### LAST GAME

Despite a furious late comeback, the Bowie Baysox came up just short to the Altoona Curve by a 13-11 final Thursday night. The Curve jumped out to a 10-0 lead in the contest - highlighted by four runs in the third and five runs in the fourth. Mason Martin launched a grand slam for Altoona, along with three RBI from Liover Pagueiro. Lolo Sanchez, Henry Davis, and Connor Scott would each plate a run for the Curve as well. Starter Peter Van Loon only managed 2.2 innings for the Baysox before being lifted. Bowie notched two runs back in the fifth on a Cesar Prieto single and Coby Mayo sacrifice fly. Claudio Finol then hit a two-run home run as part of a three-run sixth inning, stretching the Altoona lead to 13-2. Bowie's storm back was kickstarted by a TT Bowens solo home run in the seventh, before a seven-run eighth inning. John Rhodes and Donta' Williams each lined an RBI single, before Bowens drove in another run on an RBI double. The bases would eventually fill for Cesar Prieto to launch a grand slam and cut the deficit to 13-10. The Baysox would inch closer with another RBI double from Bowens in the ninth to make it 13-11, but ultimately were unable to plate the tying run after it reached base in the defeat.

### TODAY'S OPPONENT

The Altoona Curve enter tonight with a record of 17-17. Altoona currently sits fourth in the Southwest division standings - just one game out of first place. The Curve are coming off a series in which they lost four of six games to the Akron RubberDucks at home. Altoona took four of five games played against the Baysox last month at Peoples Natural Gas Field. The Curve are led by C Henry Davis, as the No. 3 Pirates prospect and No. 48 overall prospect (per MLB Pipeline) ranks top five in the Eastern League in OPS (1.104 - 1st), on-base percentage (.457 - 1st), slugging (.647 - 1st), batting average (.314 - 2nd), home runs (9 - 3rd), and extra-base hits (15 - 5th). Davis' on-base percentage and OPS leads all of Double-A, while his slugging is second. Davis is one of six prospects in the MLB Pipeline Top 30 for the Pirates, alongside INF Liover Pagueiro (No. 6 PIT), RHP Jared Jones (No. 11 PIT), OF Matt Gorski (No. 16 PIT), RHP Kyle Nicolas (No. 19 PIT), and OF Matt Frazier (No. 22 PIT).

### TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Altoona looks to start right-hander Kyle Nicolas on the mound tonight. The No. 20 prospect in the Pirates' system, Nicolas is coming off one of his more efficient outings of the season. The right-hander threw five one-run innings against Akron on Saturday, yielding six hits and striking out five. Nicolas has struggled with contact this season, his 39 hits surrendered are second most in the Eastern League and sixth-most across Double-A, and his .302 opposing average is fourth-highest at the level. Nicolas faced the Baysox back on April 18, pitching his best start of the season - six one-run innings on just three hits with two walks and three strikeouts on 88 pitches. In five appearances (four starts) against Bowie, Nicolas is 1-1 with a 2.84 ERA, including 4 ER surrendered in 8.2 innings at Prince George's Stadium. Initially a Competitive Balance Round B pick by the Miami Marlins in 2020, Nicolas was sent to the Pirates organization in November of 2021 as a part of the Jacob Stallings trade. He pitched collegiately at Ball State, where he was three-year teammates with tonight's projected Baysox starter, Chayce McDermott. Nicolas features a mid-high 90s fast-ball with 20 inches of induced vertical break, along with a mid-80s slider and low-80s curveball. He also has a changeup he utilizes on occasion.

### HAIL CESAR

INF Cesar Prieto continues to pace the Eastern League with 51 hits and a .383 average - 69 points above the next highest qualified average. Prieto has hit a scorching .421 in the month of May with a .459 on-base percentage. He has collected hits in 13 of his 14 games this month, and has 16 multi-hit games in his first 33 contests of 2023. The No. 17 O's prospect also ranks third in the league in on-base percentage (.427), along with fourth in OPS (.983).

### HOBBLING AT HOME

The Baysox enter this week sporting the worst home record in the Eastern League at 6-14. Bowie has been outscored 122-86 at Prince George's Stadium this season. The struggles stem, in part, from the pitching staff, who sports a 5.14 ERA at home, compared to a 3.30 ERA away from home. Bowie arms have also surrendered the second-most long balls in home contests this season. 31 of the staff's 41 home runs have been conceded at home.

### TANDEM TROUBLES

Bowie's abundance of starting pitching experience is leading to a statistical split based on when each pitcher enters the game. Bowie has had eight different pitchers start multiple games this season, and those pitchers sport a 3.40 ERA with 160 strikeouts in 145.2 innings when they start their respective games. When those same pitchers enter games as relievers, they sport a collective 7.02 ERA, with only 56 strikeouts in 59 innings.

### HESTON IS BESTON

OF/1B Heston Kjerstad has shown out as one of the top bats in the Eastern League so far this season. Kjerstad currently sits third in the Eastern League with nine home runs. Beyond the long ball, the Orioles' No. 5 prospect has also demonstrated plenty offensive consistency - sitting third in the Eastern League in slugging percentage (.615) and second in OPS (.996) among qualifiers, while also ranking second in extra-base hits (18) and total bases (75), and sitting tied for the league lead with three triples. Kjerstad is in the midst of a 21-game on-base streak - the longest streak in the Eastern League this season. He has reached base safely in 30 of his first 31 Double-A contests.

## QUICK HITS

- Ranked as the 19th overall prospect in the Orioles' system, per MLB Pipeline, entering the 2023 season.
- Acquired by the Orioles this past July as a part of the Trey Mancini trade. Final start as an Astros farmhand was against Aberdeen, the team he would join four days later.
- Older brother Sean played in the NBA for the Memphis Grizzlies during the 2020-21 season

## CAREER NOTES

- Pitched to a 6.08 ERA in Bowie across 6 starts and 26.2 innings last season. Held opponents to a .179 average but struggled with 20 walks and 7 home runs given up in a Baysox uniform.
- Made his Double-A debut for Bowie on 8/17 after making two brief appearances with High-A - his first two in the Orioles system. Surrendered 14 earned runs in his first two starts (8 IP) for Bowie, before finishing the season by allowing 4 ER in his final 4 starts (18.2 IP).
- Played two-plus seasons at Ball State. Originally drafted by the Houston Astros in the 4th round of the 2021 draft.
- Struck out 199 batters for Ball State in two seasons, across 139 innings. Redshirted his first season at Ball State in 2018 while recovering from Tommy John Surgery.
- Comes from a long legacy of Indiana basketball. Older brother Sean, played in the NBA for the Memphis Grizzlies during the 2020-21 season, and collegiately at Butler. Mother, Kim, played at Indiana State. Grandfather, Alan Danner, was a high school basketball coach who won two Indiana state titles, also in the Indiana Basketball Hall of Fame. Uncles, Linc and Tige, played at Purdue and Appalachian State, respectively. Uncle Linc was head men's basketball coach at D2 Florida Southern and won a national championship in 2015 - also coached Wisconsin-Green Bay and reached the March Madness tournament in 2016. Linc was Associate Head Coach at Ball State in 2022.

## NOTES BY OUTING\*

- Allowed a leadoff single in the first inning, but worked a double play. Allowed two doubles, but did not allow any runners to third base. After an efficient opening, 25 pitches in the fifth inning kept him from going further.
- Labored over 21 pitches and two baserunners in the first inning, but retired eight consecutive batters into the fourth. Struck out five over four innings, but an error helped cut his fifth inning short, and a reliever allowed two inherited runners to score.
- Relieved Houston Roth in tandem, allowed a triple to the first batter he faced, and a double to the same batter later (Tyler Fitzgerald) Both runs came from the same batter.
- Walked first batter and allowed a home run to the second. Allowed a second home run later in the inning. 28 pitch first inning followed by six strikeouts over the next three scoreless innings.
- Struck out the first four batters, then allowed a single and two-run home run. Did not allow any more hits while Bowie used two three-run home runs to win.
- Worked around two two-out singles in the first inning. Allowed a two-run home run in the second, and had to escaped bases loaded in the fourth.
