LAST TIME OUT...

MOOSIC, Pa. (July 10, 2021) – The Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders split a doubleheader with the Syracuse Mets on Saturday at PNC Field. The Mets took the first game in extra-innings 6-5, while the RailRiders claimed the second contest 1-0.

The Mets took a 1-0 lead in the top of the first inning of game one on a solo home run from MLB rehabber J.D. Davis. The RailRiders struck back with four runs in the bottom of the second, with a two-run double from Andrew Velazquez highlighting the inning. Syracuse responded with three runs in the top of the third off Asher Wojciechowski to tie the game at 4-4. The right-hander allowed four runs on four hits in 3.2 innings in his third start of the season.

Estevan Florial led off the bottom of the fifth with a solo home run against Vance Worley to give SWB at 5-4 advantage, but the Mets tied the game in the top of the sixth. The RailRiders loaded the bases in the bottom of the seventh but didn't score, and Syracuse plated a run in the eighth and held on for a wild 6-5 triumph. The defeat was the third straight for the RailRiders, marking the first three-game losing streak of the season for the club.

In the nightcap Matt Krook (1-1) was wild early, but settled in nicely to allow only one hit in 5.0 innings of work. The left-hander walked one and struck out one, but hit a pair of batters. The RailRiders broke through against Akeem Bostick in the bottom of the fifth when Max McDowell led off with a double and scored on a Brandon Wagner RBI single. Wagner was 2-for-2 in the game, breaking an 0-for-29 skid he was riding entering the contest. Trevor Lane closed the door on the game two win with 2.0 scoreless innings of relief. His first save of the season sealed the second 1-0 win of the year for the RailRiders. It also marked the first time this season that the Mets were shut out.

NEWS & NOTES

AHH, THE METS: PNC Field is quickly turning into a house of horrors for the Syracuse Mets. In the first series between the clubs in Moosic this season, the RailRiders completed a five-game sweep of the Mets, a series which included two walk-off wins and four come-from-behind victories. Overall, under the Mets affiliation, Syracuse is just 5-15 at PNC Field, and had lost 13 straight contests to the RailRiders in NEPA, before the 5-0 triumph in game two of the doubleheader on Wednesday. Overall, the RailRiders have won 16 of their last 20 games against Syracuse, dating back to the 2019 season.

WHERE HAVE ALL THE HOME RUNS GONE?: After hitting 64 home runs in the first two months of the season, the RailRiders offense has collectively seen a power outage in the month of July. The team has hit only two home runs in the month, both by **Estevan Florial**. Scranton/Wilkes-Barre has a team .318 SLG in the month, and sports a paltry .080 isolated slugging percentage (calculated by subtracting AVG from SLG). The RailRiders have eight doubles, one triple and one home run on the month, while they have allowed five round-trippers.

ALL GOOD STREAKS MUST COME TO AN END: RailRiders outfielder **Trey Amburgey** saw his historic 42-game on-base streak come to an end in game two of Saturday's doubleheader against Syracuse with an 0-for-3 effort. The streak is the longest in the RailRiders era (2013 - Present) in club history, surpassing **Brandon Drury**, who had a 32-game on-base streak in the 2018 season. Here is a look inside the numbers during Trey's incredible run:

- The streak began on August 26, 2019, when Amburgey went 1-for-3 with a HBP at the Pawtucket Red Sox.
- He hit .333/.418/.581 during the streak, with 30 R, 15 2B, 3B, 7 HR, 39 RBI, 20 BB, 41 K, and 5 HBP.
- The minor league record on-base streak is 74 consecutive games, set by current RailRiders INF **Andrew Velazquez** while playing with the South Bend Silver Hawks (ARZ, Single-A) from 4/22-7/16/2014.
- The streak has included 11 multi-hit games and 12 multi-RBI games.
- During the streak, Amburgey only went hitless six times, including in each of the final three games at Worcester (6/30-7/3) and four of the last seven games of the streak.
- That was the first time Amburgey has been held hitless in three straight games since 6/9 (G1) - 6/11/19, when he went 0-10 across 3 contests.
- Amburgey had a 20-game hitting streak from 9/1/19 to 6/13/21 as part of the longer on-base streak, snapped on 6/15 vs Syracuse.

HIGHWAY ROBBERY: After stealing just 39 bases in their first 45 games, the RailRiders have been on a roll since the start of the series at Worcester last Tuesday. In its last nine games, SWB is 22-for-28 (.786) in stolen base attempts, including a team-record tying seven on 6/29 at Worcester and another five on 7/6 vs Syracuse. Seven steals in a game tied a franchise mark set by the SWB Yankees on June 6, 2008 against the Norfolk Tides. **Andrew Velazquez** accomplished the rare feat of stealing three bases in one inning, while **Estevan Florial** (2), **Hoy Park** and **Ryan LaMarr** (1 each) all stole bags against the Red Sox. The barrage has SWB up to 58 steals on the year, fourth in Triple-A East, with Syracuse leading the way with 70. Velazquez leads Triple-A East with 17 steals on the season.

BULLS ON PARADE: Since **Kyle Barraclough** relieved **Albert Abreu** in the sixth inning of the RailRiders game at Buffalo on Friday, June 11, the SWB bullpen has performed at an amazing clip. In the last 28 days, the bullpen has combined for a 2.08 ERA (28 ER/121.1 IP), while allowing just 91 hits, 39 walks and recording 143 strikeouts. The current stretch has lowered SWB's bullpen ERA to 2.79 on the season, the third-best in MiLB (1st, Harrisburg, 2.39). The bullpen's 30 wins are tied for second-most in the minors behind only Tampa's 37.

HERE COME THE YANKEES: Nearing the halfway point of the season, the Yankees minor league system still stands alone across minor league baseball as the most successful. Not only are all four full season affiliates currently in first place in their respective divisions, but they have an average divisional lead of nearly four games. Each affiliate has won at least 36 games entering play on Sunday afternoon, and as a whole, the Yankees have an organizational record of 159-78 (.671). That is a full eight-games better than second-place Tampa Bay's 152-87 (.636) organizational record.

LAST TIME OUT: Gil returns to the mound for the second time in the series after picking up the win in Tuesday's lid-lifter with Syracuse. The right-hander allowed one run in 5.0 innings of work on only one hit, a solo home run from Wilfredo Tovar. He walked five but struck out seven and became the first pitcher on the SWB staff to win two games as a starting pitcher. In his last two starts, Gil has allowed three runs in 10.0 innings, all on solo home runs.

FROM BASEBALL AMERICA ON GIL: "...Upper-90s fastball. The Yankees worked with him at the alternate site to give the pitch riding life at the top of the zone while weeding out the version that bleeds into two-seam territory, helping it move toward its plus-plus potential. Gil's slider is a new addition to his arsenal, replacing his curveball, and ranges from 82-88 mph while showing average promise with more development. The Yankees like the movement and shape of Gil's low-90s changeup, but would like to see him execute the pitch more consistently." - from preseason scouting report written by Josh Norris.

SOMERSET PITCHING COACH DANIEL MOSKOS ON GIL: "Luis definitely is an exciting kid. The big-time fastball velocity is there, the slider is coming along and turning into plus-pitch form and the changeup will be something we continue to develop. The slider has become really good. He had eight strikeouts in his last outing on his slider. But it starts with the fastball for Luis, for sure, and then it's being able to command the ball. If he's able to do those two things and continue to grow and mature, there's tons of upside there.
