Today: The Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, play the second in a six-game series against the Dayton Dragons, High-A affiliate of the Cincinnati Reds, the 363rd alltime meeting between the two teams. The Lugnuts and Dragons split a six-game series in Lansing in mid May in their only prior encounter; Dayton then won the opener of this series last night.

Starting Matchup: The Nuts are expected to throw 23-year-old right-hander Jorge Juan, the A's No. 24 prospect, in his second start back from a rehab stint in the Arizona Complex League. Right-hander Christian Fernandez is then expected to follow Juan in out of the bullpen; tomorrow will be Fernandez's 23rd birthday. Dayton counters with right-hander Thomas Farr, the 150th overall pick of the 2021 draft from South Carolina. Farr allowed two runs in four innings in a no-decision against the Lugnuts on May 12.

Last Game: Dragons 4, Lugnuts 2. Justice Thompson hit a tie-breaking two-run homer to right field in the bottom of the seventh inning, lifting Dayton to victory in the first game of this series. The game had previously seen Lansing starter Grant Holman whiff six in three innings, Dayton starter Christian Roa fan nine in five innings, and rehabbing MLBer Art Warren toss a scoreless frame.

On Deck: The Lugnuts play the Dragons through Sunday before returning home next week to host the Great Lakes Loons.

Transaction: Entering today's game, the Lugnuts added INF Sahid Valenzuela from Double-A Midland. The Cal State Fullerton Titan had begun the season with the Nuts before joining the RockHounds on June 22. Valenzuela has had greater success this season in Double-A (25 games, four doubles, four homers, .211/.253/.389, .642 OPS) than in High-A (22 games, 1 double, .159/.209/.175, .384 OPS).

Ain't That a Shane: C Shane McGuire has been sensational since being promoted to Lansing from Single-A Stockton. The San Diego Torero, drafted in the ninth round last year, went 3-for-3 with a walk, a single, two doubles and both Lugnuts runs scored last night. In seven games with the Nuts overall, he's slashing .391/.517/.652. Consider, too, that he was hitless in his first six Midwest League at-bats, meaning that he's hit safely in 9 of his last 17 at-bats and reached base in 15 of his last 23 plate appearances.

Double Your Fun: McGuire collected two of the Lugnuts' 2022 single game high six doubles last night, with Euribiel Ángeles, Denzel Clarke, Bravan Buelvas and Patrick McColl each supplying a two-bagger. (Before last night, the Nuts had a total of eight doubles in their first six games with Dayton.) Unfortunately for Lansing, Buelyas's RBI double in the fourth inning was the Nuts' lone hit in 17 at-bats with runners in scoring position.

Basically a Basketball Team: The Lansing starting rotation features 6'8 Jorge Juan, 6'7 Kyle Virbitsky and 6'6 Grant Holman alongside 6'3 Jake Walkinshaw, 6'2 Joey Estes and 6'1 Jack Owen.

Amongst the League Leaders: The Lugnuts are third in the Midwest League in team batting average (.247) and third in base hits (829). Reliever Kumar Nambiar is tied for first in the league with West Michigan's Andrew Magno with 36 appearances. Infielder Euribiel Ángeles is fifth with 95 base hits.

Leaving His Mark: Promoted 20-year-old top prospect Tyler Soderstrom continues to lead the Midwest League in RBIs (71) and is tied for first in home runs (20), second in total bases (172) and second in extra-base hits (42). Soderstrom is hitting .259 with a double, a triple, a home run and six RBIs in his first six games with Double-A Midland after slashing .260/.323/.513 in 89 games with the Lugnuts.

Welcome Back! The 6'8 right-hander, the tallest player on the team, was reinstated from the Injured List in Single-A Stockton and promoted to the Lugnuts on August 4. Juan made two starts last year for the Lugnuts, at Lake County and at home vs. Dayton, before landing on the Injured List; he returned on August 5, tossing 1 1/3 innings vs. West Michigan in a no-decision, allowing two runs in the 1st inning and a run in the 2nd inning (inherited/scored against Jake Walkinshaw).

Prospecting: Jorge is currently ranked MLB Pipeline's No. 24 prospect in the Oakland Athletics organization and No. 13 pitching prospect... ranked the A's No. 19 prospect entering the year by Baseball America ("Juan is built like a throwback NBA power forward"). His Pipeline grades: fastball - 65, curve - 55, change - 40, control - 50. Quoting MLB.com, "Juan was relatively unheralded when he signed out of the Dominican Republic with the A's for just \$10,000 in 2017 as an 18-year-old. Struggling through some command issues early in his professional career, he returned from the year off due to the pandemic and unexpectedly broke out in 2021, showcasing an uptick in velocity that really helped put himself on Oakland's radar as his power arm dominated hitters at Low-A Stockton before a flexor strain cut his season short."

2017, Signing Day: Juan signed with Oakland's Juan C. De La Cruz, who was also the signing scout for former Lugnuts pitchers Richard Guasch and Rafael Kelly.

2018, Dominican Summer League: Jorge spent the entire season in the DSL, beginning in a piggyback tandem with Carlos Leandro, alternating starts and relief appearances... the team also included future Lugnut Richard Guasch, traded last year to the Washington Nationals... struggled with his control, hitting ten batters in his first nine appearances but only one in his last six... opposing base stealers went 14-for-18 in effectiveness against him.... dominated left-handed batters (5-for-46, .109) compared to right-handers (27-for-111, 10 HBP, .243).... gave up only five extra-base hits, all doubles

2019, Arizona League: Started the third game of the season for A's Green, bursting out of the gates with an impressive 3 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 2 BB, 7 K... followed up with three scoreless innings in his second appearance but then hit a road block, allowing at least one run in every subsequent appearance, including three games with 4+ runs allowed and seven games with 3+ walks... opposing base stealers were 11-for-16... again handled lefties (11-for-52, .212, .364 OBP, .614 OPS) compared to right-handers (21-for-72, .292, .469 OBP, .886 OPS)... allowed eight extra-base hits (6 doubles, 1 triple, 1 home run).

2021, Low-A West: Joined Stockton for the 44th game of the year, starting June 24 at Inland Empire and tossing two innings (4 H, 3 R, 2 BB, 2 K) before current Lugnut Jack Cushing relieved him and threw six dazzling innings (1 UER) of relief... followed up with a gem, four hitless innings vs. San Jose, July 1... opposing base stealers went 4-for-4... left-handed batters hit .214 (9-for-42, 2 2B, 2 HR), right-handers hit .188 (6-for-32, 1 3B).

2021, Lansing: Joined the Lugnuts and made two starts (August 4 at Lake County: 2 2/3 IP, 3 H, 3 R, 3 BB, 3 K; August 10 vs. Dayton: 3 IP, 4 H, 4 R, 2 HR, 3 BB, 6 K) before being shut down due to flexor strain.

2022, The Present Day: A tumultuous period of time saw Juan get added to the 40-man roster in November, removed from the 40-man on May 8 and given his release, and then sign back with the Athletics on a minor league contract on May 16, eight days later... he was placed on the Stockton Injured List, with a two-start rehab stint in the Arizona Complex League readying him for his return.

Hometown: Payita is located on the northern coast in the region of Maria Trinidad Sanchez, just north of the region's capital, Nagua, and northeast of San Francisco de Macoris... others from Maria Trinidad Sanchez include Diego Castillo (Cabrera), Ubaldo Jiménez (Nagua) and Emmanuel Clase (Rio San Juan).

Life as a Lugnut: Assigned to Lansing on July 10 after being acquired from the Tampa Bay Rays with Triple-A outfielder Cal Stevenson on July 9 for Christian Bethancourt... debuted for the Nuts on July 13 at Fort Wayne, looking great with a 1-2-3 first inning before allowing three runs on three singles and two walks in the second inning and then a fourth run in the third inning on two singles sandwiched around a wild pitch... after delay due to All-Star Break, made second start on July 27th, allowing seven runs at Great Lakes in two innings (four runs in 1st, three in 2nd... gave up leadoff home run in each frame (Eddys Leonard, Edwin Mateo).

Last Start: August 3rd vs. West Michigan. Allowed six hits in 3 1/3 innings, but only gave up one run, scoring in the fourth inning on a Trei Cruz one-out solo home run... had stranded a two-out single in the first, a pair of singles in the second (aided by a caught-stealing by Shane McGuire), and a pair of singles plus a walk in the third, leaving the bases loaded... relief corps handled the rest in an 8-1 victory over the Whitecaps.

The Early Word: When announcing the trade with the Rays, Athletics general manager Dan Feinstein summed up Fernandez to the media, "A four-pitch mix. Fastball averages 93. Three really good off-speed pitches. The change-up is probably the best one. Has the ability to get swings and misses, plus a slider and curve ball." Feinstein also informed the media that Fernandez missed the 2021 season with an unspecified arm injury... Fernandez is eligible for the Rule 5 Draft at season's end.

Home Cooking: Home of Cabimas is located in northwestern Venezuela on the shore of Maracaibo Lake in the state of Zulia... notables from Cabimas include Marlins ace Pablo López and longtime Major Leaguer Vic Davalillo (1963-1980).

Path Through the Pros: Debuted in 2016 in the Dominican Summer League working entirely out of the bullpen... converted to starting pitcher in 2017 DSL with greater success... split 2018 between DSL and Gulf Coast League... spent 2019 in the Appy League with Princeton... missed all of 2020 (canceled MiLB season) and 2021 (injury).
