YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the Bowie Baysox, 2-1, at The Diamond. Richmond scored its only two runs in the first inning with a two-run homer by **Sean Roby**, his eighth of the year and his seventh at home. **Frankie Tostado** had Richmond's only other hit, a single in the seventh inning. Bowie closed within a run in the third when Zach Watson scored on a sac fly by Gunnar Henderson. Richmond pitchers **Gray Fenter**, **Solomon Bates**, **Travis Perry**, **Taylor Rashi** and **R.J. Dabovich** did not allow an earned run on the night. The Baysox went 0-for-7 with runners in scoring position and left eight runners on base.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the fifth of a six-game series against the Bowie Baysox, Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles. The Flying Squirrels and Baysox met for a three-game set in Bowie to open the season from April 8-10, with Richmond picking up two wins. After this week's six-game series, the two teams will meet for three more games in Richmond from July 22-24. The Flying Squirrels travel to Bowie for a six-game set from June 28-July 3 and again from September 6-11.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have won three of their last four games, all in this week's series against the Baysox. Last week, they dropped four of six in their road set at Erie. It was the first series loss of the year for the Flying Squirrels. They opened the season taking two in a three-game series at Bowie from April 8-10 before winning four games in a six-game set against Altoona in their first homestand from April 12-17. The Flying Squirrels have the second-most offensive strikeouts in the league (215) and are tied for fourth in home runs (24).

THE BAYSOX snapped a three-game losing slide with Wednesday's win after winning their previous four games in last week's home series against the Akron RubberDucks. They have dropped five of six overall. After dropping two of three against the Flying Squirrels at home to begin the season, the Baysox won three of five at Binghamton from April 12-17, with one game postponed until June. Bowie's roster includes six of MLB.com's top-30 Orioles prospects, including Gunnar Henderson (3), Jordan Westburg (6), Joseph Ortiz (15), Hudson Haskin (16), Drew Rom (17) and Adam Hall (28).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Matt Frisbee** makes his third start of the season and his first against the Baysox. He made his season debut for the Flying Squirrels on April 20 and allowed one run in 2.2 innings while throwing 61 pitches. He pitched on three days of rest on Sunday in the series finale at Erie and allowed one run over three innings. Last year, he began the season with the Flying Squirrels and went 4-1 with a 1.24 ERA in five starts in the month of May, earning a promotion to Triple-A Sacramento on June 3. In 11 outings (nine starts) with the River Cats, he went 1-6 with a 7.64 ERA and was assigned back to Richmond on August 6. He made six more starts to finish the season with the Flying Squirrels, going 1-3 with a 6.16 ERA. On May 13 at Harrisburg, Frisbee worked six perfect innings and combined with **Joey Marciano**, **Matt Seelinger** and **Patrick Ruotolo** for the first nine-inning no-hitter in Flying Squirrels franchise history. Frisbee was drafted in the 15th round in 2018 by the Giants out of UNC Greensboro. **For more on Frisbee, see page two.**

FOR BOWIE: Right-hander Zach Peek makes his fourth start of the year and his first against the Flying Squirrels. Last time out, he allowed two runs over four innings with a season-high five strikeouts against Akron on Sunday at Prince George's Stadium. Peek was selected in the sixth round of the 2019 MLB Draft out of Winthrop by the Los Angeles Angels. He was traded to the Baltimore Orioles on December 4, 2019 along with RHPs Isaac Mattson, Kyle Bradish and Kyle Brnovich in exchange for RHP Dylan Bundy. Last year, Peek pitched his first professional season, splitting time at Low-A Delmarva and High-A Aberdeen as a starter and a reliever. He went 6-3 with a 3.80 ERA over 23 total outings on the year.

PACKING THE HOUSE: On the year, the Richmond Flying Squirrels are leading all of Double-A in total attendance (58,395) and average attendance (5,840). Richmond is 11th of the 120 minor league teams in average attendance. The 9,810 fans at The Diamond on Opening Night is the largest crowd in all of Double-A this year and the largest of all non-Triple-A teams this season.

LOOKING FOR HITS: Over the last five games since April 24, the Flying Squirrels are hitting .171 (25-for-146), which ranks last in the league. In Thursday's win over the Baysox, the Flying Squirrels picked up nine total hits, with five of them coming in five consecutive plate appearances in the first inning. Excluding Wednesday's performance, the Richmond offense has hit .139 (16-for-115) since last Saturday. Over the first 13 games of the year from April 8-22, Richmond hit .250 (106-for-424), which was third in the league, and led the circuit with 21 homers. After being held without a homer on Saturday and Sunday, the Flying Squirrels went deep twice in Tuesday's game before being shut out on Wednesday night and held without a home run on Thursday. **Sean Roby** broke the homer drought with a two-run shot in the first inning of Friday night's 2-1 win.

POWER SURGE: The Richmond offense has hit 24 home runs this season, which is tied for fourth in the Eastern League. **Sean Roby** is leading the league lead with eight homers on the season, with seven coming at The Diamond. Last year, the Flying Squirrels set a franchise record with 127 homers, surpassing the previous record of 109 from 2013. This year, the Flying Squirrels are on pace to hit 174 home runs.

ROBUST: **Sean Roby** is leading the Eastern League with eight home runs on the season. With his two-run homer on Friday night, Roby tied the franchise record for the most home runs in a calendar month, evening **Jarret Parker's** record of eight from May 2013. Seven of Roby's home runs have come at The Diamond, which ties him for the fifth-most homers in a season at home in franchise history. He hit five home runs in the first home series of the season against Altoona from April 12-17 and has hit two in the current series against Bowie. He has hit more homers at home than the team's leaders in 2010 (3), 2012 (6), 2015 (6), 2017 (6) and 2019 (4).

TOASTY: After hitting .263 (10-for-38) over his first 10 games of the year, **Frankie Tostado** is batting .435 (10-for-23) with a homer, a double, five RBIs and a walk over his last six games since April 22. He has picked up multiple hits in three of his last six games and has five multi-hit games on the season. Last year, Tostado finished the season ranked eighth in the Double-A Northeast with 63 RBIs, which was fifth in the Giants system. Tostado hit 14 homers last year, which was tied for 10th-most in a season in Flying Squirrels history. He clubbed his first homer of 2022 on April 22 at Erie. For the season, Tostado is ranked eighth in the league in batting average (.328) and tied for fourth with 20 hits.

MARTY PARTY: After batting .063 (2-for-32) over a nine-game stretch from April 9-22, **Brandon Martorano** has picked up five hits in his last three games. In the current series against the Baysox, Martorano is batting .500 (5-for-10) with two doubles, four RBIs and two walks. On the year against the Baysox, Martorano is hitting .444 (8-for-18) with three doubles, six RBIs and four walks in six games, compared to a .071 (2-for-28, 2 HR, 3 RBI) against all other Eastern League teams.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: **Sean Roby** is leading the Eastern League in homers (8), tied for second in RBIs (15), third in SLG (.702), fourth in OPS (1.079), tied for third in total bases (40) and tied for sixth in runs scored (14). **Frankie Tostado** is eighth in batting average (.328) and tied for fourth in hits (20). **Will Wilson** is tied for ninth in walks (13) and tied for second in runs scored (15). **Jake Dahlberg** is fourth in ERA (2.21), sixth in innings pitched (20.1) and 10th in WHIP (1.08). **Ryan Walker** is leading the league in wins (4) and **Solomon Bates** is tied for second (3).

THE DENNIS PELFREY ERA: On March 3, **Dennis Pelfrey** was named the new manager for the Richmond Flying Squirrels. Last year in his first season as a manager in affiliated baseball, he led the Eugene Emeralds to the High-A West championship. Pelfrey, 44, played six professional seasons in independent baseball from 1999-2004. He began his coaching career at South Grand Prairie High School in Texas in 2006, a position he held through 2015. He continued that role as he began his professional coaching career in 2011 with the Gary SouthShore RailCats, where he spent four seasons. Pelfrey landed his first managerial job in 2015 with the Florence Freedom of the independent Frontier League, a role he held for five seasons through 2019. He was hired by the Giants entering the 2020 season to manage High-A San Jose before the season was canceled due to the outbreak of the COVID-19 pandemic. Under his direction last year, the Emeralds went 69-50 before topping Spokane in the High-A West Championship Series.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have six players ranked in *Baseball America's* Top-40 Giants prospects, including **Will Wilson** (14), **R.J. Dabovich** (17), **Tyler Fitzgerald** (34), **Diego Rincones** (36) and **Kai-Wei Teng** (40). **Franklin Labour** is rated by *Baseball America* as having the "Best Outfield Arm." MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes Dabovich (17), Wilson (22) and **Brett Auerbach** (28).
