CARDINALS STUN RIDERS IN OPENER:

Evan Carter tripled in his first at-bat since June 1st, homered in his next at-bat and also singled in the Frisco RoughRiders' 6-2 loss to the Springfield Cardinals on Wednesday at Riders Field. In his first start since being reinstated off the Injured List, Carter went 3-for-4 and scored both of Frisco's (28-36) runs. He reached on an error and scored in the ninth, finishing a double shy of what would have been the first cycle in RoughRiders history. The Cardinals (33-32) got all their runs in the third inning, five of them charged to **Seth Nordlin** (0-2). Connor Lunn (3-4) allowed just one run in his 6.2 innings for the win. The RoughRiders bullpen kept Springfield in check, posting zeroes in every inning after the third. **Danny Duffy** went 1.2 innings and **John Matthews** faced one batter and retired him to leave the bases loaded. **Hever Bueno** and **Eudrys Manon** combined for three hitless innings to finish the game. Frisco pitchers stranded 15 runners on the bases on Wednesday night. **Thomas Saggese** extended his hitting streak to 10 games with his triple in the ninth inning that scored Carter. **Kellen Strahm** pushed his hit streak to 11 games with a base hit in the seventh. **Josh Hatcher** made his Double-A debut after his call-up from High-A Hickory. He singled to left field in his first at-bat and went 1-for-3 in the ball game while playing first base.

IT'S ABOUT STRAHM TIME:

Outfielder Kellen Strahm has been hot lately, hitting safely in 11-straight games while batting .356 (16-for-45)/.420/.444/.864 with one double, one home run, five RBIs, six runs, five walks and a steal. Over the last 11 games, he has raised his average from .200 to .233 and his OPS from .612 to .665.

RISP-ECT THIS:

This season, the Riders are just eighth in the 10-team Texas League in batting average with runners in scoring position, hitting .251, though Frisco is fourth with 250 RBIs with RISP. Over the last seven games (2-5 record), Frisco is hitting just .224 (15-for-67) in those situations.

THOMAS THE TANK ENGINE:

Thomas Saggese has been incredible for the RoughRiders on offense. Over a 10-game hitting streak, Saggese is hitting. 419 (18-for-43)/.469/.767/1.236 with a double, four home runs, 12 RBIs, four walks, nine runs scored and a steal. Among those who have played at least 50 games, Saggese is second on the team with a .298 batting average and .830 OPS.

THE SPEAS THAT PLEASES:

Reliever **Alex Speas** now has an ERA under 1.00 at 0.72 over 21 appearances. In 25.0 innings, he has struck out 42 to 12 walks. Opponents are hitting just .138 against him and he has not allowed an earned run over his last 12 outings. During that span, he has struck out 27 to five walks over 14.2 innings. On the season, righties are just hitting .125 (8-for-64) against him on the season with a .385 OPS.

POWER SURGE:

After only hitting two home runs over a two-week span, the RoughRiders have hit 16 long balls over their last 14 games. In the 14 games, Frisco is hitting .254/.353/.419/.772 with 26 doubles, 16 home runs and averaging 5.7 runs per game. **Thomas Saggese** led the way, batting .339 (20-for-59)/.397/.644/1.041 and has hit five home runs, the second most in the league over that span (Jorge Bonifacio with Northwest Arkansas, six).

AMBUSH EARLY AND OFTEN:

Thomas Saggese has been fantastic on first pitches this season, tied for first in the Texas League with a .600 average (12-for-20) when he puts the first pitch of an at-bat in play. He has a 1.619 OPS on the first pitch after homering on the first pitch on Saturday, which is second in the league. Luisangel Acuña has also been great, hitting .455 (20-for-44) on the initial offering while his 20 hits on the first pitch lead the league.

SPEED KILLS:

Luisangel Acuña leads the league in steals with 29 and is on pace for a career-best 62 swipes. The RoughRiders are second in Texas League steals with 96 bases in 112 attempts (85 percent).

ONE HOME RUN, PLEASE. AND MAKE IT GRAND:

The RoughRiders have had a knack for grand slams this year with **Thomas Saggese** hitting Frisco's seventh grand slam of the season on last Friday. They are one of two teams with seven grand slams in all of Minor League Baseball. Six different players have accounted for the grand slams (Hicks, **Luisangel Acuña**, **Jax Biggers**, **Dustin Harris**, **Trevor Hauver**, **Thomas Saggese** (2)).

ACUÑA MATATA:

RoughRiders infielder Luisangel Acuña has been on fire at the plate. The Rangers No. 3 prospect is hitting .302 (73-for-242)/.368/.450/.818 through the first 56 games. Over his last 51 games, he is batting .313/.382/.473/.855. When the 21-year-old arrived in Frisco in 2022, he had a wRC+ of 68 while it has nearly doubled this season (118).

WALK THIS WAY:

On the season, Frisco's 318 walks are tied for first among Texas League teams while their .352 team OBP is third in the Texas League. Dustin Harris is still first in the league with 44 walks despite being promoted to Triple-A Round Rock on Tuesday.

	ABOUT RYAN										

-Went to La Salle High School in Pasadena, California. There, his senior year, he owned a 1.16 ERA while striking out 48 in 42.1 innings, but played primarily infield.

-Went to UCLA camp as an infielder and asked one of the coaches if he could pitch the last inning of one of the games. He ended up throwing well enough that UCLA invited him out for a visit as a pitcher. He came back two weeks later and committed on the spot.

-At UCLA, he was named Pac-12 Pitcher of the Year and a consensus First Team All-American in 2019 as a junior. Over 16 games (13 starts), Garcia went 10-1 with a 1.44 ERA. In 94.0 innings, he whiffed 117 batters while walking just 26 and holding opponents to a .160 batting average. In his career with the Bruins, he went 20-2 with a 2.11 ERA. His 2.11 career ERA is seventh in UCLA history.

-His best start during his junior year came against Utah on April 26th, 2019. Over a 9.0-inning complete-game, shutout he struck out 14 batters while allowing just three base runners (two hits and one walk). The 14 strikeouts were the most by a UCLA starter since Trevor Bauer in 2011.

-Led the Wareham Gatemen of the Cape Cod League to a championship in 2018, going 2-0 with a $1.28\ \text{ERA}$ over 10 outings.

-Now lives in Surprise, Arizona, about two blocks away from the Rangers Spring Training Complex.

2023 SEASON

-In his Double-A debut on April 11th at San Antonio, Garcia allowed just two solo home runs while tying a career-best five innings.

-Allowed career-high eight runs over 2.2 innings against Wichita on 5/10 during a day game.

-Went a career-high seven innings at Corpus Christi, finishing with just 83 pitches.

2022 SEASON

-Was activated in late May while continuing his rehabilitation from injuries.

-His thought for the 2022 season was "I have built a house this season, coming back from injury, and next season, I will be able to fortify the house."

-Averaged 11.8 K/9 over his 14 games (13 starts).

2021 SEASON

-Missed the entire 2021 season with a right lat strain. That required two months of rest and then trying to build back up, but he strained his lat three different times and was unable to get back on the mound.

2019 SEASON

-Three starts into his professional career, he went on the Injured List with a right elbow strain and underwent "Tommy John" surgery on March 16th, 2020.

-During his TJ rehab, he built a computer from scratch and is very interested in technology.
