- Marsh is making his 3rd start with Omaha, his 22nd overall start this season and his 23rd appearance in 2024 ... he opened the year as the 5th starter in Kansas City's rotation and made a rehab start with Omaha in May ...

LAST OUTING: SUNDAY, AUGUST 4 @ ROCHESTER

Made his first start back in Triple-A since being optioned and threw 3.0 scoreless innings with 4 strikeouts ... worked around a hit batter in the 1st inning, stranded a runner on after a single in the 2nd inning ... leadoff walk in the 3rd was erased on the double play, did not return to the mound for the 4th inning, limited to just 38 pitches.

2024 HIGHLIGHTS

- Won the fifth starting pitcher spot in Kansas City's rotation in Spring Training, pitched to a 3.57 ERA (7 ER in 17.2 IP) with 20 strikeouts in 6 Cactus League appearances (2 starts) ...

CAREER NOTES

- Opened the season in NW Arkansas (AA) for the third straight year, made 11 starts with the Naturals and was promoted to Omaha on June 3, making just 3 starts with Omaha before he was recalled to Kansas City on June 30 to finish the year.

- Broke camp with NW Arkansas (AA) and made six starts for the Naturals, before missing the rest of the year with an injury ... his 14.92 K/9 (42 K in 25.1 IP) ranked 2nd among Royals Minor League pitchers who threw at least 25 innings.

- Made 13 starts for Idaho Falls (Rookie Advanced) in his first pro season, going 0-1 with a 4.05 ERA (15 ER in 33.1 IP) with 38 strikeouts (10.3 K/9) to just 4 walks ...

- Attended Arizona State University, where he was named to the Golden Spikes Award Mid-Season Watch List and the Collegiate Baseball Hall of Fame Watch List of the National Pitcher of the Year as a junior in 2019, team won 21 straight to start the season.
