STRONG START: The Delmarva Shorebirds started the 2023 season in impressive fashion thanks to a huge night from the offense. Samuel Basallo and Elio Prado who each collected 3 hits, 3 RBIs and a home run. Despite 11 walks from the pitching staff and 4 errors in the field, the Shorebirds provided plenty of offense and always had a timely answer offensively as they topped the Red Sox 11-7 on opening night.

TODAY'S OPPONENT: The opening series of the season continues against North Division rival, Salem with LHP Noah Dean taking the mound for the Red Sox.

BOUNCE BACK SEASON: 2022 was a rough campaign for the 'Birds who finished the season 49-81 overall, which was the worst overall record amongst teams in the Carolina League and third worst in all of Single-A (Stockton & Visalia, 45-87). The 2022 squad narrowly avoid being the least successful team in franchise history according to winning percentage as they just edged out the 2012 team that finished 52-86 (.376). However, the Shorebirds with plenty of fresh faces finished the 2022 regular season strong 15-12 in their final 27 game, which included a series victory of Down East in the final week of the regular season and taking 4 of 6 versus Lynchburg who finished as the runner-up in the Carolina League.

YOUNG MAN'S GAME: The debut roster for the Delmarva Shorebirds will showcase plenty of youth as the average of the team is 20.9 years-old.

HE WAS #1: Jackson Holliday became the second No. 1 overall pick to play for the Shorebirds (Adley Rutschman, 2019) when he debuted on August 25. Holliday was drafted first overall last out of Stillwater HS where he was named HS Player of the Year by Baseball America (.685/.749/1.392), setting the national record for hits in a season (89). Holliday is the son of seven-time All-Star Matt Holliday.

WHAT ABOUT US?: The Delmarva Shorebirds opening day roster features three other prospects in addition to Jackson Holliday. Catcher Samuel Basallo will begin his first run at full-season baseball as the Orioles No. 12 prospect according to MLB Pipeline and No. 15 by Baseball America suits up for the Shorebirds at just 18 years of age as he showcases big time power and a strong arm behind home plate. Two other infielders make the rankings as infielder Carter Young (No. 30 MLB Pipeline) and Anderson De Los Santos (No. 30 Baseball America) look to make impacts on both sides of the ball.

TOP OF THE CLASS: For the second consecutive season, the Baltimore Orioles have the #1 ranked farm system according to both MLB Pipeline and Baseball America. Baltimore has 8 players in MLB Pipeline Top-100 including the Gunnar Henderson (No. 1), Grayson Rodriguez (No. 7) who are both currently with the big league club. Jackson Holliday is the No. 3 prospect for the Orioles and ranked 12th overall.

REMEMBER US?: There will be plenty of familiar faces on the Shorebirds Opening Day roster with 24 players who suited up at least once for Delmarva will be on the team to start the season.

WELCOME BACK FELIPE: Felipe Rojas Alou Jr. takes the helm for the second straight season in Delmarva as the team's manager. This will be Felipe's 16th season in the Orioles organization and he'll be joined by pitching coach Adam Bleday, Hitting Coach Josh Bunselmeyer, Fundamentals Coach Daniel Fajardo, Athletic Trainer Julio Ibarra, and Strength and Conditioning Coach Juan Sanchez.

TODAY'S STARTER: Alfred Vega takes the mound for Delmarva in Game 2 of the Regular Season

RULE-5 SELECTION: Alfred Vega will make his first start in the Orioles organization after he was acquired from the New York Yankees in the Rule-5 Draft in December of 2022. Vega has only pitched above just once in his career and that was in 2021 when he started for Single-A Tampa and dealt 4 innings with 6 strikeouts and 3 walks, giving up 1 runs on 2 hits in a no decision versus Clearwater (PHI).

LAST OUTING (8/22 vs. TOR-FCL): The last outing for Vega was on August 22 where he went 2.2 innings in a short start against the Blue Jays FCL team. He struck out 4 and walked 2, allowing 1 run on 3 hits. Took a no-decision in a 5-2 defeat

vs. SALEM: No prior matchups

2022 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS: Pitched just 7 times last season and twice as a starter for the Yankees FCL team in Tampa. Gave up just 2 earned runs in 15.2 innings and struck out 22 compared to 4 walks. Was left unprotected as a Rule-5 eligible player where he was then selected by the Orioles.

FELIPE ROJAS ALOU JR.

MANAGER



Returns to the Shorebirds for his second season as manager and his 16th in the Orioles organization. Previously, he served as the Director of the Orioles' Dominican Republic Academy. He was a 40th round pick by the Kansas City Royals in the 1998 amateur draft, he played in the minor leagues for the Royals from 1998 to 2001, and in the short-lived Canadian Baseball League in 2003. His father, Felipe, played in the Majors for 15+ years before managing the Expos ('92-'01) and Giants ('03-'06). Alou's brother, Luis Rojas, was the manager of the Mets and is currently on the Yankees coaching staff. This will be Felipe's 16th season in the Orioles organization.

ADAM BLEDAY

PITCHING COACH

Enters his first season as the Shorebirds Pitching Coach in 2023 after spending last season as a O's Pitching Coach in the Florida Complex League. Bleday played his college days as a Left-handed Pitcher for the University of Pennsylvania before being drafted in the 27th round of the 2017 MLB Draft by the Houston Astros. From there, Bleday spent two season in the Astros minor league ranks before making the jump to coaching in 2019.

JOSH BUNSELMAYER

Josh Bunselmeyer takes over as the Shorebirds Hitting Coach in 2023 after spending the last three seasons as a hitting coach for the Orioles between the Florida Complex League and the Dominican Summer League. Before coaching, Bunselmeyer played independent ball for the three season in the Frontier League as a utility player after playing college baseball for Saint Louis University.

Daniel Fajardo Is back in Delmarva for his second season as the Shorebirds Fundamentals Coach. After playing eight seasons in the Orioles minor league system and parts of two with the Shorebirds, Fajardo made his professional coaching debut with the 'Birds in 2022 bringing a wealth of knowledge from his time as a catcher. A 2019 Shorebirds Mid-Season All-Star, Fajardo was a Shorebirds fan-favorite hitting for a career .251 average with 124 RBI and 106 Runs Scored.
