FROM THE CROWS NEST

WELCOME TO THE STRETCH RUN: With five games to go in the regular season, Bradenton is 27-32 in the second half, currently 4.5 games (5.5 including the tie-breaker) behind the Threshers for the FSL West's final playoff spot. The Marauders are eyeing their first postseason appearance since 2021 when they won their second FSL title. After dropping the season series with Clearwater, the Threshers have the tie-break advantage if the two teams finish with even records at the end of the season. With Clearwater playing Tampa in a doubleheader today, any combination of two Clearwater wins and/or one Marauders loss would eliminate Bradenton.

AGER DAY: Right hander Matt Ager will toe rubber for the Marauders as they look to bounce back against the Blue Jays. Over 21 outings and 18 starts, Ager has posted a 4.66 ERA. In his last start on Wednesday at Tampa, Ager tossed a career-high 5.1 innings and fanned a career-best eight hitters. In the process, he allowed just one run one three hits. Over the last two months, Ager has decreased his walk-rate from 15.5% over his first nine starts to 8.8% in his following eight apperances. Tonight marks his fourth start verus Dunedin this season (5 ER/9 IP). He mixes in a four seamer (90 mph), slider (82.4 mph, 37.3% Whiff), changeup (83.9 mph) and curveball (74 mph). He has been stellar against right-handed batters, limiting them to a .221 average and .331 slugging percentage.

MR. 100: After Diamondbacks infielder Jordan Lawler graduated from MLB Pipeline's Top 100 prospects list, Marauders outfielder Edward Florentino was named the No. 100 prospect in all of baseball (No. 98 via Baseball America). He was also named Florida State League Player of the Month for his dominant performance in July. He remains the only Marauders player to be honored this season by Minor League Baseball. Over the 23-game stretch, Florentino slashed .301/.433/.663 with 16 stolen bases and 17 walks. His eight home runs and 23 RBI were the most of any player throughout the Florida State League and Single-A. Florentino was also one of three Single-A players, and the only in the FSL, to tally 15 or more walks and ten or more extra-base hits. Florentino is the Pirates No. 5 ranked prospect according to MLB Pipeline and was promoted to Single-A Bradenton on June 21.

FLY FLY AWAY: The Marauders currently lead the Florida State League with 101 home runs, marking their fifth season in franchise history reaching the triple-digit threshold. With five games to go, they're 16 away from matching their all-time high of 117 in 2023. Moreover, they also have blasted the most in Single-A, as they've now passed San Jose (California League, 98). 156 of their 566 total runs have been generated via the long ball (27.5%). They're 36-32 when leaving the yard at least once, and 21-37 when not homering at all. They've seen six players launch 9+ home runs this season, more than any other team in the FSL (A. Plaz, Y. De Los Santos, K. Griffin, I. Saverine, F. Florentine, F. Padriguez, F J. Severino, E. Florentino, E. Rodriguez).

BURNING THE BASE PATHS: The Marauders have surpassed their franchise record with 223 stolen bases this season (2023). Yordany De Los Santos has played a massive role as he stole 51st base ont Friday night, adding to a career-best mark (34 between FCL/Single-A in 2024). He is now tied with Daytona's Kyle Henley for the most in the league - the two are the first FSL players to steal 50 since Seth Stephensen (LAK-62) and Emaarion Boyd (CLR-56) reached the threshold in 2023. In the process, De Los Santos also passed Jesus Castillo (39 - 2023), for the most single-season stolen bases by a Marauder in franchise history. Him and Henley are tied for seventh in Single-A. Moreover, De Los Santos sits only behind Konnor Griffin (64) for the most swipes in the Pittsburgh Pirates system. They are the ninth and tenth 40+ stolen-base seasons in Pirates-MiLB history. The two are approaching Rich Thompson for the most in pages by a Pittsberg ping the pages by a Pittsberg ping the All Newson and Trible All Adiagonalist. in a season by a Pirates minor leaguer since 2005 when he stole 58 that season between Double-A Altoona and Triple-A Indianapolis.

TONY TATERS: Pirates No. 30 prospect (MLB Pipeline) Tony Blanco Jr. demolished two homers during the Marauders previous homestand. On July 30, he sent a fastball 415 feet to left field, that cleared the confines of LECOM Park. The ball left his bat at 118.9 miles per hour, marking the hardest-hit ball in Single-A at the time, clearing the next closest batted ball by 4.4 mph. Three nights later, he also demolished a walk-off three-run homer that left the bat at 119.8 mph - the hardest-batted ball in MilB this season. Only three batted balls at the Major-League level have been hit harder this season. He joins Oneil Cruz (122.9 mph) and Vladamir Guerrero Jr. (120.4 mph) on the list. Only him and Cruz (122.9 mph) have left the yard with such batted ball quality.
