YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost to the Curve, 5-1. Jase Bowen opened the scoring with a two-run homer in the bottom of the second inning. In the sixth, **Matt Higgins** reached on catcher interference with the bases loaded to bring home Richmond's only run of the game. Sammy Siani doubled in a run and scored in the sixth and Tres Gonzalez brought him in to score with a single to extend the Curve lead to 4-1. In the eighth, Nick Cimillo pushed the Altoona lead to 5-1 with an RBI single.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels face the Altoona Curve, Double-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh Pirates, in the opener of a six-game series at PNG Field. This is the first of two triples to Altoona for Richmond this year. The Flying Squirrels won two-of-six at The Diamond from June 4-9, dropping the final four games of the series. The Curve also return to Richmond for a six-game set from August 20-25 and the Flying Squirrels close the regular season in Altoona from September 10-15.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 4-8 in their last 12 games dating back to July 13 after winning their previous four games. For the year, the Flying Squirrels are hitting .228 and averaging 3.75 runs per game (191 runs/51 games) at home compared to a .235 batting average and 4.71 runs per game on the road (212 runs/45 games). The Flying Squirrels are 11-5 in their last 16 road games since June 12. Richmond is 8-17 in its last 25 home games dating back to June 6.

THE CURVE are 1-8 in their last nine games since July 19 after going 9-1 in their previous 10 games from July 3-11. Altoona's roster includes five of Baseball America's top-30 Pirates prospects, including RHP Bubba Chandler (No. 1), RHP Thomas Harrington (No. 5), INF/OF Charles McAdoo (No. 12), INF Tsung-Che Cheng (No. 13) and LHP Hunter Barco (No. 16). MLB.com's top-30 Pirates prospects list includes seven Altoona players, including Chandler (No. 1), Harrington (No. 6), Cheng (No. 8), Barco (No. 13), OF Jase Bowen (No. 19), OF Tres Gonzalez (No. 26) and McAdoo (No. 29).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Nick Sinacola** makes his seventh Double-A start and his first since July 13 after being placed on the injured list. In his last outing, he worked two innings and allowed four runs in a loss against the Senators. He made his Double-A debut on June 6 against the Curve at The Diamond and allowed five runs over 4.1 innings. In his next five starts from June 12-July 4, he went 3-0 with a 1.33 ERA (4 ER/27.0 IP). Among Giants minor league pitchers (min. 70 IP), he leads the organization in BAA (.213) and WHIP (0.99), ranks third in ERA (3.05), third in BB/9 (1.95) and fifth in strikeout percentage (27.1%). He began the season with High-A Eugene and went 4-1 with a 2.68 ERA in 10 outings, including two starts. At the time of his promotion to Double-A, Sinacola ranked second among Northwest League pitchers (min. 40 IP) in WHIP (0.79), third in BB/9 (1.56), third in BAA (.190), ninth in ERA (2.68), and 10th in K/9 (8.48). He spent the entire 2023 season with the Emeralds and went 2-5 with a 4.58 ERA over 23 outings (20 starts). Sinacola was selected by the Giants in the seventh round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of the University of Maine, where he was the America East Pitcher of the Year that season as a senior. **For more on Sinacola, see page two.**

FOR ALTOONA: Right-hander Po-Yu Chen makes his 20th appearance and his 18th start of the season. He last pitched on Thursday at Erie and threw seven innings, allowing one run. In the month of July, Chen has gone 2-0 with a 1.00 ERA (3 ER/27.0 IP) in his four starts. He has allowed one-or-less earned runs in every July start, working seven innings three times and six innings once. Chen has made one start against the Flying Squirrels this season back on June 7 at The Diamond, when he picked up a win after striking out nine and allowing one run over a career-high eight innings. A native of Taiwan, Chen signed with the Pirates as an international free agent on October 7, 2020. He spent the 2023 season with High-A Greensboro, going 5-8 with a 4.44 ERA in 25 games (24 starts). He was a member of the 2019 U-18 Chinese Taipei national team that won a world championship, starting games against Panama and Korea before picking up the save in the gold medal game with two innings against the United States. His father, Ping-Nan Chen, played in the Chinese Professional Baseball League.

DEADLINE DEALS: The MLB trade deadline was Tuesday at 6 p.m. and Flying Squirrels reliever **Eric Silva** was traded to the Detroit Tigers for Mark Canha and will join the Erie SeaWolves. Silva became the fifth player all time traded from the Flying Squirrels at trade deadline time. The most recent deadline day trades directly impacting the Flying Squirrels were in 2021. That year, pitcher **Caleb Kilian** was traded to the Cubs as part of a deal for Kris Bryant and reliever **Jose Marte** was sent to the Angels as part of a package for Tony Watson. In 2012, catcher **Tommy Joseph** was traded from the Flying Squirrels along with two other players to the Phillies for Hunter Pence. In 2010, pitcher Daniel Turpen was swapped to the Red Sox for Ramon Ramirez. Current Flying Squirrels catcher **Andy Thomas** was a trade deadline acquisition for the Giants along with reliever **Michael Stryffeler** in 2022 for Matthew Boyd and Curt Casali. In 2022, **Tristan Peters** became the only players sent straight to Richmond after being traded at the deadline when he was picked up from the Brewers for Trevor Rosenthal.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: The Flying Squirrels have turned 70 double plays this year, which is the most in the Eastern League. Altoona is ranked second with 68. Richmond pitcher **John Michael Bertrand** has induced 15 double plays this year, which is the most in the league, ahead of three pitchers tied for second with 11, including Altoona's Po-Yu Chen. It is also the second-most in the minors. The Flying Squirrels turned four double plays on Saturday night against Binghamton, which is tied for the most in a game this season in the league. On July 10 against the Senators, **Seth Lonsway** induced three double plays, which is tied for the most by one pitcher in a game in the league this year. Bertrand matched that with three double plays behind him on July 19 against the RubberDucks.

GO, DIEGO, GO!: On Friday in his second Double-A game, **Diego Velasquez** hit a solo home run in the fourth inning for his first Double-A hit. He finished the night with three hits, adding an RBI single in the eighth inning. In his debut on Thursday, he walked twice and added a sacrifice bunt. Between Richmond and High-A Eugene this year, Velasquez has hit .272, which is seventh-best in the Giants organization. He is also ranked fourth in hits (78), fourth in stolen bases (18), tied for sixth in triples (3), eighth in doubles (16), ninth in OBP (.355), ninth in SLG (.390) and 10th in OPS (.745). With his debut on Thursday, Velasquez became the sixth-youngest player in Flying Squirrels history, the ninth player to debut for Richmond at age 20 or younger and the first player in team history born in 2003. On Saturday night, he made a diving stop to begin a double play that landed at No. 3 on ESPN's SportsCenter Top 10 Plays.

BERICOTO BASHING: In his last 39 games dating back to June 6, **Victor Bericoto** is hitting .314 (49-for-156) with three homers, eight doubles, eight walks and 18 RBIs. After leading the Giants organization in homers (27) last year, Bericoto hit just one homer in his first 34 games this season through May 21. From May 22-28, he homered three times in five games. He went deep again on June 14 at New Hampshire and added a homer on June 18 at Portland, but he has not homered in his last 29 games. In his last 49 games since May 22, Bericoto is batting .303 (57-for-188) with six homers, nine doubles, 14 walks and 27 RBIs. Bericoto has picked up multiple hits in 14-of-31 games dating back to June 15 and is batting .314 (38-for-121) in that stretch.

RETURN OF THE MECKLER: In his nine games with Richmond this year, **Wade Meckler** has picked up 11 hits, batting .333 (11-for-33). He first reached the Flying Squirrels last season and batted .336 (50-for-149) over 39 games, which as the third-highest average in the league (min. 170 PA) for the year. He hit .371 (115-for-310) in the minors last year, which was the highest in MiLB (min. 350 PA). It was the second straight year that a Flying Squirrels player led the minors in batting average, with **Vaun Brown** topping the charts (min. 350 PA) with a .346 average in 2022.

PACKING THE HOUSE: The Flying Squirrels drew an average of 7,113 fans in April for their home games at The Diamond to open the season, their highest April average in franchise history. The previous high was 6,891 in 2014 followed by 6,571 in 2019. This season, the Flying Squirrels are leading all 30 Double-A teams and are ranked eighth among the 120 minor league clubs in average home attendance (6,653), just shy of the highest average attendance in franchise history (6,689 in 2013).

PROSPECT WATCH: Two of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects are on the Richmond roster, including OF **Wade Meckler** (No. 12) and SS **Diego Velasquez** (No. 26). On Baseball America's Best Tools list, Meckler is rated the best hitter for average and best strike-zone discipline and LHP **John Michael Bertrand** is rated as having the best control. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list features five Richmond players, including McDonald (No. 12), Meckler (No. 16), Velasquez (No. 18), OF/1B **Victor Bericoto** (No. 19) and OF **Jairo Pomares** (No. 26).
