- The Blue Jays dropped the second game of the series with Lakeland, 4-2 on Wednesday night.
- The game was headlined by two high-profile rehabs assignments: Ricky Tiedemann on the mound and Joey Votto at first base. Tiedemann, in his second rehab start with the D-Jays, worked 2.1 innings, striking out five while walking around two second-inning walks.
- Votto went 0-3, and played five innings in the field.
- Dunedin claimed an early lead thanks to an RBI triple from Victor Arias in the 3rd. That lead swelled to 2-0 thanks to an Adrian Meza RBI single in the 5th.
- Lakeland got on the board with a run in the fifth, and then took the lead for good with a three-run rally in the fourth, highlighted by a go-ahead two-RBI triple from Samuel Gil.
- Dunedin managed just one base runner in the final four innings of the contest.

## HOW DO YOU DO, FELLOW KIDS?

Today's matinee marks the Blue Jays third and final scheduled mid-week day game of the season. Dunedin has split their prior two mid-week matinees: a 3-2 win vs Daytona on June 19, and a 10-1 loss to Clearwater on April 17. Coincidentally, Juaron Watts-Brown started both games, and is scheduled to start today.

## JUARON WHIFFS BROWN

Blue Jays starter Juaron Watts-Brown ranks second in Single-A in whiffs, drawing 159 in 53 innings - an average of 3 per frame. Watts-Brown's 38% whiff rate is the fourth-best in Single-A among pitchers with over 500 pitches. Watts-Brown's 70 strikeouts this season rank 10th in the FSL, one behind teammate Fernando Perez.

## NIGHT AND DAY DIFFERENCE

The Blue Jays have hit significantly better in day games (.241 in 14 games) than night games (.213 in 56 games). Manuel Beltre is hitting .340 (17-50) in 12 day contests. Edward Duran is hitting .306 during the day. On the other side of the scoreboard, Dunedin pitching has struggled during the day, surrendering a 5.11 ERA, compared to a 3.64 mark in night games.

## JAMMIN' BATS IN JUNE

Dunedin's pitching staff is in the midst of its best month of the season, pitching to a 3.26 ERA in 21 games in June, the fourth best mark in the FSL. In May, the Blue Jays turned in a 4.70 ERA - the second-worst in the league.

## TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT

Tuesday night's 5-4 victory marked Dunedin's 25th one-run game this season - the second-most in the FSL, behind Bradenton's 27. The Jays are 12-13 in those contests. 49 of the Blue Jays 70 games this season (70%) have been decided by three or fewer runs. Dunedin has a 25-24 record in those games. Eight of the team's last nine have been decided by three or fewer.

## VAMOS, VICTOR

Outfielder Victor Arias' .286 average and .841 OPS lead the Blue Jays in June. The hot month comes after a cool May in which Arias batted just .211. On June 14, Arias went 4-5 with 2 home runs and 8 RBIs - the most runs driven in by a D-Jay in a single game since 2021. Arias' .791 OPS is 7th in the FSL among qualified hitters.

## ROAD COOKING

Dunedin's pitching staff has proved to be more effective on the road than at home. At TD Ballpark, the Jays have posted a 4.30 ERA in 343 innings. On the road, the staff's ERA stands at 3.49 in 283.1 innings - the second best road ERA in the FSL.

## SERIES SUCCESS

Last week's series victory marks six straight sets with a split or better for the D-Jays. Across the last six series, Dunedin has earned three splits and three series wins.

## HOPE SPRINGS ETERNAL IN THE SUMMER

Dunedin has opened the second half 2-2. The D-Jays' 34-32 mark in the first half was the team's best first half record since 2019 (41-24). Last season, Dunedin finished in last place in the FSL West in the second half with a 30-36 record. In 2022, Dunedin won the second-half title with a 38-25 record after going 28-38 in the first half.

### ABOUT JUARON

- Selected by the Blue Jays in the 3rd round of the 2023 draft out of Oklahoma State... Did not make pro debut in 2023.
- Grew up in Hanford, CA; located west of Visalia and south of San Jose. Same hometown as 1996 National League MVP Ken Caminiti.
- Throws a four pitch mix that features a low-90s fastball, slider, curve and changeup. Mid-80s slider has been considered his best pitch by scouts. Slider is occasionally identified as a cutter by Statcast - does not throw a cutter.
- Was a three-sport star at Hanford High School... was the school's starting varsity quarterback and also played basketball.
- Was originally committed to Texas Tech out of high school, but Red Raiders pulled offer after a football injury suffered his senior year.

- Opponents batting .250 against fastball... but .170 vs Slider, .118 against changeup...
- Tied season-high in strikeouts in last start, 6/19 vs Daytona... worked six innings for second time in three starts.
- Delivered first walk-free start of the year, working 6 IP on 6/5 at Palm Beach.
- 2nd in Single-A with 159 Whiffs, 11th with 38% Whiff rate (min. 400 pc).
- Struck out season-high 9 batters in just four innings on 5/15 vs Jupiter... left bases loaded in final inning of work. Drew 20 whiffs.
- Turned in season-high 6 innings on 5/8 at Fort Myers... allowed 4 runs, just two earned.
- Made professional debut on 4/10 at Tampa... Fired 5 innings of 2 run ball with four strikeouts... Walked first batter faced, then retired nine straight. Allowed one run in each of final two innings.

### COLLEGE

- Played two seasons of college baseball - the last of which at Oklahoma State in 2023. Pitched to a 5.03 ERA in 17 appearances and 15 starts, totaling to 82.1 innings. Struck out 124 batters (13.6 K/9) to lead the Big 12.
- Started collegiate career at Long Beach State in his home state of California... missed 2021 season with a shoulder injury (sustained playing football in high school), but broke out in his redshirt freshman year in 2022. Earned Freshman All-American honors, firing a 3.68 ERA in 15 appearances, 12 of them starts. Struck out 111 hitters in 73.1 innings (13.6 K/9).
- Threw a 9-inning, 11 strikeout no-hitter for Long Beach State on Mother's Day 2022, with his mom in attendance.
- Played in the prestigious Cape Cod league in the summer of 2022 and posted a 3.71 ERA in 34 innings for Falmouth.
