#### FRES-NOTES

SUNDAY SETBACK IN STOCKTON: The Fresno Grizziles (11-19, 49-46) fell to the Stockton Ports (11-19, 37-57) 4-2 Sunday evening from Banner Island Ballpark. The Grizziles split the six-game set with the Ports and have not won a road series since June 4-9 at Modesto (four road series since). The Grizziles dropped to 78-30 all-time against the Ports (17-7 record this season) with a 45-11 all-time record (13-5 this year) at Banner Island Ballpark. The Ports plated all four runs over an early three-inning span. Stockton scored a pair of runs in the bottom of the second from a Myles Naylor two-RBI double to right-center. In the bottom of the third, T.J. Schofield-Sam barreled a solo shot to right-center, his fourth homer of the season. A frame later, Naylor reached on an error by Braylen Wimmer, adding Joseph Rodriguez. The Grizziles notched a run in the fifth and sixth innings, but could not make the comeback. Andy Perez lifted a sacrifice fly to center, pushing across Ben McCabe. Then, McCabe lasered a double down the left-field line in the top of the sixth McCabe bumped in Nick Gile, who doubled prior to the RBI knock After the dust settled, the clubs pooled together for 14 hits (nine extro-bases) with seven for each team. Fresno crushed a season-high five doubles among their seven hits. Luis Mendez and Gile relished multi-hit games with the latter scoring a run. McCabe encohed base three times from a walk, hit-by-pitch and RBI double. He provided a run, stole a base and caught 14 strikeouts from the staff. Jason Hinchman lengthened his hit streak to six games. Hinchman had one hit in every game with four landing for extro-bases (two doubles, one triple, one wallop). Fresno lefty Isolah Coupet (5-5) suffered the setback after five innings of work. Coupet allowed four runs (three earned), on five hits and one walk while striking out 10 (one shy of career-high). Hunter Mann hurled a 1-2-3 sixth, giving him three score-less frames in the series. In those three innings, he whiffed six Stockton batters. Bryson Hammer chu

GRIZZLIES VS. STORM: The Fresno Grizzlies and Lake Elsinore Storm (San Diego Padres Single-A affiliate) start a six-game series tonight at Chuk-chansi Park. This is the second of two series between the clubs in 2024 and the only regular season series in Fresno. In 2022, the Storm won the California League crown after sweeping the Grizzlies 2-0 in the Championship Series, celebrating on Fresno's field. Lake Elsinore joined the California League in 1994 and are one of four teams in the Southern Division. The Storm are affiliated with the San Diego Padres organization and have been since the start of the 2001 season. Prior to that, the team had ties with the California Angels from 1981-2000. Lake Elsinore has gone through a couple name and location changes in their club history. In 1979, they were known as the Santa Clara Padres. From 1980-85, they were named the Redwood Ploneers and from 1986-1993, they were the Palm Springs Angels. Since 2004, Lake Elsinore have been known as the Storm and have called their home at Lake Elsinore Diamond or just, The Diamond. It takes five hours and 23 minutes on average to drive from Chukchansi Park to The Diamond via car.

NOJO IN FRESNO FOR MLB REHAB: The Colorado Rockies have sent outfielder Nolan Jones to the Grizzlies for a rehab assignment (lower back strain, 10-Day IL). This is the second time this season that Fresno will be graced with a rehabber from Colorado. RHP Germán Márquez started for Fresno on June 16 versus Rancho Cucamonga. Jones enters his ninth professional season and his second with the Rockies. He was dealt to Colorado from the Cleveland Guardians on November 15, 2022 for former Grizzlies INF Juan Britz. In 2023, Jones finished fourth in National League Rookie of the Year voting after becoming the first rookie in Major League history to have at least 20 home runs, 20 stolen bases and 19 outfield assists in a season. Jones led the Majors with 19 outfield assists in 93 games in 2023, a franchise record surpassing Dante Bichette's 17 assists in 144 games in 1999. Welcome to Growlifornia Nolan Jones!

MENA MAKES HIS GRIZZLIES DEBUT: Tonight, the Grizzlies hand the ball to RHP Bryan Mena, who will make his Grizzlies debut. Mena made 13 appearances (six starts) with the ACL Rockies this season. He went 2-4 with one hold and two saves, logging a 4.89 ERA. In 46 innings, Mena struck out 58. The 20-year-old signed with the Rockies in 2021 as an International Free Agent out of the Dominican Republic.

NO WALKS WHEN YOU FACE JACE: Grizzlies RHP Jace Kaminska has issued one walk over his last seven outings (June 9-July 24), spanning 39 innings. Kaminska has allowed 42 hits and fanned 48 batters in that stretch. He has also not permitted a walk in four straight games (June 30-July 24) spanning 23 innings. Kaminska has scattered 20 hits and struck out 27 batters in that stretch.

ANDY IS DANDY: Grizzlies' INF Andy Perez ranks among the Top 10 in eight different California League categories. Perez ranks first in hits (106), first in total bases (163), tied for first in triples (6), second in extra-base hits (35), third in RBI (59), fourth in doubles (21), tied for sixth in batting average (.287) and 10th in slugging percentage (.442).

ANDY PEREZ JOINS THE GRIZZLIES CAREER RECORD BOOKS: Grizzlies' INF Andy Perez joined the Grizzlies record books after logging his 13th career triple with two outs in the top of the first June 29 at San Jose. He is now tied with Juan Melo and Roger Kleschnick for ninth all-time with those 13 triples. Up next for Perez are Clay Timpner and Jason Ellison, who have tallied 14 triples apiece.

MORE RECORDS FOR ANDY PEREZ: Andy Perez's triple on June 29 at San Jose was his sixth triple of 2024, putting him one triple shy of joining the Grizzilies Top 10 Single-Season Records AGAIN. Perez (2023), Preston Tucker (2017), Nate Schierholtz (2007), Jason Ellison (2004) and Calvin Murray (1999) each recorded seven triples in their respective seasons. The Cuban native would become the second Grizzlies player (Nate Schierholtz, 2007-08) to Join the Grizzlies Top 10 Single-Season Triples list twice.

NEW MAN AT THE TOP OF THE LINEUP: Grizzlies' OF Caleb Hobson has relished his role as the team's leadoff hitter. When Hobson has been plugged into the leadoff spot, he has reached base 67 times in 174 plate appearances (37 games; 39% he is reaching base in the leadoff spot). In 11 of those 37 games, Hobson has made it on base three or more times, combining to score 32 runs. Part of Hobson's success is in his first plate appearance of the game, where he is 9-for-29 (310) with a double, seven walks and one hit-by-pitch (17-for-37, 46% of the time he reaches base in first plate appearance). Eight of his nine hits have been singles with three of them landing as bunt singles. Hobson has also swiped 18 total bags as a leadoff hitter, picking up two stolen bases in five of those leadoff games (28/32 in stolen bases on the season).

**RUNNING CLOSER TO THE RECORD BOOKS**: Grizzlies' OF Caleb Hobson has swiped 28 bases this season. Hobson is currently seven stolen bases shy of joining the Grizzlies Top 10 Single-Season Records in that category. Tyler Graham (2010), Darren Ford (2014), Jonathan Villar (2015) and Myles Straw (2018) are tied for ninth all-time with 35 stolen bases.
