Tonight's Game: The Sounds and Jumbo Shrimp wrap up their season series tonight at First Horizon Park. Nashville holds a 10-7 record over Jacksonville this year and has won three of the first five in the current series. Right-hander Chad Patrick is on the mound for the Sounds and will face off against Luarbert Arias for Jacksonville.

Chad Patrick: The 26-year-old makes his 22nd appearance (20th start) for the Sounds this season. In his last outing, he allowed five earned runs in 3.0 innings. He has only given up more than three earned runs in an outing three times this season and it hasn't happened since April 26. In two outings versus the Jumbo Shrimp, Patrick has relinquished seven earned runs in 6.0 innings. Despite the rough outing on Tuesday, the hot dog connoisseur leads Triple-A in ERA (3.18), wins (11), and is second in WHIP (1.16). The Sounds are 16-3 in games started by Patrick and he has seven quality starts and five outings in which he was one out away from a quality start. He was drafted in the fourth round by the Diamondbacks in the 2021 First-Year Player Draft from Purdue University Northwest in Hammond, Indiana. After he was traded at the deadline in 2023 to the Athletics, he was traded once again in November 2023 to the Brewers in exchange for Abraham Toro.

Luarbert Arias: The 23-year-old makes his 37th appearance (1st start) for the Jumbo Shrimp this season. His last start came in the second game of a doubleheader on August 24, 2022, while pitching for Jupiter. In his career, he has made 149 appearances but just 19 starts and just two starts since the 2019 season. Arias' season high in innings is 3.0 and pitches are 49 with a bullpen game expected for Jacksonville. His best month came in July when he did not allow an earned run in 9.0 innings and picked up three wins. The Venezuelan leads the Jumbo Shrimp in appearances (36), and strikeouts as a reliever (60). As a whole, Jacksonville's bullpen ranks seventh in the International League in ERA (4.23) and ranks in the middle of the pack in most categories.

Bully Pen: Nashville's bullpen saw Jacob Misiorowski and Craig Yoho dominate once again with 2.1 innings combined with only one base runner. Since both players made their debut with the Sounds in early August, they have given up just two earned runs in 15.1 innings. Yoho has not allowed an earned run since June 14 and has 92 strikeouts in 48.2 innings between Wisconsin, Biloxi, and Nashville this season. Misiorowski has only given up one hit with Nashville which works out to an .032 opponents batting average. The duo has enhanced an already elite bullpen that ranks first in Triple-A in ERA (3.56) and WHIP (1.34).

Offensive Woes: The bats were quiet again last night with just one run coming on a bases-loaded walk from Isaac Collins. In the series against Jacksonville, the Sounds have scored 20 runs in five games. Nashville remains in last place in batting average in August in Triple-A at .217 and is third from last in runs scored (74). In their last 16 games, the Sounds have scored three or fewer runs 11 times. A reason for the lack of runs can be attributed to the struggles of the meat of the lineup. In August, Tyler Black is hitting .216 (8-for-37) and Brewer Hicklen hitting .164 (11-for-67).

Speedy Hicklen: In the fourth inning last night, Brewer Hicklen swiped his 40th bag of the season on only his 45th attempt. He became the first player in the International League to reach that mark and the fourth in Triple-A. Each of the three players ahead of Hicklen in the rankings has been caught at least seven times. Nashville ranks fourth in the International League with 153 stolen bases while Jacksonville is last with only 63. Hicklen has reached 40 steals once prior back in 2021 with Northwest Arkansas. In 678 games in the minor leagues in his career, Hicklen has 226 stolen bases with an 85.6% success rate.

The Future, We See: The Sounds currently have five of the top 30 Brewers prospects, per MLB Pipeline. They are RHP Jacob Misiorowski (No. 3), INF Tyler Black (No. 4), RHP Logan Henderson (No. 10), RHP Craig Yoho (No. 20), and RHP Carlos Rodriguez (No. 21).

The Sweet Life: Manager Rick Sweet is in his fourth consecutive season as the Sounds manager (5th overall) and his 34th season as a manager in MiLB. Sweet is the winningest manager in Nashville Sounds history, earning his 321st victory in the 2023 season finale vs. Jacksonville. This is his 11th season as manager of the Brewers' Triple-A affiliate and boasts a 748-641 record (Nashville in 2014, Colorado Springs from 2015-18, San Antonio in 2019 and Nashville 2021-). Overall, Sweet has a career managerial record of 2,340-2,161 - that's the fifth most wins in MiLB history and second among active managers (only Buddy Bailey with Single-A Myrtle Beach has more).

Sounds Manager Rick Sweet ranks fifth among Minor League managers in wins. He has the second-most among active managers, trailing Single-A Myrtle Beach manager Buddy Bailey.

AGAINST OPPONENT: This is Patrick's fourth start against the Jumbo Shrimp. He got the win on May 16 (6.0 IP, 6 H, 1 ER, 2 BB, 4 K) and worked three innings in relief on June 27 (3.0 IP, 5 H, 2 ER) in addition to his outing in the series opener.

- Tossed three scoreless innings in Sounds debut on April 7 vs. St. Paul
- Held Omaha to a couple of hits and a run over six innings for first quality start of season on April 19
