Last Time Out: The Binghamton Rumble Ponies' rally fell just short against the Altoona Curve on Thursday night, falling 9-8 at PNG Field. It was a back-and-forth affair, but the Curve bullpen held off the Ponies' late rally, as Binghamton stranded the bases loaded in the seventh, eighth, and ninth innings. Connor Scott made a diving catch in right field on a potential go-ahead hit from Jose Peroza to end the game.

Jose ... Jose, Jose, Jose!: Infielder **Jose Peroza** belted the game-tying three-run homer in the ninth inning of Wednesday's game. Peroza has raised his average back above .300. He has 12 hits in his past seven games, including five multi-hit games. The 22-year-old has six runs batted in over his past six games. He hit .309 in the month of May across 26 games. He had a team-high 20 RBIs and 10 doubles in the month of May.

Grand Ole Augy: Outfielder **Agustin Ruiz** smashed his second homer of the series last night, with a go-ahead two-run shot to right field. Ruiz is now tied with Matt Rudick and Luke Ritter for the team lead in home runs with seven. Ruiz hit two home runs over his first 17 games of the season, and has now hit four homers in his last five games, including a grand slam and last night's two-run shot. The 23-year-old slugged 21 home runs across High-A and Double-A with the Padres in 2021.

McLaughlin Locked In: RHP **Trey McLaughlin** made his Double-A debut last night for Binghamton. He threw two scoreless frames, allowed two hits and struck out two batters. The 16th round pick by the Mets in 2021 has now not allowed an earned run in his last five appearances, including his last four for High-A Brooklyn. He has recorded at least one strikeout in all but one of his outings this season.

Jordan's Brand: Outfielder Rowdey Jordan reached base five times in last night's game, via two hits and three walks. Jordan is on a six-game hitting streak.

The Month of Rudick: Outfielder **Matt Rudick** had a ridiculous month of May. In 26 games, he hit .322 with a .459 OBP and 1.022 OPS. Rudick had 28 hits, six doubles, five homers, 15 RBIs, and more walks (18) than strikeouts (15). He currently leads the Eastern League with 35 runs scored and a .463 OBP.

Last Start: Hamel tied his season high with eight strikeouts over five innings of work in his last start against Richmond on Saturday. Hamel allowed four runs on eight hits, all in the fifth inning, before being taken out of the game. He threw four scoreless before the rough fifth inning. Left with a 6-4 lead and got the win.

World Baseball Classic: Hamel represented Team Puerto Rico in the 2023 World Baseball Classic. He honored his late mother, who passed away 11 days before the Mets selected him in the 2021 MLB Draft. He was WBC teammates with current New York Mets, Francisco Lindor and Edwin Díaz.

2022: Was named the 2022 New York Mets Minor League Pitcher of the Year. He led all Mets minor leaguers with 10 wins and 145 strikeouts. Began the season with St. Lucie (A) and pitched to a 5-2 record with a 3.84 ERA in 14 appearances and 13 starts. He tossed 63.1 innings and struck out 71 batters, before he was assigned to Brooklyn (A+) on July 4. He went 5-1 on the mound with a 2.59 ERA in 11 starts for the Cyclones. He struck out 74 hitters over 55.2 innings and opponents hit just .180 against him.

BACKGROUND: Ranks as the Mets' No. 2 pitching prospect and No. 7 overall Mets' prospect by MLB Pipeline. He was drafted out of Dallas Baptist University in the 3rd round (81st overall) by the Mets in 2021. Hamel went 13-2 on the mound and racked up 136 strikeouts in his final year at DBU in 2021. He spent his first two years at Yavapai College in Arizona.
