FRISCO CANNOT HOLD 10-RUN LEAD IN CRUSHING DEFEAT:

The Frisco RoughRiders dropped the Amarillo Sod Poodles 5-1 on Thursday night from HODGETOWN behind strong pitching and a **Jax Biggers** grand slam. The Sod Poodles (10-8) struck first in the bottom of the first inning when Ryan Bliss homered off of Frisco (9-9) starter **Tekoah Roby** (1-2). The solo shot was the only damage against the Riders on the night. Roby went 5.0 innings in his win, allowing just one run on four hits while striking out eight and walking one. The Riders tied the game in the top of the fourth when **Thomas Saggese** plated **Luisangel Acuña** with an RBI ground out and Biggers then crushed his grand slam in the sixth to make it 5-1. It was Frisco's fourth grand slam of the season, which is the most in Minor League Baseball. **Grant Wolfram** was brilliant out of the Frisco bullpen, tossing three shutout innings, and **Antoine Kelly** added a scoreless ninth.

STRONGER IN A WOLF(RAM) PACK:

The RoughRiders bullpen has been highlighted by **Grant Wolfram** this season. The 6'8 lefty has thrown six scoreless outings this season and is 2-0. Over 9.1 innings, he has allowed just three hits while striking out 11 and walking one. On Thursday in Amarillo, Wolfram threw 3.0 scoreless innings, his longest scoreless outing since July 4th, 2021 when he threw 6.0 scoreless as a starter with Hickory. Through his last 16 games with the Riders in 2022, he went 1-1 with a 1.77 ERA.

O(wen), THAT'S QUALITY:

On Tuesday, Owen White threw the first quality start for the RoughRiders this season when he tossed six innings, allowing three runs while striking out four. He retired the first 10 he saw and allowed just one hit through five shutout innings before ceding a run in the sixth and left two on in the seventh when he exited, both of which came into score.

AND WE THOUGHT WE WERE SAFE:

The RoughRiders fell to the Amarillo Sod Poodles on Tuesday 9-7, twice leading by six runs. It was the first time that the RoughRiders lost a game leading by at least six runs since May 13th, 2007 when the RoughRiders dropped a game 9-8 to the Midland Rock-Hounds. In that game, Frisco led 8-1 in the top of the seventh before Midland scored seven runs in the bottom of the seventh to tie it and one in the eighth to take the lead. Similarly, on Tuesday, the Riders allowed six in the seventh to tie the game and two runs in the eighth for the go-ahead tallies. On Wednesday, Frisco led 11-1 before falling 12-11 in 10 innings. The 10-run lead that the Riders could not hold was the largest lead lost in a defeat in recorded franchise history (back to 2005).

LOAD UP UM:

The RoughRiders have had a league-high 27 RBIs with the bases loaded this season. As a team, they are hitting .364 (8-for-22)/.333/1.000/1.333 with four grand slams and 27 RBIs. They are the only team in Minor League Baseball with four grand slams this season already as **Trevor Hauver** hit one on Opening Day, **Dustin Harris** added another in San Antonio, **Luisangel Acuña** blasted one against Arkansas and **Jax Biggers** slugged one in Amarillo. The Riders have had one grand slam in each of the four series they have played this season.

DEFENSE WINS CHAMPIONSHIPS:

The RoughRiders have just committed seven errors through 18 games and committed their first position player error on Sunday in San Antonio. The team's .989 fielding percentage is first in Minor League Baseball. Their seven errors are the fewest in the minors.

WALK THIS WAY:

On the season, Frisco's 101 walks lead Double-A while their .356 team OBP is second in Double-A. **Dustin Harris** has the Double-A lead with 18 walks while **Evan Carter** is tied for second with 17 and is third in OBP (.493).

I LIKE BIG WINS AND I CANNOT LIE:

The RoughRiders nine wins this season have come by eight, six, seven, seven, 10, four runs, eight runs, three runs and four runs, respectively, while their nine losses have come by a combined 25 runs. That gives Frisco a +32 run differential through 18 games, which is first in the Texas League despite being third in the South Division. The only team with a +20 run differential in the league is Tulsa, which is 11-5 (+32). The RoughRiders have scored at least six runs 10 times (8-2) and scored three or fewer runs seven times (0-7).

EVAN ALMIGHTY:

Outfielder **Evan Carter** has reached safely in 14 of his 15 games this season, batting .333 (19-for-57)/.493/.561/1.054 with a double, four home runs, 17 walks, 18 RBIs and three stolen bases. Carter is seventh in the Texas League in average (.333), tied for sixth in home runs (4), second in RBIs (18), second in walks (17) and sixth in OPS (1.054). The No. 1 prospect in the Rangers system won a MiLB Rawlings Gold Glove in 2022. The reigning Tom Greive Rangers Minor League Player of the Year, Carter joined the RoughRiders for the last week of the 2022 season and the playoffs. Carter is also the third-youngest player in the Texas League this season, trailing on 19-year-old Deyvison De Los Santos of Amarillo and 20-year-old Juan Santander of Corpus Christi. Since going 0-for-4 for the first time this season on Saturday in San Antonio, Carter has walked 12 times to two strikeouts over seven games with a 1.083 OPS.

ABOUT RYAN

-Went to La Salle High School in Pasadena, California. There, his senior year, he owned a 1.16 ERA while striking out 48 in 42.1 innings, but played primarily infield.

-Went to UCLA camp as an infielder and asked one of the coaches if he could pitch the last inning of one of the games. He ended up throwing well enough that UCLA invited him out for a visit as a pitcher. He came back two weeks later and committed on the spot.

-At UCLA, he was named Pac-12 Pitcher of the Year and a consensus First Team All-American in 2019 as a junior. Over 16 games (13 starts), Garcia went 10-1 with a 1.44 ERA. In 94.0 innings, he whiffed 117 batters while walking just 26 and holding opponents to a .160 batting average. In his career with the Bruins, he went 20-2 with a 2.11 ERA. His 2.11 career ERA is seventh in UCLA history.

-His best start during his junior year came against Utah on April 26th, 2019. Over a 9.0-inning complete-game, shutout he struck out 14 batters while allowing just three base runners (two hits and one walk). The 14 strikeouts were the most by a UCLA starter since Trevor Bauer in 2011.

-Led the Wareham Gatemen of the Cape Cod League to a championship in 2018, going 2-0 with a 1.28 ERA over 10 outings.

-Now lives in Surprise, Arizona, about two blocks away from the Rangers Spring Training Complex.

2023 SEASON

-In his Double-A debut on April 11th at San Antonio, Garcia allowed just two solo home runs while tying a career-best five innings.

2022 SEASON

-Was activated in late May while continuing his rehabilitation from injuries.

-His thought for the 2022 season was "I have built a house this season, coming back from injury, and next season, I will be able to fortify the house."

-Averaged 11.8 K/9 over his 14 games (13 starts).

2021 SEASON

-Missed the entire 2021 season with a right lat strain. That required two months of rest and then trying to build back up, but he strained his lat three different times and was unable to get back on the mound.

2019 SEASON

-Three starts into his professional career, he went on the Injured List with a right elbow strain and underwent "Tommy John" surgery on March 16th, 2020.

-During his TJ rehab, he built a computer from scratch and is very interested in technology.
