YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the Senators, 7-6. Richmond homered three times in the game, including back-to-back homers in the first inning. Bryce Eldridge hit a two-run shot and Drew Ellis followed with a solo home run to open a 3-0 lead. In the fourth, Zach Morgan belted a three-run homer to open a 6-0 lead. After Harrisburg's Murphy Staley hit a two-run homer in the fifth, Ellis hit an RBI single in the fifth to push the lead to 7-2. In the sixth, Maxwell Romeron hit an RBI single and Stehly doubled in to runs to close the score to 7-5. In the seventh, Jonathon Thomas doubled in a run to pull the Senators within a run. Braxton Roxby struck out the final two batters to strand two runners on base in the ninth. Manuel Mercedes picked up his second win of the season

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the fifth of a six-game series against the Harrisburg Senators, Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals. Richmond played two road series in Harrisburg this year and went 2-4 in both sets, first from April 8-13 and again from May 6-11. Along with this week's series, the Senators return to The Diamond for a three-game set from July 18-20 out of the All-Star Break.

PACKING THE HOUSE: Last year, the Flying Squirrels led all 30 Double-A teams in average (6,595) and total (435,295) attendance. Among the 120 MiLB teams, the Flying Squirrels were 10th in average attendance. It was the third straight year the Flying Squirrels led all 30 Double-A clubs in average and total attendance, which had not been done prior to 2022. Last year's total attendance is the highest since 2013 (434,769) and the fourth-highest average in team history. April 4 marked the 15th consecutive Opening Night sellout, marking every home opener in franchise history to date. This year, the Flying Squirrels are averaging 6,902 fans per home game, which ranks third among all 120 MiLB clubs. Their average of 7,290 in the season's first month was the highest April attendance in franchise history.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS are 3-9 in their last 12 games. Prior to splitting the first four games this week, they went 1-5 in last week's series in Binghamton, falling on three walk-off hits. In the Flying Squirrels' last six losses, four have been by one run. Of Richmond's 34 losses this season, 18 of them have been by two runs or less (12 by one, six by two). The Richmond offense has the second-fewest strikeouts (390) in the Eastern League but are last in runs scored (155). The Richmond pitching staff is last in ERA (4.68) on the season.

THE SENATORS are 4-10 in their last 14 games, including going 1-5 in their home series against the Baysox last week. In the Eastern League, the Harrisburg offense ranks first in triples (22), second in hits (403), second in total bases (632), third in runs (223), fourth in RBIs (205) and tied for fourth in homers (35). Harrisburg's roster features two players ranked in Baseball America's top-30 Nationals prospects list, including RHP Jarlin Susana (No. 3 - on IL) and 3B Cayden Wallace (No. 9). MLB.com's top-30 Nationals prospects list features three Harrisburg players, including Susana (No. 2), Wallace (No. 10) and SS Kevin Made (No. 26).

STARTING STRONG: Richmond starting pitchers have posted a 2.96 ERA (17 ER/51.2 IP) over the last 10 games dating back to May 20. Last Tuesday, Seth Lonsway threw 5.1 scoreless innings and struck out six batters to open the series. In the finale on Sunday, he allowed four runs over 5.1 innings. Last Wednesday, Joe Whitman threw five scoreless innings and set a career high with 11 strikeouts prior to the game being suspended for rain in the top of the sixth inning and followed with seven scoreless innings on Tuesday against the Senators. John Michael Bertrand scattered five hits and a walk over four scoreless innings in Friday night's 6-1 Flying Squirrels win on May 23 and surrendered four earned runs in seven innings on Thursday. Last Saturday, Manuel Mercedes set a season high with six strikeouts and allowed one run in five innings. Jack Choate allowed two runs over 4.2 innings on Sunday in the first game of Sunday's doubleheader.

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander Jack Choate makes his 10th start of the season and the fourth of his career against the Senators. He last pitched in the first game of Sunday's doubleheader at Binghamton and allowed two runs over 4.2 innings in a loss. In his last outing against the Senators on May 7 at FNB Field, he threw five innings and allowed two runs in a loss. Last year, Choate spent most of the season with High-A Eugene, going 1-3 with a 2.90 ERA in 19 outings (18 starts). He was promoted to Double-A Richmond in August and made eight starts for the Flying Squirrels, posting a 1-4 record with a 5.82 ERA to close the season. Choate finished 2024 ranked first among qualified, full-season Giants minor-league pitchers in BAA (.231) and WHIP (1.21) while ranking second in ERA (3.79). Choate was selected by the Giants in the ninth round of the 2022 MLB Draft out of Assumption University. He entered 2025 ranked by Baseball America as the No. 28 Giants prospect and No. 27 by MLB.com. For more on Choate, see page two.

FOR HARRISBURG: Right-hander Kyle Luckham makes his 11th start of the season and the seventh of his career against the Flying Squirrels. He last pitched on Sunday against the Baysox and threw seven innings, allowing two runs in a no-decision. In the Eastern League this season, Luckham is ranked first in innings pitched (51.1) and sixth in ERA (2.45). This year marks Luckham's third overall with the Senators. He first pitched for Harrisburg for one start in 2023. Last year, he worked 23 games (21 starts), going 5-8 with a 4.47 ERA. Luckham was promoted to Triple-A Rochester last July for four starts before returning to Double-A. He has made six previous starts against Richmond in his career, four of them last season, and has gone 0-3 with a 4.72 ERA (18 ER/34.1 IP). Luckham was selected in the 15th round of the 2022 MLB Draft by the Nationals out of Arizona State University.

DON'T RUN ON RICHMOND: The Flying Squirrels' catching unit of **Adrián Sugastey** and **Zach Morgan** have combined to catch 28 stolen base attempts this season, which is second among the 30 Double-A teams and leads the Eastern League. Sugastey is tied for first among Double-A catchers with 17 runners caught stealing. Morgan is tied for third in the Eastern League with 11, which is tied for ninth in Double-A.

WAIT A MINUTE: Northern Virginia native Bryce Eldridge returned to the Richmond roster on April 22 after missing the start of the season with an injury. He hit a solo home run in his first plate appearance of the year. The 20-year-old first baseman played at four levels in the Giants organization in his first full professional season last year, including nine games with Richmond in September. For the year in 116 games, Eldridge hit. 291 with 23 homers and 92 RBIs. He is ranked by Baseball America as the No. 21 prospect in baseball. Eldridge is also the fifth Virginia-born player to suit up for the Flying Squirrels in franchise history. On May 10, Eldridge drove a two-out, three-run homer against the Senators to give the Flying Squirrels the lead in the eighth for a comeback win. In two games on May 15 (G2)-16, he went 5-for-7 with three homers, two doubles and five RBIs. On Wednesday he hit his sixth homer of the season and drove in three runs. Eldridge homered again on Friday night, a two-run shot. In his last 16 games since May 13, Eldridge is hitting .328 (19-for-58) with five homers, five doubles and 12 RBIs.

HELLO, GAVELLO: Catcher/infielder/outfielder Thomas Gavello joined the Flying Squirrels from High-A Eugene on May 9. In his Double-A debut on May 10 at Harrisburg, he hit a double on the first pitch he saw in the game. He followed with two hits, including another double, in his second game the following day. On Thursday night, he hit his first Double-A homer, a two-run shot to right. Since joining Richmond, Gavello has picked at least one hit in 10-of-13 Double-A games he has played, including five doubles, and is batting .350. He has played one game at shortstop and 12 games in left field, the first games of his professional career in the outfield.

CLOSE CALLS: Of the Flying Squirrels' last six loses four have been one-run. In four-of-their-last-six losses, their opponent has scored the winning run in their final inning at bat, including three walk-off losses at Binghamton last week. On the season, 18 of the Flying Squirrels' 34 losses have been by two runs or less, which is the most in the Eastern League. The Flying Squirrels have the most one-run losses (12) in the EL this year. They have lost six games by two runs.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, Diego Velasquez is tied for 10th in hits (44). Seth Lonsway is 10th in ERA (2.89) and 10th in WHIP (1.18). Joe Whitman is sixth in strikeouts (49), eighth in WHIP (1.08) and ninth in BAA (.200). Jack Choate is seventh in strikeouts (48). John Michael Bertrand is tied for first in games started (10) and second in innings pitched (50.0).

TOP SKIPPER: Flying Squirrels manager **Dennis Pelfrey** has led the team to 219 wins in his career, which is a new franchise record all-time wins record for a manager. He passed the record with Richmond's 6-1 win at Binghamton on May 23. From 2011-2013, **Dave Machemer** won 216 games as Richmond's manager, leading the team to the Eastern League postseason for in 2011. Pelfrey, who has been with Richmond since the 2022 season, led the team to back-to-back postseason appearances for the first time in franchise history in 2022 and 2023. He also managed the 2021 Eugene Emeralds to the High-A West championship.

PROSPECT WATCH: Richmond's roster includes seven players are ranked in Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including Bryce Eldridge (No. 1), Joe Whitman (No. 10), Diego Velasquez (No. 13), Sabin Ceballos (No. 16), Trent Harris (No. 26), Aeverson Arteaga (No. 27) and Jack Choate (No. 28). There are also seven players ranked in MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list, including Eldridge, (No. 1), Whitman (No. 7), Harris (No. 11), Velasquez (No. 15), Arteaga (No. 16), Ceballos (No. 23) and Choate (No. 27). Eldridge is also ranked No. 21 overall by Baseball America and No. 21 by MLB.com.

THIS DATE IN RICHMOND **BASEBALL HISTORY**

1957: The Richmond Virginians beat the Columbus Jets, 9-6, at Parker Field. After trailing 6-0 through four, the Vees scored four runs in the seventh and four more in the eighth to pull ahead, 9-6. Tom Carroll hit a three-run double in the eighth to break the tie. 1976: The Richmond Braves beat the Syracuse Chiefs, 3-1, at Parker Field. Jeff Greach hit a two-run homer to open the scoring in the seventh, backing pitcher Preston Hanna to his first win of the year. Jack McKeon used three relief pitchers to work through the ninth. **1991:** The Richmond Braves beat the Iowa Cubs, 10-1, at The Diamond. The game was tied, 1-1, in the fifth inning before rain delayed play for 90 minutes. Following the delay, Richmond scored three runs in three straight innings from the sixth through the eighth. Victor Rosario had three hits and drove in three runs. Deion Sanders had two hits and scored a run. 2018: The Flying Squirrels beat the Bowie Baysox, 7-6. Down by a run with two outs in the bottom of the ninth, Ronnie Jebavy drove home Dillon Dobson and Dylan Davis with a two-run, walk-off single. Jerry Sands had two hits in the game and drove in two runs. Jordan Johnson started on the mound and allowed two runs over 5.1 innings.
