Today: The Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Athletics, open a six-game series at the West Michigan Whitecaps, High-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers. This is the first of 21 meetings between the Nuts and Caps this season as well as the 474th all-time meeting between the two teams. Lansing is coming off a 7-5 homestand, winning four of six against Fort Wayne and splitting a six-game series with Lake County.

Last Game, Sunday: Lugnuts 1, Captains 0 (10 innings). Sahid Valenzuela jabbed a one-out opposite-field RBI single through a drawn-in Lake County infield, walking off the Captains in a rainy Sunday finale at Jackson® Field™. Valenzuela's clutch knock was just the Lugnuts' second hit of the game, but **Yunior Tur** and four relievers blanked the Captains on seven hits for the Nuts' second shutout win of the series and second walk-off win of the season.

On Deck: The GLIAC Tournament takes over Jackson® Field™ from May 8-11 as the Lugnuts play the Whitecaps through Sunday, returning home May 13-18 to welcome in the South Bend Cubs.

Prospecting: The Nuts boast the Athletics' second, third, fourth and fifth selections in the 2024 draft: slugging third baseman **Tommy White** (40th overall), currently on the Injured List; southpaw starter **Gage Jump** (73rd), shortstop **Joshua Kuroda-Grauer** (75th) and outfielder **Rodney Green, Jr.** (104th). White is rated the A's No. 7 prospect, Kuroda-Grauer is No. 10, Jump is No. 13 and Green is No. 18. The Lugnuts also have 19-year-old **Steven Echavarria**, rated No. 12, and outfielder **Nate Nankil**, who is No. 28.

Congratulations! Minor League Baseball named **Gage Jump** its Midwest League Pitcher of the Week for the week of April 28-May 4, recognizing Jump's near-perfect effort on a rain-shortened Thursday in Lansing: a five-inning complete game shutout with seven strikeouts while allowing only one baserunner, a Jonah Advincula single in the fourth inning. Jump edged teammates **Kyle Robinson** (six hitless innings) and **Grant Judkins** (six scoreless innings, two hits allowed) for the honor.

Congratulations, Part II: Starter **Kyle Robinson** was honored on the field on Sunday as the Lugnuts Booster Club Player of the Month for April. Robinson earned the win in the Lugnuts' first victory of the season on April 6 at Fort Wayne, following up with one earned run allowed in five innings vs. Great Lakes on April 10; two runs allowed in 4 2/3 innings at Wisconsin on April 17; and back to back quality starts, with six innings of one-run ball vs. Fort Wayne on April 24 and six hitless innings vs. Lake County on April 30. Robinson's 1.52 ERA ranks 4th in the Midwest League entering today.

Walk-Off Wilson: **Jacob Wilson**, who starred for the Lugnuts in the final month of the 2023 season, delivered his second walk-off hit of 2025 for the Athletics yesterday, tying the game in the 10th inning with an RBI single before beating the Mariners with an RBI single in the 11th, 7-6. Sarah Langs reported that Wilson's three career walk-off hits in 62 MLB games trails only Gomer Hodge (3 walkoffs in 30 games in 1971) since the Division Era began in 1969.

The Midwest League's Best: The Lugnuts' offense tops the MWL in batting average (.269), base hits (237) and fewest strikeouts (181). In fact, the Nuts' strikeout rate is the best in all of Minor League Baseball, averaging only 6.7 K/game.

Roster Movement: Third baseman **Tommy White** (knee) was placed on the Injured List on Sunday, joining **Garrett Irvin** and **Darlyn Montero** on the IL, rehabbing their way back to Lansing in Arizona. In addition, outfielder **Ryan Lasko** began a rehabilitation assignment with the Arizona Complex League Athletics yesterday.

MAY 6TH IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2010: South Bend C Errol Hollinger's single leading off the 5th was the Silver Hawks' only hit in a 5-0 Lugnuts shutout victory at Cooley Law School Stadium, thanks to the combined efforts of Evan Crawford (5 IP), Matt Wright (2 IP) and Dustin Antolin (2 IP). Leadoff hitter Ryan Schimpf went 4-for-5 for the Nuts in the win..

2016: On his 21st birthday, Francisco Rios set a career high with 10 strikeouts in 5 2/3 innings, and the Lugnuts blanked the Quad Cities River Bandits, 6-0, in front of 9,816. Rios was promoted to A-Adv. Dunedin three days later.

2019: Due to flooding in Davenport, the Lugnuts opened a three-game series with Quad Cities at the University of Iowa's Duane Banks Field in Iowa City. The Lugnuts lost, 4-2, due to Austin Hansen's seven shutout innings and 10 strikeouts.

In a Nutshell: One of five 2024 draft picks on the Lugnuts' 2025 Opening Day roster, joining Tommy White (2nd round), Gage Jump (2nd round compensatory), Joshua Kuroda-Grauer (3rd round) and Rodney Green, Jr. (4th round)... made his Lugnuts debut in relief on April 6 at Fort Wayne, tossing two scoreless innings with three strikeouts to earn first professional win in Lansing's 5-3 victory... made first MWL start on April 10 vs. Great Lakes: allowed two-out, two-run Joe Vetrano double in 3rd (unearned due to a Sahid Valenzuela error), breaking 1-1 tie; tossed five innings in all; suffered the loss in Lugnuts' 3-2 defeat.

Quality x 2: Has posted a quality start in each of his last two outings, earning the win in both games... April 24 vs. Fort Wayne, allowing one run on five hits and one walk in six innings, one strikeout; 81 pitches, 53 strikes... April 30 vs. Lake County, pitched six hitless innings, walking three and striking out four; 90 pitches, 53 strikes.

Welcome to Pro Ball: Signed for \$150,000 after being selected with the first pick of Day 3 by the A's... made pro debut for Stockton on August 23, 2024 (2 IP, 3 H, 2 R, 1 BB, 2 K)... made three starts in total before Stockton's season ended, allowing exactly two earned runs in each outing... lefties hit .333 (6-for-18) with 1 BB / 6 K, while righties hit .273 (3-for-11) with 2 BB, 3 K... base-stealers went 2-for-2... pitched in the 2025 Crosstown Showdown, tossing two scoreless innings against Michigan State in relief of Yunior Tur.

Texas Tech: Robinson opened up his time in Lubbock as a reliever in 2022, appearing in 12 games (including nine appearances without allowing an earned run)... as a sophomore, was named to the 2023 Collegiate National Team; posted 5.36 ERA in 45 1/3 innings before finishing strong, posting five scoreless innings with eight strikeouts in the Big 12 Tournament against Oklahoma State to earn a nod on the All-Tournament Team, then limited No. 2 Florida to two ER in five innings in the NCAA Tournament... as a junior, led the Red Raiders with 76 IP in 15 starts, with a 5.09 ERA; struck out 11 in six innings at Oklahoma State on May 11, 2024... drafted following junior year... notable Texas Tech pros include Josh Tomlin, Danny Coulombe, Josh Jung, and the inimitable Dallas Braden.

High School: Played four years on varsity for George C. Marshall High School (Falls Church, Virginia)... named All-Conference First Team as sophomore, junior and senior... named Conference Pitcher of the Year and Conference Player of the Year as a senior: 66 2/3 IP, 1.49 ERA, 60 K... George C. Marshall is best known for the Marshall Plan, which saw the United States give \$13.3 billion to help rebuild Western European economies; it earned Marshall the 1953 Nobel Peace Prize... Marshall's nickname is the Statesmen... other notable Marshall alumni include the first woman to officially run the Boston Marathon, Kathrine Switzer; safety and current Dallas Cowboys special teams coordinator Nick Sorensen; defensive end Michael McCrary; table tennis legend Sean O'Neill; and pitcher Pete Schourek.
