**YESTERDAY:** The Flying Squirrels won their sixth straight game with a 5-3 victory over the Harrisburg Senators at FNB Field. **Jacob Heyward**, playing his first game of the season, clubbed a solo homer in his first at-bat of the year in the first inning. The Senators tied the score in the second with an RBI double by Osvaldo Duarte. Heyward put Richmond back ahead for good in the third inning with an RBI double and **David Villar** followed with a two-run single. Harrisburg scored a run in the seventh, but Villar pushed the lead to 5-2 with a solo home run in the eighth inning. Harrisburg scored its final run in the ninth with a solo home run by Ian Sagdal. **Sam Long** started on the mound and allowed one run in 4.0 innings. **Ronnie Williams** picked up his first win of the year, working 3.2 innings and allowed one run. **Patrick Ruotolo** earned his second save on the season.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels continue the first road series of 2021, facing off against the Harrisburg Senators, Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals, at FNB Field on City Island. This series marks the Flying Squirrels' lone trip to Pennsylvania's capital city this season. The Senators come to Richmond for a six-game series from June 8-13. The Flying Squirrels enter the series riding a five-game winning streak.

**GOING STREAKING:** The Flying Squirrels have won six straight games, surpassing the team's longest winning streak from the 2019 season. The last time the team had a six-game winning streak from April 13-18, 2018, which came at The Diamond against Reading and Bowie. The Flying Squirrels franchise record for consecutive is seven. The team had seven-game win streaks from April 27-May 3, 2010 and June 20-26, 2014.

**STRONG START:** The Flying Squirrels' 6-1 record through the first seven games of the season is the best start in the franchise's history. The previous best start through seven games was a 4-3 record, which has happened five times, most recently in 2019. The Flying Squirrels' best start through eight games is 5-3, which was set during the 2018 and 2019 seasons.

**BEST OF THE BEST:** At 6-1, the Flying Squirrels are tied for the fourth-best record in all of the minors. Three teams, Lynchburg (Low-A East), Down East (Low-A Central) and Akron (Double-A Northeast) are still unbeaten. There are four other teams who currently hold a 6-1 record, including Scranton/Wilkes-Barre (Triple-A East), Birmingham (Double-A South), Aberdeen (High-A East) and Tampa (Low-A Southeast).

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** sit in second place in the Double-A Northeast Southwest Division, a half-game behind unbeaten Akron. The Flying Squirrels finished the 2019 season with a 55-84 record, the worst in the franchise's history, and finished in last place in the Eastern League's Western Division for the second consecutive year. Seven players from the 2019 team are back in Richmond to start the 2021 season, including **Jacob Heyward**, **Sean Hjelle**, **Ryan Howard**, **Peter Maris**, **Heliot Ramos**, **Frank Rubio** and **Raffi Vizcaino**. Reliever **Patrick Ruotolo** did not appear with the Flying Squirrels in 2019, but he did pitch in Richmond in 2018. Outfielder **Vince Fernandez** played in the Eastern League with Hartford in 2019.

**THE SENATORS** have lost four consecutive games entering play tonight by a combined score of 23-10. The Harrisburg roster includes 10 players who appeared in a game for the team prior to this season. There are six of *Baseball America's* top-30 Nationals prospects on the Senators' roster, including LHP Tim Cate (8), INF Drew Mendoza (11), INF Jackson Cluff (12), C Jakson Reetz (25), OF Nick Banks (29) and RHP Sterling Sharpe (29). In 2019, the Senators went 76-63, finishing in second place in the Eastern League Western Division, before falling to the Bowie Baysox in the divisional round of the playoffs.

**FOR RICHMOND:** Right-hander **Sean Hjelle** makes his second start of the 2021 season. In his season debut last Thursday, Hjelle allowed six runs (four earned) over 3.2 innings against Hartford in a no-decision. In 2019, Hjelle climbed three levels in the Giants' system. He began the year with Single-A Augusta for nine starts, made 14 starts with A-Adv. San Jose and joined the Flying Squirrels for five starts at the end of the year. Hjelle finished the year ranked fourth in the Giants organization in strikeouts (139) and fifth in ERA (3.32). He enters the 2021 season rated by *Baseball America* as the Giants' No. 13 prospect. Hjelle was drafted in the second round in 2018 out of the University of Kentucky. **For more on Hjelle, see page two.**

**FOR HARRISBURG:** Left-hander Carson Teel makes his second start of the 2021 season. In his season debut last Thursday against Somerset, Teel worked 5.0 innings and allowed two runs (one earned) with two walks and three strikeouts in a no-decision. He was drafted by the Nationals in the 16th round out of Oklahoma State in 2018. He pitched his first full professional season in 2019, splitting time between Single-A Hagerstown and A-Adv. Potomac, combining for 28 appearances (16 starts). Overall, he went 8-4 with a 3.03 ERA on the year.

**PLAY THE HITS:** The Flying Squirrels are batting .295 as a team, which is first in the Double-A Northeast. The team is also second in hits (66), second in total bases (103), third in RBIs (36), third in OBP (.351), second in SLG (.460) and second in OPS (.811).

**RIGHT OFF THE BAT:** 2019 Eastern League All-Star **Jacob Heyward** made his season debut on Tuesday night at Harrisburg. In his first plate appearance of the season in the first inning, he launched a solo home run. He added an RBI double that hit the left-field wall on the fly in his second plate appearance. In 2019, Heyward set the Flying Squirrels' single-season record for walks with 80, which surpassed the previous record of 62 set by Mark Minicozzi during the 2013 season.

**RAMOS RAKING:** **Heliot Ramos** homered in back-to-back games for the fifth time in his career with blasts last Wednesday and Thursday. He has now collected five home runs at the Double-A level and 35 during his career in the minors. Ramos is currently ranked tied for second in the Double-A Northeast in batting average (.429), tied for fourth in OBP (.520), fourth in SLG (.857), third in OPS (1.377), tied for second in hits (9), tied for third in extra-base hits (5), tied for third in total bases (18) and first in runs scored (8).

**POWER SURGE:** **David Villar** has homered three times in the first seven games of the 2021 season, which is tied for third in the league. He has homered in each of his last two games and three of the last six. He hit 13 home runs in 2018 in short-season with Salem-Keizer and clubbed 13 home runs again in 2019 with A-Adv. San Jose. Villar is also ranked tied for third in the league in RBIs (8), tied for third in extra-base hits (5) and tied for third in total bases (18).

**WELCOME BACK, AUGGIE:** **José Alguacil** returns to manage the Flying Squirrels after leading the team to a 72-68 record in 2015, the most recent season the team has posted a winning record. Alguacil is in his 15th overall season with the Giants organization and worked at the Alternate Training Site in 2020. He previously served as the first base coach and oversaw bunting instruction while assisting with infield defense and baserunning in San Francisco from 2017-2019 on Bruce Bochy's major league staff.

**ALL OVER THE MAP:** The Flying Squirrels roster contains 18 players from 11 different states across the United States: California (4), Georgia (4), Florida (2) and one player from North Carolina, Minnesota, Illinois, Massachusetts, New York, Missouri, Washington and Ohio. Nine players grew up in four countries and territories outside of the 50 states, including the Dominican Republic (4), Puerto Rico (2), Venezuela (2) and Colombia (1).

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Flying Squirrels have three players included in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects: **Heliot Ramos** (3), **Tristan Beck** (12) and **Sean Hjelle** (13). Ramos is also rated by *Baseball America* as the No. 83 overall prospect. Ramos (3), Hjelle (11) and Beck (20) are also ranked in MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospects.
