**Tonight's Game:** The Nashville Sounds and Gwinnett Stripers conclude a six-game series this afternoon at First Horizon Park. The Sounds will try to split the set after dropping a pair of one-run losses in back-to-back nights. Left-hander Thomas Pannone will face left-hander Dylan Dodd, both facing each other for the second time this week.

**Thomas Pannone:** 29-year-old Thomas Pannone gets his third start of the Sounds this afternoon. The left-hander is 0-0 with a 2.31 ERA (11.2 IP/3 ER) through four outings. He took a no decision in his last start on May 9 vs. Gwinnett. He went a season-long 4.0 innings, scattering six hits to allow one run with five strikeouts. He began the season on the development list before being activated on April 22. The Rhode Island native went 5-3 with a 4.57 ERA across 14 appearances (12 starts) for Triple-A Worcester last season. He spent parts of two seasons with Toronto in 2018 and 2019. Pannone was selected in the ninth round of the 2013 First-Year Player Draft by Cleveland out of the Community College of Southern Nevada.

**Dylan Dodd:** 24-year-old Dylan Dodd makes his fifth start with Gwinnett and eighth start of the season. The left-hander is 1-2 with a 7.50 ERA (18.0 IP/15 ER) with the Stripers. He's also made three starts for Atlanta, posting a 2-1 record with a 6.46 ERA (15.1 IP/11 ER) in 2023. Dodd took the loss on Tuesday, allowing seven runs (7 ER) on eight hits in 3.1 innings. His ERA is 1.04 points better in the Majors with Atlanta than it is with Gwinnett this year. The Elk Grove, Ill. native was drafted by Atlanta in the third round of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft out of Southeast Missouri State University.

**2023 Standings:** The Sounds have spent the following number of days in the International League West Division standings in 2023: First: 1, Second: 6, Third: 2, Fourth: 7, Fifth: 18, Sixth: 2, Seventh: 0, Eighth: 0, Ninth: 0, Tenth: 0.

**Toro Tearing It Up:** Infielder Abraham Toro extended his on-base streak to 30 games after reaching with a single in last night's contest. The streak is the second-longest on-base streak in all of Minor League Baseball, trailing only Salt Lake hitter Michael Stefanic's 33-game streak. Toro is batting .304 (34-for-112) with 10 doubles, 14 RBI, 17 walks and nine runs during the streak.

**Pat the Bat:** Infielder Following his two-run homer on Friday, Patrick Dorrian tallied three hits for the first time this season. His 3-for-3 night tied his career-best for most hits in a game. His last three knock day came against the Sounds on May 3, 2022 while playing with Norfolk. In his last seven games, Dorrian is hitting .360 (9-for-25) with seven RBI and a 1.227 OPS.

**Hiura on the IL:** Keston Hiura went on the 7-day injured list yesterday. At the time of his injury, Hiura ranked among league leaders in the top ten in homers (T-2nd, 12), slugging (4th, .678), RBI (T-4th, 32), OPS (5th, 1.074), RBI (T-6th, 33) total bases (T-6th, 80) and extra-base hits (T-7th, 17). He also had reached base safely in 17 games, batting .419 (26-for-62) with 11 runs, five doubles, five home runs, 20 RBI and seven walks.

**Monasterio Makes His Mark:** Andrew Monasterio tacked on another game to his on-base streak with a couple hits last night, extending it to 17 games. Monasterio is hitting .322 (19-for-59) with 16 runs, 12 RBI and 17 walks and a .462 OBP during the streak.

**Pitcher Perfect:** The Sounds pitching staff boasts the second-best ERA in the league at 3.97, trailing only Norfolk's mark of 3.52. Nashville hurlers also boast the best WHIP at 1.32 and the second-fewest walks with 145. The bullpen has the lowest ERA among relievers at 3.51 (184.2 IP/72 ER).

**How Bizarre:** Despite tying a season-high with 14 hits in last night's contest, the Sounds fell by a run for the second-consecutive game to Gwinnett. It was just the fourth time this season that Nashville lost in which they outhit their opponent. The Sounds are 3-6 in one-run games.

**Filling Up the Zone:** Left-hander Robert Gasser logged five more strikeouts over 5.0 innings in last night's no decision. Gasser is tied for fifth among league leaders with 39 strikeouts on the season.

**The Future Brew Crew:** Nashville currently has three players on the roster who are listed on MLB Pipeline's Top-30 Milwaukee prospects. Outfielder Sal Frelick is the No. 2 prospect, left-handed pitcher Robert Gasser is the No. 9 prospect and left-handed pitcher Ethan Small is the No. 13 prospect.

**How Sweet It Is:** Sounds manager Rick Sweet is in his fourth season overall and third consecutive season at the helm of the Nashville club. The reigning International League Manager of the Year, Sweet led the Sounds to a 91-58 record in 2022, 70-58 record in 2021 and a 77-67 record in 2014. He has served as the manager for Milwaukee's Triple-A club since the 2014 season and has compiled a 619-535 record during an eight-season span.

**LAST OUTING:** Pannone last appeared in the series opener on Tuesday. He tossed 4.0 one-run innings, allowing six hits and striking out five. Pannone did not pitch long enough to be eligible for the win, settling for a no-decision in the Sounds' 11-3 thumping of Gwinnett.

**AGAINST OPPONENT:** This is Pannone's second career appearance against Gwinnett, his first coming the series opener on Tuesday. He is 0-0 with a 2.25 ERA (4.0 IP/1 ER).

### 2023 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS:

- Began season on development list...activated on April 22.
- Made first appearance of season on April 23, coming out of the bullpen.
- Made first start on May 3, allowing two runs (both earned) in 3.0 innings.

### 2022 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS:

- Went 5-3 with a 4.57 ERA in 14 games (12 starts) with Triple-A Worcester...walked just 3.1% of hitters faced, the 2nd lowest in International League (min. 60 IP).
- After being released by Boston on June 27, made 14 starts for the Kia Tigers of the Korea Baseball Organization...went 3-4 with a 2.72 ERA and 73 strikeouts over 82.2 innings.

### 2021 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS:

- Went 5-11 with a 7.07 ERA in 24 games (21 starts) with Triple-A Salt Lake (Los Angeles-AL)...posted highest ERA in Minor League Baseball (min. 100 IP).
- Led the Triple-A West in innings pitched...was one of just seven qualifying pitchers in the league.

- Named International League Pitcher of the Week for June 30, 2019 after going 2-0 with a 1.63 ERA (11.0 IP/2 ER) and 14 strikeouts.
- Carried a no-hitter into the seventh inning of his first Major League start on August 22, 2018 vs. Baltimore...only hit was Trey Mancini's single to start seventh.
- In 2017, went 9-3 with a 2.36 ERA in 25 starts with Double-A Akron, Double-A New Hampshire and Advanced-A Lynchburg.
- Named an Eastern League Mid-Season All-Star in 2017...led the Eastern League in ERA (.227) and WHIP (1.09)...ranked among Eastern League leaders in ERA (2nd, 2.92), winning percentage (3rd, .700) and strikeouts (10th, 110).
- Did not allow an earned run (1 R) through first six starts of 2017 between Lynchburg (5 GS) and Akron (1 GS)...streak of 33.1 innings without an earned run was the second longest in the full season minor leagues by a starting pitcher.
- Traded to Toronto on July 31 alongside 2B Samad Taylor in exchange for RHP Joe Smith
- Named a Midwest League Mid-Season All-Star in 2016.
- Drafted by Cleveland in the ninth round of the 2013 First-Year Player Draft.

- Graduated from Bishop Hendricken High School (RI).
- Initially drafted by Chicago-NL in the 33rd round of the 2012 First-Year Player Draft, but did not sign.
