West Michigan Whitecaps (3-0, 27-40) at Dayton Dragons (1-1, 40-28) RH Zack Lee (2-2, 3.95) vs. RH Ty Floyd (0-1, 5.68)

Today's Game: The Dayton Dragons (affiliate of the Cincinnati Reds) host the West Michigan Whitecaps (affiliate of the Detroit Tigers) in the first game of a six-game series at Day Air Ballpark in the heart of the Water Street District. **Season Series:** Dayton 8, West Michigan 4 (all previous games at WM).

Dragons First Half Summary: Record: 39-27, East Division champs. By winning 8 of their last 9 games in the half including 2 elimination games on the final night, the Dragons overtook Great Lakes and Lake County to win the division by 1 game. The Dragons previously won First Half division titles in 2001 and '07. **For starting lineups, roster, media guide, and more, go to the Dragons Digital Pressbox at www.daytondragons.com/digitalpressbox**

Last Game: Sunday: Dayton at Peoria, postponed, rain. The game will not be rescheduled.

Last Series: at Peoria (June 16-20): Dayton 4, Peoria 1. The Dragons outscored Peoria 36-13. Dayton team stats in the series: .245 batting avg. (.196 with runners in scoring position); 14 HR, 6 SB, 2.70 ERA, 3 E.

Dragons Team and Player Trending Notes:

- The Dragons have won nine of their last 11 games, outscoring their opponents 97-35 in those 11 G. They are 27-14 since May 5.
- **The Dragons have notched their third First Half division championship in franchise history, joining the 2001 and '07 Dragons teams.** They also earned a First Half playoff berth in 2017 by finishing in second place (playoff formats prior to 2021 awarded playoff berths for second place).
- The Dragons First Half winning percentage of .591 tied for second best in franchise history (44-26, .629 in 2007; 39-27, .591 in 2022).
- As they won eight of their last nine games to close the first half and win the division title by one game, the Dragons outscored their opponents 90-26 in those nine games.
- The Dragons have hit 90 HR in 68 G, on pace to finish the year with 173 (club record: 152 in 2022).
- **The Dragons have hit 20 home runs over their last six games and 32 over their last 11 games.** Amazingly, the Dragons have hit grand slams in four of their last eight games.
- The Dragons have scored 411 runs, on pace to finish the year with 792 (club record is 730 in 2000).

--Carter Graham broke the Dragons club record for highest batting average in a First Half season at .330.

Graham has also broken the club record for most grand slam home runs in a season with three. For the year, Graham has three 2-homer games and five games with at least 5 RBI. He tied the club record on May 28 for most RBI in a game with 8 (a record that was also tied on June 18 (Game 2) by Jacob Friend. Graham has four 4-hit games in 2026.

--Since May 1, Carter Graham in 44 G leads the MWL in RBI (50—12 more than any other player), extra base hits (26), and hits (55). Since 5/1, he is batting .340 (4th in MWL), 14 HR (2nd in MWL), 1.144 OPS (2nd in MWL).

MWL Leading Dragons: Carlos Sanchez leads the MWL in hits...Carter Graham is tied for first in RBI...Graham and Alfredo Duno are tied for second in home runs. **Reds Organization Leading Dragons:** Graham leads the Reds org in RBI, OPS, and On-Base percentage...Jacob Friend leads the org in slugging percentage...Carlos Sanchez leads in runs scored.

--Jacob Friend is the Dragons Batter of the Week (week of June 16-21). In 5 games, Friend batted .333 with 2 home runs, 9 RBI, 3 stolen bases with an OPS of 1.2763. **Kyle McCoy** is the Dragons Pitcher of the Week. He fired six scoreless innings in his only appearance of the week.

Dragons Hottest Hitters:

Carter Graham in his last 20 G is batting .346 (27 for 78) with 10 HR and 32 RBI. He has 6 HR in his last 11 G.

Peyton Stovall in his last 16 G is batting .340 with 5 HR, 5 2B, 2 3B, and 16 RBI with an OPS of 1.205.

Kien Vu in his last 23 G is batting .333 with 6 HR, 5 2B, 4 3B, 16 BB, and 6 HBP and an OPS of 1.174.

Alfredo Duno in his last 37 games is batting .290, 13 HR, 9 2B, 32 RBI, 1.019 OPS.

Alfredo Alcantara over his last 10 G is batting .324, 5 HR, 3 2B, 12 RBI, 1.116 OPS.

Yerlin Confidan in his last 12 G is batting .286, 3 HR, after going 2 for his previous 45. Prior to that, he hit .350 (35 for 100) over the previous 26 G.

Jacob Friend in his last 7 G is batting .381, 3 HR, 2 2B, 12 RBI, 8 BB. Between Dayton and Daytona, Friend has 14 HR (5th in Reds org), 49 RBI (3rd in org.).

Victor Acosta is 1 for 15 (the hit was a HR) in his last 5 G after going 5 for 10 in the previous set at West Michigan.

Ariel Almonte since May 1 has seven hits with four of the seven going for home runs. He is 7 for 58 (.121) with 4 HR and 7 RBI since May 1.

John Michael Faile in June (13 G) is 8 for 46 (.174). Faile hit .322 in April and May for the Dragons.

Diego Omana joined the Dragons on 5/26 from Chattanooga. He 3 for 7 (.429) since his arrival.

Carlos Sanchez in his last 9 G is 5 for 36 (.139) with 14 SO. He leads the MWL in hits and ranks second in runs.

Reds Top Prospect is with the Dragons:

The Dragons roster is headlined by elite prospect **Alfredo Duno**, the highest-rated prospect in the Reds farm system. Duno is listed as the #1 on the Reds prospect list by both *MLB Pipeline* and *Baseball America*. Duno was selected as both the Most Valuable Player and Best Major League Prospect in the Single-A Florida State League in 2025 while playing for the Daytona Tortugas. Duno led the league in eight major categories including home runs (18), runs batted in (81), extra base hits (52), runs (78), doubles (32), on-base percentage (.430), slugging percentage (.518), and OPS (.948). He batted .287. Duno is the top-rated prospect ever to play for the Dragons at the catcher position, surpassing future Major Leaguers Devin Mesoraco and Tyler Stephenson.

Current Player Notes:

--Outfielder **Kien Vu** is in his first full season of pro ball after completing his college career at Arizona State, where he led the PAC 12 in batting as a sophomore in 2024 at .413. His OPS over his three years at ASU was 1.062 with a career batting average of .351 after making the team as a walk-on in 2023.

--**John Michael Faile** is the NCAA Division II all-time career leader in both home runs (81) and RBI (337). Faile has hit 17 home runs in his Dragons career and would equal the team's career record of 30 this season if he matches his home run with the Dragons in 2025 (13).

--**Carter Graham** led the PAC 12 in home runs in 2022 at Stanford and was selected 2nd Team All-American by *Baseball America*.

--**Peyton Stovall** was selected 3rd Team All-American by ABCA/Rawlings in 2024 at the University of Arkansas.

Dragons in Big Games:

These Dragons players have been key members of teams that played in the eight-team College World Series: **Carter Graham** (Stanford, 2021-23), **Peyton Stovall** (Arkansas, 2022), and **Ty Floyd** (LSU, 2023—national champions). These Dragons have played in an NCAA Super Regional: **Jonah Hurney** (Virginia Tech, 2022), **Jimmy Romano** (Duke, 2023), **Stephen Quigley** (U-Conn, 2024). These Dragons players have played in an NCAA Regional: **Graham Osman** (Arizona State, 2021), **Dylan Simmons** (Florida State, 2022), **Cody Adcock** (Ole Miss, 2021 & Arkansas, 2023), and **Kien Vu** (Arizona State, 2025).

All-Time Best Dragons: The team named their 12 Greatest Dragons in franchise history as part of last season's 25-year celebration. Those players, listed alphabetically, are Homer Bailey, Jay Bruce, Zack Cozart, Johnny Cueto, Elly De La Cruz, Adam Dunn, Todd Frazier, Hunter Greene, Billy Hamilton, Austin Kearns, Joey Votto, and Jesse Winker.

A total of 159 players have gone from the Dragons to the Major Leagues, and another 45 Reds players have completed injury rehab assignments with the Dragons, including Jose Rijo, Joey Votto (three times), Homer Bailey, Drew Stubbs, Johnny Cueto, Aroldis Chapman, and Brandon Phillips.

Three members of the Reds Hall-of-Fame have served as coaches for the Dragons including Ken Griffey Sr., Chris Sabo, and Tom Browning.

Every season in Dragons history has featured a future Major League player/s on the Dayton roster. Most recently: Chase Burns in 2025; Sal Stewart and Rhett Lowder in 2024; Blake Dunn, Julian Aguiar, and Edwin Arroyo in 2023; Elly De La Cruz, Rece Hinds, Noelvi Marte, Andrew Abbott, Connor Phillips, and others in 2022.

Three Great Achievements in Dragons History:

--Austin Kearns hit home runs in eight consecutive games, July 17-24, 2000.

--Billy Hamilton stole 103 bases for the Dragons in 2011, most for any player with a single team in Reds history (Majors or Minors). Hamilton stole 155 the next season, splitting his season between two clubs, the highest total in baseball history.

--Jose Siri broke the Midwest League record for longest consecutive game hitting streak with 39 from June 22-August 3, 2017.

Recordkeeping & Highlights

--Carlos Sanchez tied the Dragons club record by stealing bases in six consecutive games, April 17-22 (record shared by Billy Hamilton and Michael Siani; records available since 2005).

--The Dragons hit home runs in 15 consecutive games, May 3-20. The streak was the Dragons longest since MLB assumed record-keeping duties for Minor League Baseball in 2005. The streak was also the longest in the Minor Leagues to date in 2026, and the longest in the MWL since 2022.

--The Dragons broke their club record for most runs in a game on May 20, topping Fort Wayne 22-8. The record of 21 had held up for 25 years after being set in 2001. The Dragons also tied their club record for most home runs in a game on May 20, matching the mark set in 2001 and 2007. In the game on May 20, the Dragons scored five runs in the first inning, keyed by a grand slam home run by Carter Graham, and jumped out to a 13-0 lead over the first two innings. Carlos Sanchez scored five runs, tying the record set by Austin Kearns (2000) and Wily Mo Pena (2001)...The Dragons had 11 extra base hits, most in a game since MLB assumed record-keeping duties in 2005 (no record of this stat prior to that year). Graham became the first Dayton player with four extra base hits in a game since Kevyn Feiner in 2009, Graham had 6 RBI (all in the first two innings)...Graham had his second 4-hit game of the year and the first Dragons grand slam since Anthony Stephan in April of 2025...Sanchez and Alfredo Duno each had two home runs...Sanchez reached base in all six plate appearances, going 4 for 4 with two walks.

--Carter Graham collected eight RBI in one game vs. Great Lakes on May 28, tying the club record set in 2019 by Brian Rey. Graham broke the club record for most RBI in a home game, topping Juan Francisco's seven RBI in 2007.

--In one of the most amazing endings to a game in Dragons history, Kien Vu completed a "true" steal of home to break a 4-4 tie with two outs and two strikes in the bottom of the ninth inning to give the Dragons a walk-off win.

--On June 14 vs. Fort Wayne, the Dragons tied a club record for most home runs in a game with six (second time in 2026—fourth time in team history). The Dragons finished the 6-game series with Fort Wayne with 18 home runs, 61 runs, and 32 extra base hits, all team records for a series (MWL went to 6-game sets in 2021).

--Alfredo Duno hit two grand slams in a three-game period June 12-14.

--On June 16 at Peoria, Carter Graham connected on his third grand slam home run of the season to establish a team record for most grand slams in a season and career with the Dragons. Since records on the topic became available in 2005, only five other Dragons players have hit two grand slams in one season (Jeremiah Piepkorn in 2005; Denis Phipps in 2007; Beau Amaral in 2013; Jack Rogers in 2023; Alfredo Duno in 2026). Tyler Stephenson hit two career grand slams with the Dragons over two different years (one in 2016, one in 2017).

--On June 18 at Peoria, the Dragons swept a doubleheader to clinch their third First Half East Division title in team history, and their first since 2007. In the second game, the Dragons beat the Chiefs 18-1 as Jacob Friend tied a club record with eight RBI while hitting two home runs including a grand slam. The Dragons hit six home runs in a game to tie their club record (for the third time in 2026).
