LAST TIME OUT: The Cyclones dropped their 2nd-straight home contest on Friday, falling to Asheville, 4-3...Despite the defeat, RHP Will Watson looked strong in his Maimonides Park debut..The 2024 7th-round pick by the Mets spun 4.2 frames of scoreless ball in his second appearance at the High-A level. Watson struck out eight and permitted only two hits...Brooklyn held a 3-0 lead for the majority of the ballgame, but the Tourists put up four runs in the seventh to take a lead they would not relinquish...RHP Andrew Taylor kept the Brooklyn bats at bay over the final 5.0 innings, allowing only one base hit while striking out six and walking none...Asheville C Walker Janek delivered the decisive blow with an RBI double in that four-run 7th to put the Tourists in front.

THE NUMBER ONE SPOT: The Cyclones are mired in a 3-team race for the South Atlantic League First Half North Division crown...Entering play on Saturday, Brooklyn holds a 0.5-game lead on Greensboro for 1st place in the division...The Cyclones are 4.5 games up on 3rd-place Hudson Valley with 5 games remaining in the first half...Brooklyn's magic number to clinch the first half division crown is 5...Any Cyclones wins or Grasshoppers losses will decrease the number...Brooklyn does not play Hudson Valley or Greensboro for the remainder of the half...Greensboro has played one series (April 15-20 vs. Jersey Shore) against a North Division foe and will not play another until the second half (July 1-6 vs./at Aberdeen).

ALL BÁEZ ON ME: After recovering from knee surgery, INF Jesús Báez has slowly returned to form...Since the start of May, Báez leads the South Atlantic League in RBI (28), is 3rd in on-base percentage (.413), 8th in batting average (.301), 4th in OPS (.900), tied for 13th in hits (34), tied for 12th walks (20), and tied for 11th in runs scored (22)...The 20-year-old reached base safely in 17-of-23 plate appearances in the May 20-25 series against Jersey Shore and went 6-for-8 at the plate in May 23's double-header with 3 runs scored, a double, 2 home runs, and 7 RBI, en route to winning South Atlantic League Player of the Week honors...During the week, Báez hit .647 (11-17) with 6 runs scored, 2 home runs, and 10 RBI...The infielder led the circuit in batting average (.647), on-base percentage (.739), slugging percentage (1.059) OPS (1798), and was tied for the league lead in RBI (10)...After OF A.J. Ewing won Player of the Week for May 13-18, it marked the first time Brooklyn hitters had won a league's Player of the Week award in consecutive weeks in franchise history...Báez also was recognized on Milb.com's "Prospect Team of the Week" for his efforts...On May 20, the infielder tied a Cyclones' single-game franchise record, working 4 walks at Jersey Shore...The feat has been accomplished 11 times, most recently by LF Ryan Clifford on April 21, 2024, at Jersey Shore.

CAN'T TUCC THIS: LHP Jonathan Santucci has found his form in 2025...The 2024 Mets' 2nd-round selection is a perfect 4-0 over his last 5 outings (3 starts), including a career-high-tying 5.1 scoreless inning performance in a no-decision last Wednesday at Wilmington...Since May 16 vs. Winston-Salem, the 22-year-old has an 0.72 ERA (2 ER in 25.0 IP) with 13 hits allowed, 9 walks, and 26 strikeouts...Santucci saw his scoreless inning streak come to an end at 18.0 frames in Tuesday's win over Asheville...The southpaw's streak spanned from the 2nd inning in game one of a doubleheader on May 23 at Jersey Shore until the top of the 7th with two outs on Tuesday...Since May 16, Santucci leads the South Atlantic League in ERA (0.72), is tied for 1st in wins (4), 2nd in batting average against (.149), 3rd in WHIP (0.88), and 10th in innings pitched (25.0).

NOAH'S ARC: After being limited to just 13.0 innings in his first professional season in 2024, RHP Noah Hall has found a new gear in 2025...The 24-year-old registered his 1st pro save last Thursday night in Wilmington, tossing 4.0 innings of 1-hit shutout ball... The save was Hall's first since April 30, 2021, vs. the University of Louisiana at Monroe, while pitching for Appalachian State University...Entering play on Saturday, the Charlotte, N.C. native is tied for 2nd in the South Atlantic League in ERA (2.56), 8th in batting average against (.211), and 9th in innings pitched (56.1).

HOME COOKING: Brooklyn has been a model of consistency at Maimonides Park this year...Thursday's defeat marked the end of the Cyclones' 15-game home winning streak...Brooklyn's franchise record for consecutive home wins is 19, set in the inaugural 2001 campaign...Entering play on Saturday, Brooklyn holds the best home record in the South Atlantic League at 24-7 (.774)...Greenville is second best (21-13)...The 24 home wins are tied for the 2nd most home wins in all of MiLB...Only the Athletics' Triple-A Las Vegas has more (26)...Brooklyn's .774 home winning percentage is the best in MiLB...San Francisco's Single-A San José (.714) is 2nd.

GARCÍA LATER: RHP Saúl García has been exquisite in relief for the Cyclones in 2025... Entering Friday, the 21-year-old is tied with Bowling Green's RHP Jack Snyder for the South Atlantic League lead in saves (6)...Among SAL relievers with 17.0 or more innings of work, García paces the circuit in strikeouts-per-9-innings (16.41)...That total is also the best mark in all of High-A...It is also the 6th-best in Minor League Baseball...Los Angeles-NL's High-A Great Lakes RHP Alex Makarewich (18.31) is 1st...Following that same qualifier, García is also 2nd in the SAL in batting average against (.111), 1st in hits-per-9-innings (3.18), and is tied for 8th in ERA (1.59).

KEEP THE 'COASTER MOVING: The Cyclones remained perfect in series through the first 57 games of the 2025 season with Saturday's win at Wilmington, ultimately earning a series split...Through Brooklyn's first 10 series of the year, the Cyclones hold a 7-0-3 record...In home series, Brooklyn is 4-0-1, splitting their first full 6-game set with Hudson Valley from April 8-13...The Cyclones have not lost a series since they dropped 5-of-6 at home vs. Jersey Shore from August 20-25, 2024...Since then, Brooklyn is 9-0-3 in a series of any length...Additionally, the Cyclones 41-20 record is the franchise's best record through 61 games in Minor League Baseball's Digital Era (2005-present)...Brooklyn went 44-17 through 61 contests in their inaugural season in 2001...One more win this week against Asheville would guarantee Brooklyn another series split at the least, as the 'Clones took two of the first four matchups.

REIMER SHINE: INF Jacob Reimer remains scorching hot to start the 2025 season... Entering play on Saturday, Reimer is tied for 12th in Minor League Baseball in runs scored (48)...The former 4th-round pick also leads the South Atlantic League in runs

vs. ASHEVILLE: After splitting a 6-game series in Wilmington, Brooklyn returns home for their final homestand of the season's first half...Asheville enters the series after splitting 6 games in at home against Winston-Salem... The Tourists are 15-17 on the road this season...Brooklyn and Asheville split a 6-game series at McCormick Field from May 6-11...The Tourists boast 8 of the Astros' Top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: C Walker Janek (3), RHP Anderson Brito (5), OF Joseph Sullivan (11), INF Chase Jaworsky (12), OF Kenni Gómez (16), RHP Juan Bello (21), RHP Bryce Mayer (26), and INF Alejandro Núñez (28)...In 27 meetings since 2021, the Cyclones lead the all-time series, 15-12 (.556)...Brooklyn is 6-4 (.600) against the Tourists in 10 games at Maimonides Park. scored (48), is second in the league in slugging percentage (.545) and in OPS (.948)... He's also tied for 1st in doubles (17), 5th in batting average (.300), 2nd in total bases (109) and hits (60), tied for 2nd in the league in extra-base hits (29), tied for 4th in RBI (38), and 6th in on-base percentage (.403)...Reimer was limited to just 35 games in 2024 with a hamstring injury.

BENGE IT LIKE CARSON: OF Carson Benge has been heating up at the plate over the last few weeks...The 2024 first-round pick enters Saturday tied for the South Atlantic League lead in triples (4)...He is also 2nd in runs scored (45), tied for 1st in doubles (17), 4th in extra-base hits (25), 3rd in on-base percentage (.419), 4th in OPS (.1911), tied for 5th in walks (36), 3rd in hits (59), 5th in total bases (96), 3rd in batting average (.303), and 4th in slugging percentage (.492)...The Yukon, Okla. native was recognized on MiLB. com's "Prospect Team of the Week" from May 20-25 after hitting. 412 (-17) with 8 runs scored, 3 doubles, 2 triples, an RBI, 8 walks to 3 strikeouts, 2 stolen bases, and 2 hit-by-pitches in 6 games at Jersey Shore from May 20-25.

EWING-ING IT: IF/OF A.J. Ewing has had a marvelous start to his 2025 season...Entering play on Saturday, the Springboro, Ohio native is tied for 2nd in all of Minor League Baseball in triples (7)...He is also 3rd in stolen bases (43), and 9th in batting average (.337)...Since debuting with Brooklyn on April 29, Ewing leads the league in steals (29 - 7 more than anyone else), is tied for 2nd in hits (44) and triples (3), 6th in batting average (.308), tied for 4th in runs scored (29), and 5th in on-base percentage (.401)...Overall, Ewing is 2nd in the SAL in stolen bags (29)...The 2023 4th-round pick was recognized as the South Atlantic League Player of the Week for May 13-18 vs. Winston-Salem...In 5 games, the 20-year-old went 9-for-18 (.500) at the plate with 5 runs scored, 2 doubles, a triple, 3 RBI, 5 walks, and 6 stolen bases...Ewing led the SAL in steals (6) and on-base percentage (.609) for the week...He was the first Cyclone to receive a league weekly honor since INF Nick Lorusso and LHP Felipe De La Cruz took home Player and Pitcher of the Week, respectively, for May 20-26, 2024.

SWIPER KEEP SWIPING: Brooklyn is off to a historic start on the basepaths in 2025...The Cyclones' 7-6 win vs. Wilmington on April 29 saw them nab a franchise record 9 stolen bases, courtesy of 7 players...The mark topped a previous high of 8 on August 2, 2017, vs. Tri-City...Brooklyn enters play on Saturday with 139 steals, good for the 2nd most in the South Atlantic League behind only Aberdeen (152)...The 139 steals are tied for 8th in Minor League Baseball...Cleveland's Single-A Lynchburg leads MiLB (181)...Brooklyn already has 6 players with 10-or-more steals on the season...The 139 swiped bags are the most by the Cyclones through the team's first 61 games in Minor League Baseball's Digital era (2005-present) by 51 swipes...The 2005 club is 2nd with 91 steals through 61 games...The Cyclones are 43 steals shy of breaking their single-season franchise record of 181 steals set in 2024.

IT'S A WALK-OFF: C Chris Suero provided Brooklyn's 2nd walk-off win in as many days in Sunday's 4-3 victory vs. Aberdeen...With 2nd and 3rd and 2 out, the 21-year-old reached on a run-scoring infield single, while a throwing error from 3B Anderson De Los Santos enabled the winning run to cross...On Saturday, C Ronald Hernandez helped Brooklyn complete another come-from-behind win, clobbering a walk-off solo home run with 1 out in the 9th in a 5-4 Cyclones win...The walk-off homer was Brooklyn's 1st since 3B Jefrey De Los Santos hit a game-tying 2-run blast and LF Omar De Los Santos smashed the game-ending solo shot on July 28, 2024, vs. Rome...Hernandez also delivered a walk-off winner with a run-producing fielder's choice in the bottom of the 10th on May 18 vs. Winston-Salem...2B Marco Vargas collected Brooklyn's 1st walk-off win of the year, slapping a game-ending RBI single in the bottom of the 10th on April 29 vs. Willmington.

MAGIC 8 BALL: Brooklyn erupted for a season-high 8 runs in the 3rd inning in Tuesday's 12-3 win at Wilmington...The Cyclones scored 8 runs on 8 hits and sent 12 batters to the plate...The 8-run frame was Brooklyn's biggest offensive outburst this year...The previous high had been 6 runs on 3 occasions, most recently on May 14 vs. Winston-Salem in the bottom of the 4th...The 8-run inning was the 'Clones largest frame since scoring 9 runs in the bottom of the 2nd inning in an 11-7 win vs. Wilmington on July 27, 2023... Brooklyn scored 9 runs on 6 hits in that inning, sending 12 to the dish. It was the Cyclones' biggest offensive inning on the road since tallying 10 runs in the top of the 6th in a 20-6 rout on May 27, 2022, at Bowling Green.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: Brooklyn's roster features no shortage of talent...According to MLB Pipeline, the Cyclones boast 12 of the Mets' Top 30 prospects...Those include OF Carson Benge (3), INF Jesús Báez (7), LHP Jonathan Santucci (12), INF Boston Baro (13), INF Marco Vargas (14), RHP Nate Dohm (18), INF Jacob Reimer (20), C Chris Suero (21), OF Eli Serrano III (22) and C Ronald Hernández (26), OF A.J. Ewing (27), and RHP WII Watson (29)...The Cyclones also possess 11 of the Mets' Top 30 farmhands per Baseball America...The list features Báez (6), Benge (7), Ewing (8), Reimer (10), Vargas (11), Baro (17), Santucci (18), Suero (19), Serrano III (20), RHP Raimon Gómez (21), and Dohm (24)... Brooklyn also hosts 11 of SNY's Top 30 from Joe DeMayo...Benge (5), Báez (6), Baro (13), Santucci (15), Vargas (17), Dohm (20), Reimer (21), Serrano (22), Suero (25), Hernández (26), and Gómez (28).

**LAST TIME OUT:** Did not receive a decision last Sunday at Wilmington...Yielded 2 runs (1 earned) on 2 hits in 4.0 innings...Plunked a batter and walked 3, striking out 2...Threw 68 pitches and 40 strikes (58.82%)...Relieved by RHP **R.J. Gordon** to start the bottom of the 5th inning with Brooklyn trailing 2-1...Cyclones rallied to take a 4-2 lead into the 9th inning...However, Wilmington tied the game with 2 out in the 9th on a C **Caleb Farmer** home run and won, 5-4, in the 10th on SS **Marcus Brown**'s walk-off RBI single.

2025: Broke camp with Brooklyn...Did not receive a decision in his High-A debut, striking out a career-high 5 on 4/6 vs. WIL (2.2 IP, 3 H, R, ER, BB, 5 K)...Suffered the loss in his 1st appearance of the year in relief on 4/12-1 vs. HV (3.0 IP, 3 H, 2 R, ER, 3 BB, 4 K)...Earned the 1st win of his professional career in relief on 4/23 @JS (3.0 IP, 4 H, R, ER, 2 BB, 2 K)...Tossed a career-high 4.0 innings and tied a career-best with 5 K's in a no-decision on 5/1 vs. WIL (4.0 IP, 4 H, 4 R, 2 ER, 5 K)...Earned the win and struck out a career-best 9 over a career-long 5.0 innings on 5/13 vWS (5.0 IP, H, R, ER, 2 BB, 9 K)...Struck out 8 over 4.2 innings in a no-decision on 5/27 vABD (4.2 IP, 2 H, BB, 8 K)...Appeared in a relief capacity following R.J. Gordon on 6/3 @WIL...Earned his 3rd win, tossing 4.1 innings of 2-run relief on 6/3 @WIL (4.1 IP, 3 H, 2 R, 2 ER, BB, 3 K).

**HE'S GIR-EAT**: Since the beginning of May, Girton has thrived for the Cyclones, registering a 2-0 record with a 2.76 ERA (9 ER in 29.1 IP) in 7 appearances (6 starts)...The 23-year-old has surrendered 20 hits, walked 13, and struck out 34...Among South Atlantic League pitchers with 29.0 or more innings of work since May 1, Girton is 4th in the league in hits-per-9-innings (6.1), 5th in batting average against (.194), 7th in ERA (2.76), and 10th in strikeouts-per-9-innings (10.43)...The second-year pro holds a 28.3% strikeout rate and a 10.8% walk rate in that span.

WHAT'S IN A ROLE: Girton has split time in 2025 between Brooklyn's rotation and bullpen...The 23-year-old started the year in a piggyback tandem with RHP Joel Díaz before moving to the rotation full-time after LHP Zach Thornton's transfer to Double-A Binghamton...In 8 starts, Girton has a 1-0 record and a 3.19 ERA (11 ER in 31.0 IP) with 24 hits allowed, 16 walks, and 40 strikeouts...In 3 appearances out of the bullpen, the right-hander is 2-1 with a 3.48 ERA (4 ER in 10.1 IP), 10 hits allowed, 6 walks, and 9 punchouts.

**HOME COOKING:** The Gage, Okla., native has thrived when gracing the bump at Maimonides Park...In 5 appearances (4 starts) on Coney Island, Girton holds a 1-1 record with a 2.33 ERA (5 ER in 19.1 IP), 13 hits, 7 walks, and 31 strikeouts...The 23-year-old is 2-0 with a 4.09 ERA (10 ER in 22.0 IP) with 21 hits, 15 walks, and 18 strikeouts in 6 outings (4 starts) in visiting parks.

2024: Signed with the Mets on 7/20 and assigned to Single-A St. Lucie on 8/28...Made his professional debut in relief, striking out the side in order on 8/29 vs. Jupiter (1.0 IP, 3 K)...Took a no-decision in his first and only pro start on 9/3 at Clearwater (1.0 IP, 2 H, 2 R, 2 ER, 2 BB, 1 K)...In 3 appearances (1 start), did not receive a decision and tallied a 12.00 ERA (4 ER in 3.0 IP) with 5 hits, 4 walks, and 5 strikeouts.

**BOOMER SOONER:** Girton spent the 2024 collegiate season at the University of Oklahoma...Girton grew up about 177 miles northwest of the university in Gage, Okla... Corralled a 0-1 record with a 7.32 ERA (29 ER in 35.2 IP), 1 save, 44 hits, 31 walks, and 47 strikeouts in 16 appearances (10 starts) for the Sooners...In first outing as a Sooner, went 4.0 innings and surrendered 1 run on 3 hits and 3 walks with 9 strikeouts in a win vs. No. 9 Tennessee on 2/17...Tossed 4.0 innings of 1-hit ball with 2 strikeouts in a win at TCU on 3/16...Started and struck out a pair in 2 postseason appearances vs. Kansas (5/24) and vs. UConn (6/2).

**RED RAIDER NATION:** The 23-year-old started his college career at Texas Tech University...During his 3 years with the Red Raiders, Girton compiled a 7-2 record with a 5.21 ERA (54 ER in 93.1 IP), 1 save, 77 hits, 57 walks, and 77 strikeouts in 42 outings (9 starts)...Named to the All-Big 12 Academic Second Team in 2023...Named Big 12 Pitcher of the Week on 2/20/23 after tossing 6.0 shutout innings out of the bullpen on Opening Day vs. Gonzaga...Had his 2022 season cut short due to injury.
