Syracuse Mets News and Notes

False Positive: Syracuse Mets manager Chad Kreuter announced on Thursday that the positive COVID-19 test that came back for a Syracuse player on Tuesday was actually a **false positive**, determined by Major League Baseball. The player who tested positive has had multiple negative tests since, and all other subsequent tests for the team have come back negative for COVID-19.

Bring in the Reinforcements: New York Mets outfielder **Brandon Nimmo** has rejoined Syracuse for his Major League rehab assignment. Nimmo was placed on the 10-day injured list on May 5th with what was originally diagnosed as a left index finger bone bruise and then a nerve issue. New York Mets manager Luis Rojas announced on Friday that Nimmo actually had a small ligament tear in the base of his left index finger. Nimmo began his rehab assignment with Syracuse on May 13th and played in one game before pausing the rehab assignment because of recurring discomfort. Nimmo is 2-for 7 with a walk since rejoining Syracuse on Sunday. New York Mets reliever **Dellin Betances** joined Syracuse on Wednesday to continue his rehab assignment that was started on June 13th with Low-A St. Lucie. Betances was placed on New York's 10-day injured list on April 8th with a right shoulder impingement and was transferred to the 60-day injured list on April 24th. Betances pitched a scoreless inning of relief on Wednesday.

Streaking in the Wrong Direction: Syracuse is on a season-high 15-game losing streak. This losing streak has surpassed a 12-game skid in 2015 from May 25th to June 5th. That was part of a stretch of 19 losses in 20 games (May 16, 2015 to June 5, 2015). The Mets are still a ways away from the longest losing streak in franchise history: a 21-game losing streak in 1953.

League Leaders: Syracuse leads the Triple-A East League with 63 stolen bases, 12 more than Worcester, the next closest team... The Mets are third in the league lead defensively in double plays with 44, behind Omaha (47) and Gwinnett (46)... **Drew Ferguson** is tied for 13th with eight stolen bases... **César Puello** is tied for 13th in the league with eight stolen bases (Six with Worcester and two with Syracuse)... **Drew Jackson** is tied for seventh in the league with 25 walks and ranks 17th with a .379 on-base percentage... **Jesús Reyes** is third in the league with 46.2 IP... **Franklyn Kilomé** has the only complete-game shutout thrown in the league this season.

Mets Dig the Long Ball: Syracuse has hit 46 home runs this season, scoring 78 total runs from those homers. That accounts for 39% of Syracuse's run production this season (198 runs).

Capacity Updates: Beginning this homestand NBT Bank Stadium capacity is nearly 100%. All but three sections will be at 100% with those three sections having socially-distanced seating for fans who are more comfortable in that setting. 549 seats will be "buffer seats" in the socially-distanced sections as NBT Bank Stadium's capacity will be 10,266 (95%) out of full capacity of 10,815.

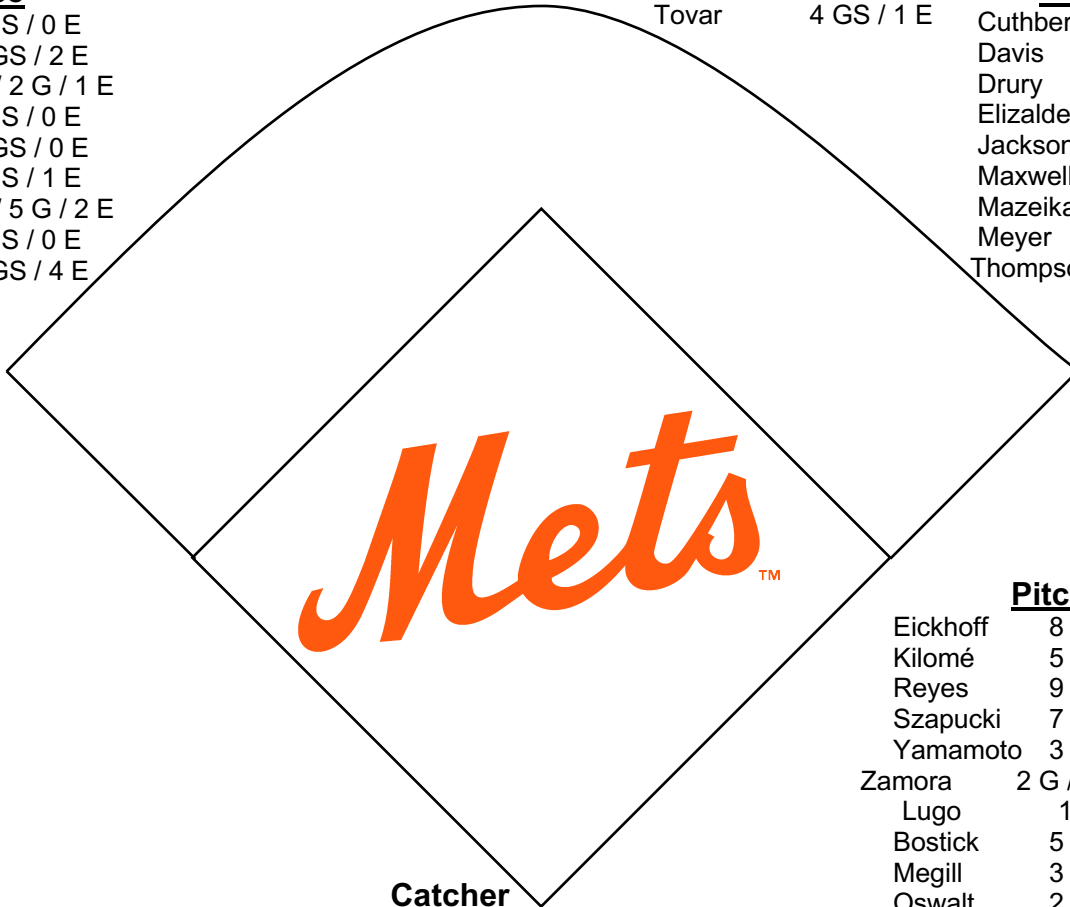
