237 batting average against).

LAST START: Marcano, the youngest player on the Whitecaps roster, posted his second straight impressive performance, tossing four scoreless innings while striking out four as part of a 4-3 win over the Great Lakes Loons on April 16 at Dow Diamond.

2023: After being a full-time member of the Flying Tigers bullpen the year prior, Marcano transitioned into the starting rotation where he posted a 4.50 ERA through 100 innings pitched and racked up 78 strikeouts and reducing hard contact (allowed just seven home runs).

2022: Marcano came out of the bullpen in his first season with the Flying Tigers but struggled with hard contact, posting a 4.68 ERA while giving up 47 hits through 42.1 innings pitched. However, his strikeout-to-walk ratio stood out, generating 41 punchouts to just 18 walks on the season.

2021: Marcano enjoyed his breakout in the Dominican Summer League. Despite a 5.25 ERA, he displayed his ability to rack up his strikeout totals, punching out 41 hitters while allowing just 10 walks through 36 innings of work.

More: His repertoire includes a sinker/fastball, two breaking balls, and a changeup. The fastball/sinker is his primary pitch that sits in the low 90s which he's able to generate a ton of ground balls with. The two breaking balls are a curveball and a slider. The slider posted a 54% whiff rate in 2023, while the curveball posted a 36%.

His size is very projectible - listed at 6'2, 150 pounds, there is still plenty of room to grow into his body.
