**ABOUT SUNDAY:** No. 30 Mets prospect LHP **Keyshawn Askew** set the tone for the series with six shutout innings in Brooklyn 7-0 victory over Jersey Shore on Tuesday night to move to 17-5 over the BlueClaws in 2022. RHP **Jeffrey Colon** piggy-backed and tossed the final three scoreless for the save. INF **Shervyen Newton** hit an early two-run home run, while INF **Jose Peroza** stayed scorching hot with three more hits. 1B **JT Schwartz** went 2-for-4 with a double and two runs scored. Jersey Shore put together a bullpen game, sending out five different pitchers over the nine innings.

**DIVISION ON THE LINE:** Including today, the Cyclones have 17 games remaining and three series: five at Jersey Shore, six vs. Wilmington, and six at Winston-Salem. Brooklyn is vying for a playoff spot with a second half division title in the North Division of the South Atlantic League, sitting tied for second place with Aberdeen 0.5 games behind Hudson Valley who plays Hickory this week at Dutchess Stadium.

**OLD BAY SEASONING:** The last time the Cyclones played Jersey Shore, OF **Alex Ramirez** hit two home runs in a three-game weekend series after the MLB All-Star Break, going a whopping 8-for-13 (.615). Ramirez currently leads all Mets minor leaguers with 118 hits.

**2021 CYCLONES TAKEOVER QUEENS:** With Monday's promotion of RHP **Connor Grey** to the Mets roster, the Cyclones saw three 2021 members of the roster earn the callup. 3B **Brett Baty** has played with the big club since last Wednesday and RHP **Jose Butto** made his MLB debut Sunday in Philadelphia.

**HOW RUDE!:** In August, OF **Matt Rudick** has a whopping .420 on-base percentage and a .795 OPS over 17 contests. Rudick has been on base in 12 consecutive games and is hitting .281 (18-64).

**vs. JERSEY SHORE:** The Philadelphia Phillies High-A affiliate sits in last place in the North Division of the South Atlantic League at ShoreTown Ballpark in Lakewood, New Jersey. Against the BlueClaws, the Cyclones are 17-5. Jersey Shore hosts four of Philadelphia's Top 30 prospects, according to MLB Pipeline, including No. 8 OF Ethan Wilson, No. 14 INF Luis Garcia, No. 21 RHP Christian McGowan, and No. 27 INF Casey Martin.

**PEROZA PRODUCING:** Since July 9, INF **Jose Peroza** has a OPS of .912 over his past 35 games with a 22-game on-base streak. The current active streak leader is Hickory OF **Jayce Easley** who has a 24-game on-base streak. The 22-year-old Venezuelan has been on base in 33 of the past 35 games, hitting .325 with a .420 OBP. On July 8, Peroza's slash line was .214/.299/.316 and is now .256/.310/.383.

**MASTERS OF THEIR DOMAIN:** The Cyclones have allowed the fewest runs in the league in the second half sixth-fewest in Minor League Baseball overall, having allowed 459 runs in 115 games (4.0 runs/game).

**THAT'S OFFENSIVE!:** The Cyclones have scored just 451 runs in 115 games (3.9 runs/game) which ranks second-to-last in the South Atlantic League to Jersey Shore and fourth-worst in MiLB in fewest runs.

**BRETT THE BAT:** Former Brooklyn Cyclones 3B **Brett Baty** made his MLB debut Wednesday with the Mets in Atlanta, hitting a two-run home run in his first at-bat en route to a 9-7 Mets victory.

**TONIGHT:** Santos faces Jersey Shore for the 4th time. He has a 3.95 ERA over three starts with 18 strikeouts in 13 2/3 innings and just two walks. Blue Claws INF Casey Martin is 5-7 with a double and INF DJ Stewart is 4-5 with a home run against Santos.

**HIT ME!:** Santos has allowed 25 hits over his past three starts, allowing the league to hit .385 against him in August.

**INNINGS EATER:** Santos ranks tied for second in the Mets organization with 98.1 innings pitched. Last year, Junior tossed 96 innings as a career high.

**HIGH-RANKING MEMBER:** Santos ranks as the top pitching prospect on the staff, ranking No. 16 according to *MLB Pipeline* and No. 17 according to *Baseball America*.

**BREAKOUT:** The 21 year old pitched with Low-A St. Lucie in 2021, tossing 96 innings which doubles the workload he turned in in 2019 (40.2 IP) and 2018 (45). This season marks the second full season assignment for the righty.

**VALUED MEMBER:** Santos signed with the Mets in 2018 for \$275,000 out of Santiago in the Dominican Republic.

**OPENING DAY STARTER:** Junior Santos made Brooklyn's Opening Day start in Wilmington, Delaware on Saturday evening. It was Santos' fourth Opening Day and first Opening Day start since 2018 when he pitched for the DSL Mets against the DSL Angels. In that outing, he struck out six over three innings of one-run ball.
